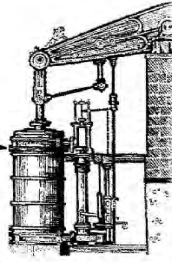

NEW CORNWALL COUNCIL LEADER

John Pollard is a Hayle man through and through – and it is a commitment to doing what is right which landed him the top job at Cornwall Council.

Effectively “Cornwall’s Prime Minister”, he neither sought nor expected to be asked to lead the authority.

Nevertheless, he relishes the challenge of redefining what Cornwall Council stands for.

He intends to be a very visible leader to both staff at County Hall (Lys Kernow) and to the electorate

Describing himself, resolutely, as a local man working for local people, rather than for a distant political machine, he said: “I am into community politics, not party politics. I believe in the principles of equality and justice. I am motivated by working for my community and I regard the whole of Cornwall as my community. This post is my opportunity to try to make a difference.”

He has served on its town council for more than 30 years and last month increased his share of the vote from the 2009 Cornwall Council election by 14% to 65%.

Born to shopkeeper parents and with family connections to the mighty J&F Pool engineering works in Hayle, he attended Penpol County Primary School and Humphry Davy Grammar School in Penzance, before going on to train as a teacher in Coventry.

Returning home to Cornwall with wife, Jean, he taught history at

Humphry Davy for 25 years, retiring in 2004 as deputy head.

His entry into local politics happened quite by accident when, soon after moving back to Cornwall in 1982, the future leader attended a meeting about the state of Hayle Harbour. During the session, he was overheard muttering about the calibre of the councillors present – to which a local woman told him: “If you don’t like it, stand for the council yourself!”

Now he finds himself holding the most powerful position in Cornish politics after fellow councillors unanimously elected him as their leader. Despite this, however, he has no illusions about the task ahead.

Being from Hayle, rather than a more prosperous part of Cornwall, is one of the reasons he is able to keep his thoughts focused on the needs of

those hardest hit by the economic downturn.

"I joined Hayle Town Council in 1982 to serve my local community and create a better quality of life," he said. "I wanted to make a difference. After working for the people of Hayle for 30 years, I decided I wanted to work for the whole community of Cornwall and stood for election to the new council in 2009."

He believes the ongoing rejuvenation of Hayle represents a useful analogy for the future prosperity of Cornwall as a whole.

An early supporter of plans to scrap the district councils in favour of a single authority, he believes unitary status made "perfect sense".

"I was in the minority with that view," he recalls. "It was possibly because I had not been a district councillor and therefore did not have the baggage or affection for the districts. Cornwall is one region and one community and it made perfect sense for one council to be pulling together for all sections of society."

The new cabinet consists of an alliance of Independents and Liberal Democrats. Mebyon Kernow and Labour have pledged to work constructively with the new administration, while UKIP stated it will co-operate where it can. Tories refused to join the alliance.

"My aim as leader is to work with all members to create a positive and responsive council and to build better relationships with our partners," he said. "We need to fight for fairer funding, to bring investment into Cornwall and to build the best, most inclusive, vibrant and successful Cornwall possible."

Turning to specifics, he added: "We need to sort out the budget. We need to establish what Cornwall Council can deliver in four years' time and budget to it. I'm not here to keep chipping away at services and taking things away to fit a budget, so we need to budget ahead. I also want to raise the reputation of the council. We have to get people to understand that we are delivering a service in the most businesslike way we can. We have got to regain people's trust and we have to be realistic about the service we can offer. It can't be what it was 20 years ago or ten years ago because the economic situation and the constraints are different."

Supporting him are his wife Jean and their two sons. Away from council work, John chairs Hayle Foundry Trust and was made a Bard of the Cornish Gorsedd in 2011 for services to history and heritage.

He relishes the future. And as a Cornishman with an optimistic outlook, he dismisses suggestions that heading Cornwall Council is 'a poisoned chalice'.

"I don't see it that way at all, but as my opportunity to make a difference," he said. "I would have to say to those who think otherwise that chalices only become poisoned because someone puts the poison in. One of my jobs is to make sure there's no poison around. I hope I can engender a positive spirit. That might sound naive, but that's the way I see it."

