The Woman's Institute

originated in Canada at Stoney Creek in February 19th 1897. It was formed in Britain at

the suggestion of the Canadian Madge Watt to counter the shortages caused by the marauding submarines attacking food convoys in the middle of the First World War. As a result more food had to be home grown and all excess went into the production of jams and preserves.



This was repeated later during the Second World War and between 1940 and 1945 the amazing amount of 5,300 tons of jam and fruit preserves contributed to the war effort. Sir Hubert Parry's setting of Blake's Jerusalem was first sung at the A.G.M of 21 May 1924. It had actually been used as early as 1918 by the National Union of Suffrage. Thus Jam and Jerusalem

The compost includes weeds and spent plants from the gardens, old fruit and banana skins from the bird food kitchen, tea bags and peelings from the café, plus straw and animal waste from the Fun Farm - all combine into a mountain of potential goodness. Local company Ireland Brothers bring machinery to turn the pile, and the rich dark compost in the middle is moved to a convenient place near the plant nursery at the Park.
