The app has been made by Lucy Frears using the Hayle Oral History Project recordings she & her team of dedicated volunteers collected, plus some new recordings, & is part of Lucy's doctoral research at Falmouth University. The app will remain free once it is published & has been partly supported by an All Your Stories Heritage Lottery Grant. 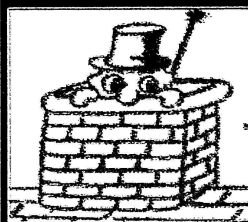

## Wave Hub Turbine?

Formal consent has been applied for to attach an experimental floating wind turbine to the Wave Hub situated on the sea bed ten miles off the coast of Hayle. This would be a first in the UK.

The Wave Hub hope to operate a 200 metre high “demonstrator” for a period of ten years, testing could start in 2015. An American marine engineering firm Gloston Associates is designing the turbine.

As well as this turbine it is hoped Irish firm Ocean Energy Ltd will provide the first wave device to be plugged in at the hub.

A second wave energy device is being tested in Falmouth and Ms Gibson confirmed that another client, whom she would not name, had come forward to take the third space.

There are natural concerns about the impact of the turbine on the view across St Ives Bay; Ms Claire Gibson from the Wave Hub said it would barely be visible from the shore.

"This is a unique opportunity for Cornwall. We have had a positive response so far from the local community."

Ms Gibson admitted progress had been slower than the company had anticipated, and the plans to build a floating wind turbine were a way of responding to the position in which the sector has found itself at the moment.

## Supermarket

As usual, rumours abound, and one is true! That the actual bits of South Quay to be developed for the supermarket and Foundry Yard opposite Jewsons HAS been sold, by ING, but this is a part of the plans.

As ING have been withdrawing from property business in Europe, for the Hayle project to continue, ING are taking on "Investment partners" to assist in development funding and long term ownership. This is apparently normal in property development and in Hayle's case it is being carefully managed to ensure Partners understand implications of things like the Heritage Levy and other

conditions relating to the development.

As usual, it all seems to be taking longer than at first thought. Issues raised by the World Heritage Status people have not stopped the project, Cornwall Council have not cancelled the planning permission, (and have no power to do so anyway.) ING have been in negotiation with ASDA to be the store operators, and the footpath past the sluice gates and sluice tunnels has been temporarily closed to allow the repairs and work needed to resume sluicing from Carnsew Pool. (The sluicing has to be sorted before the store is allowed to open for business.)

(This is all the case to the best knowledge and belief of the Editor at the time of writing in mid September.....!)

Furthermore, the council's Maritime Manager Andy Brigden, at a meeting of the Hayle Area Forum, stated that if the council did take over the harbour it would be only the water operations and not the 100 acres of land we helped negotiate for the community.

Hayle Harbour Trust, Ltd was formed two years ago following a public meeting of the Hayle Residents Association. Since then we have worked with ING to negotiate both the land transfer and a sustainable

production and an increasing population brought about a need for a new parish, and in 1870 permission was granted to take land from Phillack and St Erth to form the new Ecclesiastical District of St Elwyn. There was but one major dilemma, the new parish had no church to go with it, and for the next eighteen years the first vicar, Revd. William Horsburgh, held services in the St John's Chapel of Ease in St John's Street, ironically still part of Phillack Parish.

In 1884 Harvey and Sons gave an area of land overlooking Copperhouse Pool and plans were drawn up to finally build St Elwyn's. St Just-born architect John Dando Seddings was appointed to design it, having already designed Downes House in Hayle in 1880.

Built in the Early English style (1201-1300), with some later features from the Perpendicular and Decorated periods which have been very skilfully blended to retain the overall harmony of the building. The elevated site and striking external appearance prompted the Rector of Phillack, the Revd. Frederick Hockin to dub it the 'Cathedral of Hayle' after its dedication in 1887.

code that householders need to quote to register electronically, are given on the form. Registering electronically is not only the quickest and easiest method, but also the cheapest, thereby helping the Council to save taxpayers' money.

If any details on the form have changed, people should cross through the names of anyone who no longer lives at the address, amend any mistakes or add the names of anyone new who is eligible to vote. They then need to sign the form and return it – either in the pre paid envelope or by dropping it into any Council office or one stop shop. Denise and her team hope that as many people as possible will complete and return their forms as soon as they receive them otherwise a reminder will have to be sent out in early November to any households who have not yet replied.

In addition a team of over 100 canvassers will then visit any households who have still not registered in December and January (except from 23 December to 1 January) to help people fill in their form.

Anyone who does not receive a form is asked to contact the Council's electoral registration team on **0300 123 1115.**