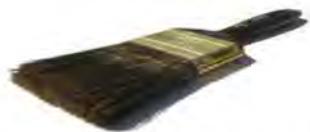

PLANTS ON THE WALK

(King George VI Memorial Walk)



Usually we would tell you about a plant that will be of interest during the period of time that the Pump covers. However this time we felt that it would be better to highlight a rare plant that is flowering as we write this article. The plant in question is a Dragon Lily or *Dracunculus Vulgaris* which is a perennial with attractive leaves divided into several narrow finger-like segments. It has a wonderful, exotic looking purple flower that has a dramatic foul smell somewhat reminiscent of rotting meat. This attracts the flies. It flowers in spring

or summer and dies thereafter. *D. Vulgaris* has a handsomely spotted stem with several leaves 30cm wide or more, the narrow lobes sometimes splashed with silver.

The Dragon Lily was first seen (and smelt), on the 9th July. Ironically it is located at the entrance to the sensory garden. If you were unfortunate to smell it, you would know that it is an assault on the senses. We do not know how it came to be on the walk, but it was certainly amazing to see.

The architectural bed 9 or sluice gate bed) is now looking fabulous, the planting scheme is really settling in and is a treat to see. If you haven't seen it for a while do come and take a look.

We would like to thank the many

people who donate plants to us at the greenhouse, most of which we have accommodated already ,but all will be given a home eventually. We will shortly be planting out a *Schefflera* which is being donated as a memorial plant by a local family in remembrance of their loved one who was passionate about the walk.

Well I'll Bee !

There is to be an urgent review of policy by the Government to

protect all pollinators, including butterflies.

Councils will be banned from cutting grass verges in early summer and in the case of developers knocking down buildings, new nesting sites for bees will be put in place.

The government plans to increase wild flower habitats by 200,000 hectares and "Bee-friendly measures could be written into planning policy. Developers could be asked to not knock down old buildings from April to June and provide "Bee hotels" as alternative sites.

A National Pollinator Strategy published in November could insist councils practice "Bee friendly" policies. Perhaps our councils will BEEcome leaders in this new environmental initiative.

Sadly it is too late for the wonderful wild flowers in front of the library that were cut down the day before the Britain in Bloom judging.

black bee is better at fighting off varroa mites. They carry the deformed wing virus, which has been implicated in the deaths of bees around the world.

Colony collapse disorder is a term that applies to a range of unknown factors that has led to the widespread decline of honeybee populations around the world.

It is likely to be a mix of many different issues coming together to kill millions of bees every year, threatening the human food supply chain. Colony collapse disorder is thought to be exacerbated by the limited range of bees that are bred by beekeepers.

Black honeybees like the Cornish variety were thought to have been driven to extinction by a virus more than 100 years ago, with beekeepers having since relied upon southern European varieties.

However, new populations were discovered on the fringes of the British Isles in 2012 by the Bee Improvement and Bee Breeders' Association, which has run a conservation program dedicated to the black bees since 1997. Fewer than one percent of British bees are native black bees, however.

With larger bodies and thicker hair, the black bees are believed to be better able to survive longer and colder winters -- something that has become more of an issue with climate change causing irregularities in the British climate. A third of US honeybees were killed last winter, too, so winter hardiness is of major importance.

It now seems that those larger hairs are also good at preventing the mites clinging onto each bee, making it harder for them to get infected with the deformed wing virus.

The zoo hopes to encourage beekeepers to take on the breed, with the advantage that, at the very least, an increase in biodiversity will hopefully make one single colony collapse factor less devastating if it does strike.

The 1989 Hayle Harbour Act created the 1990 Hayle Harbour Bye-laws, and bye-law 52 on page 10 states "Except in places which shall be clearly designated by the company, or except with the

permission of the harbour master, no person shall bathe in the harbour or fish for marine creatures of any type from the harbour premises”

This applies to the harbour as set out in the Act, meaning from the Hayle Recreation ground right through the dock areas across the estuary to Old Quay House and Lelant Saltings, and out to Hayle bar.

This is to give the Harbour Authorities the power to prevent swimming, angling and the digging or gathering of bait from anywhere in the Hayle waterways where it is unsafe or likely to interfere with the safe running of the harbour.

Since the 1950s much of this area has also been a Site of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI) with its own laws and penalties covered by the

Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981. Large sections of both Copperhouse Pool and Hayle Estuary are owned by the Royal Society for the Protection of Birds (RSPB) and these agencies plus the Environment Agency, and maybe even English Heritage can lobby the Harbour Authority to utilise their authority to stop swimming and angling in areas where it might conflict with their interests.

