starring Cheryl Campbell as Vera. This new adaptation does justice to that series even as it introduces the heart-breaking story of love, war and remembrance to a fresh audience. Swedish actress Alicia Vikander is gloriously convincing as the strong-minded Vera, who, after being accepted into Oxford, volunteers as a nurse at the Western Front. Heartthrob Kit Harington (Jon Snow in *Game of Thrones*) plays her fiancé, Roland. The top-notch cast also includes Miranda Richardson, Dominic West, Emily Watson and Colin Morgan.

The film's exquisite photography and costumes add up to more than just another British costume drama. This is a beautifully

considered and powerful film, one that spent precious little time in local cinemas, and it deserves to be seen by a wide audience, including today's younger generation (the film is rated 12A). As *The Telegraph's* Tim Robey wrote in his four-star review, "The film-makers have done hugely stirring justice to Brittain's life work, which was to deny every false meaning attached to battlefield death."

the blast furnaces. Lord Beaverbrook was nothing if not thorough, and his logistics operations would have been geared to deliver the iron to the steel works.



During the Second World War, the removal of iron is recounted by hundreds of eye witnesses, yet there are no reports of the lorries arriving at steel works like Port Talbot, Sheffield and Motherwell with large quantities of railings and gates to be loaded into

So, what did happen? One school says the iron collected was unsuitable and could not be used. This seems unlikely, as recycled iron is a key component in the steel industry. Another more likely explanation is that far more iron was collected - over one million tons by September 1944 - than was needed or could be processed. Certainly, the huge underground munitions factory Beaverbook set up at Corsham in Wiltshire ran far below capacity for its short life.

Faced with an oversupply, rather than halt the collection, which had turned out to be a unifying effort for the country and of great propaganda value, the government allowed it to continue. The ironwork collected was stockpiled away from public view in depots, quarries and railway sidings. After the war, even when raw materials were still in short supply, the widely-held view is that the government did not want to reveal that the sacrifice of so much highly valued ironwork had been in vain, and, so, it was quietly disposed

of, or even buried in landfill or at sea. 26% of the iron-work collected was used for munitions, and, by 1944, much of it was rusting in council depots or railway sidings, with some filtering through to the post-war metal industry. Yet the public was never told this.

Many communities are replacing the railings, and The Passmore Edwards Institute is one of them. The railings and gates are believed to have been removed in 1940, and **they need your help** to replace them, restoring the Institute to its former state. Once again, you are being asked to donate scrap metal which will be turned not into munitions, but cash for the huge cost involved: around £14,000.

A skip will be placed in the PEI car-

park on **9 June** ready for your peacetime donations, but definitely not fridges and freezers (they contain gas). Please support this worthwhile cause in the same spirit of WW2 families.

# Millpond Update

## 'A New Era'

My old Granny used to say 'All special events come in threes!'

So it seems. We have had a newly-born princess, a newly-elected government, and the long awaited change of ownership from County to Town Councils.

During the summer, all nine of the sites once leased to Penwith, which include the Millponds, will be transferred back to Hayle Town Council after they are tidied up.

Cornac have already begun to work around the Millponds clearing away the excess growth from around the Swan Pool and mowing the grass in the gardens. They have also planted broad-leafed saplings

along Millpond Avenue. There is still more work to do around the Ponds which, we understand, will take until August to complete. Great care will be taken to protect the historical fabric and the wildlife living on the Nature Reserve, although I did have to explain the difference between the bank voles, which live on the Inner Pond, and rats, but then the voles are one-third the size.

The Black-Headed gulls have finally departed to their breeding grounds in Wales, but we are being visited by a young Ring-Billed gull, one of only six recorded in the UK this spring. The swallows and house martins are beginning to return to the Foundry where they nest in the eaves of the buildings.

The early spring flowers are going over now, but the woodland has been resplendent with primroses and lesser celandines. Arum lilies, bluebells and three-cornered leeks are blooming, and the yellow flag irises are now just starting to show around the Inner Pond. These always make a really special show, because the rhododendrons on the Island bloom at the same time.

The warm weather at the start of April has encouraged our bees and butterflies to make an appearance around the Millponds, taking advantage of the earlier spring flowers. We have also seen dragon- and damselflies. The turtles are popping their heads above water, so, summer is on the way.

Here's to a good one this year!

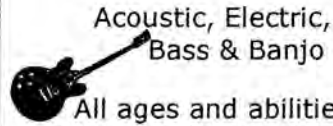