The GOOD news is that the Harbour Authority don't enforce a blanket ban, and have come up with an aerial photo showing where you CAN go fishing and where you can't in 2013. It is available on their website, (as are the bye-laws.)

<http://www.hayleharbourauthority.co.uk> under “Angling Zones”

Permitted areas vary each year depending on what is happening in the harbour, for example, this year fishing is banned from “Black Houses”/Carnsew Quay as works will be ongoing to restore the sluice tunnels and the sluice gates to a fully operational state. Once completed, fishing will probably be allowed there again.

(Note that the footpath right of way behind Jewsons is temporarily closed for the same reasons, access to The Weir is around Carnsew Basin),The situation with swimming is not so clear.

There have been swimming events in Copperhouse pool *with the permission of the harbour master* but this does not mean that swimming is more generally allowed. Health and Safety law and the requirements of

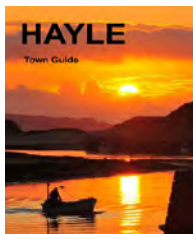

THOSE WERE THE DAYS

I was born in Hayle, and all my ancestors had come from within a few miles of Hayle for generations past. This is a part of my family's history – the “Lizzie” mentioned was my mother's mother. I remember “Aunt Laura” when I was a boy – she was quite ancient and everyone was very deferential to her. Alfred died when Mary was age 40 at most, she died at nearly 60 years. Her brother Joe emigrated to New Zealand. The following is letter written by Mary to Joe.

F.D. Trevarthen

July 20th 1871 “Praise St Erth”

Dear Joe,

I received your very welcome letter last Sunday morning. I was greatly surprised to hear from you. I really did think you had forgotten us but now I can say you are a friend in deed and not in word.

Please to accept my dear Joe our thanks for the five pounds you sent us for it has given me almost a new life, you can't think what an affect your letter has had on me when I think you sent all that money to the poor little children and said you were sorry it was not more, if it was only one pound think what a help that

would be to me at this time. I have a few friends with fair promises but nothing else to part with. Dear Alfred's death is come as an old thing to many but the children is no nearer rear than an year ago but you Dear Joe who I repeat it never promised me anything sent all that money in the very time I so much needed it. We have short of meat sometimes this summer. I never said anything to anyone nor allowed the children to. I thought certain people might guess without it. I think most of my two youngest Lizzie and Alfred two so pretty little children as you ever saw. Alfred is thirteen months old he can run as fast as the rest so I suppose you would like to hear how we are getting on. I think to me we shall do bye and bye. I do belong down to Mellanear mine in the account housed got one pound a month. William Robert is working on the

flours for ten shillings per month he is nine years old is a very good boy is always ready every day to work he has not lost an hour since April. He is very small he was for years always sick but is very well now he never complain is as cheerful as a lark. You said you suppose Nell had forgotten. Joe you are told scores of times they are both going to meet you when you come home. You have been daily expected ever since Jimmy is come they can't think how you might not come too. Nell have not laugh nor done so much else but moped like everyone in a bad temper ever since her poor father is dead. Heritage status from the whole **Cornwall and West Devon Mining Landscape** if the development goes ahead.

(They seem to have overlooked the fact that half the harbour complex has already been regenerated).

Their next step will be to consider whether the whole 'landscape' should be put on their 'at risk' register, and that is for some time in the future.

In the meantime Cornwall Council, aided by Hayle Town Council will be seeking to inform UNESCO representatives of the issues they may not yet have had placed before them.

A source has informed the Pump that negotiation is still ongoing between **ING** and **ASDA** concerning the planned supermarket on South Quay, and that related planning amendments connected with the starting of works are going through the system and have had no objections from Hayle Town Council. Keep an ear to the local press for developments.

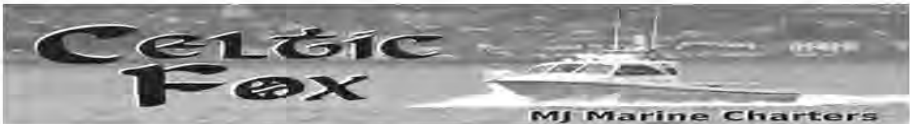
