Mayor's Walk for Cornwall Hospice Care

St Julia's Hospice at Hayle holds a special place in the hearts of many local people whose friends and family have been cared for there at the end of life for several years now. The Hospices at St Julia's in Hayle and Mount Edgcumbe in St Austell provide specialist and compassionate care, as well as offering comfort to families and friends. It costs nearly £8.4 million each year to provide these services but the government grant only pays for 41 days of care at the two hospices, which means they have to find the £7.5 million to pay for the other 324 days of the year.

In Hayle the Town Council has helped organise a group sponsored walk each year for several years to help out, and calling it the "Mayor's Walk"

This year it took place on a warm and sunny Sunday 6 September, with a five mile romp around the Towans for the energetic, or a more sedate 2.2 mile walk around the town and Copperhouse Pool.

This year "Team Mayor" included three of the mayor's four children, his grandson Cameron in his self-propelled wheelchair and his ageing Cocker Spaniel Bess. We managed to raise £220 so thanks to our sponsors.

Millpond Update

According to the Met Office September 1st is the first day of autumn, but after the very indifferent August we have just lived through I am still wondering what actually happened to summer. I am tempted to say that autumn really began on the 1st of August, but they forgot to tell us. Even the wildlife is confused. The only positive outcome so far was that the late nesting ducks ensured that their ducklings escaped becoming mobile meals for the

rooks, and we have at least eighteen healthy youngsters to come home to the ponds. We already have over sixty birds on the Millponds at the moment. These include about a dozen wild drakes which come to the

pond to moult. They come every year and their mates will arrive soon with any ducklings they have hatched. They will stay with us for the winter part of the time on the Inner Pond and partly on the lake at Sharky's Pit. At the end of the winter one or two may stay on the ponds and some of our youngsters may leave with the wild flock, which ensures new bloodlines in our breeding flock, keeping them healthy and relatively free from in-breeding. A while ago granite blocks were stolen from the site, making the wall

at the top of the Rope Walk vulnerable. Millponds are an important heritage area and with the help of English Heritage the granite wall has been repaired. The observation platform has also now been completely repaired and given a coat of wood preservative. It would also be great to get the bench and we will ask if it can be done because we know that it was much appreciated.

The bamboo along the edge of the Inner Pond is being damaged which is a great shame. The Millponds Bamboo was planted originally in 1873 and was among the first plantings in Cornwall. The second planting took place in 1886 when the plantations at Tehidy and Heligan were upgraded. Cornish bamboo was sent to London to feed a very special panda called Chi-Chi. All we can ask is that our bamboos be treated with the respect they deserve after nearly one hundred and fifty years on site. Thank you! We seem to have been successful in attracting the bees and butterflies to the gardens, especially the Cornish black Bees which have their hives at Paradise Park. Further planting of speciality bee and butterfly plants will continue next year.

The Britain in Bloom judges were very impressed with the Penpol School flower beds and the Scouts Flower Corner. Well done and we look forward to next year!

I raised (after fees) £1,010 with 30 Backers. This gave me enough to print 150 copies instead of the planned 100. Thank you to any readers who supported me. It was such a big help.

The next phase is promotion, which began with a successful book launch at the Old Foundry Chapel Day on June 20, in association with The Cornish Bookworm. My thanks to Bill Martindale for this and for stocking 'No Stone Unturned' at the Bookworm subsequently. I followed this up with sales at the Hayle In Bloom festivities on July 5, supported by Trevor Smitheram and Maria Prosser of the Old Cornwall Society. A big thank-you, there. By the time you read this, I should also have been selling and signing at Hayle Foundry Day on Sept 26, again with the Old Cornwall Society. So far, feedback has been very positive, particularly with the book's overall appearance, which is gratifying, as I spent a lot of time trying to get this right.

Apart from The Cornish Bookworm, 'No Stone Unturned' can (at the time of writing) be purchased locally at the Hayle Heritage Centre, at meetings of the Old Cornwall Society, Hayle Archives and Meritorious. Any local businesses who would like to hold copies can view the book in detail on my website: www.artferret.co.uk. Meanwhile, I am continuing to place books at museums, galleries and bookshops in the West Penwith area and carrying out on-going searches

for ancient stones on the Towans. An Ordnance Survey map from the 1960s has several marked, but whether they are ancient, modern or indeed still there remains to be investigated. Seven of them though, including the menhir featured in 'No Stone Unturned' lie in a straight line. Intriguing!

and Tourist Information Centre has an uncertain future in common with all the 31 Libraries in Cornwall. Due to stringent government funding cuts, Cornwall Council has bizarrely already cut 44% of the budget for its Cornwall Library Service, before any process to find alternative options for running the libraries.

It is asking local town and parish councils for (A) 'expressions of interest' in taking over their own libraries and looking at (B) options for handing the whole process over to some other operator. This seems to ignore the facts that Cornwall Council has a legal duty to provide a library service, FREE at the point of delivery and that councils like Hayle Town Council have no power to run

libraries.

Hayle Town Council believes the library is a vital service for the town and has resolved to tell Cornwall Council that neither options A or B are suitable and to revise its budget to continue providing a library service as now and fulfil its legal obligation. George Eustice MP has taken an interest.

Linden Homes planning application for 222 homes in Netherleigh Farm fields behind Penpol School, overwhelmingly rejected by Hayle people at TWO public meetings, and strongly objected to by Hayle Town Council, was refused permission by Cornwall Council, then Linden Homes launched a planning appeal. Part of

that process involved another presentation before the Strategic Planning Committee which again confirmed it was "still minded to refuse", but then Linden Homes came back for yet another attempt, raising its Affordable Homes level from 15% to the new lower Hayle target of 30%, and presenting additional arguments over heritage

issues. (Other public concerns over traffic and flooding etc. were ignored as the official consulting bodies were “happy” with the application!) Planning officers now consider their grounds for refusal have been answered and state they recommend approval. Hayle Town Council will have maintained its objections at a meeting on 24th September.

Foundry Yard between the viaduct and ASDA had planning permission for a block of three shops facing towards Foundry Square, with car parking and a space for the Goonvean Engine an historic steam engine made by Harvey and Co. Agents seeking tenants for the three planned shops found insufficient

interest in these cash strapped times, but there WAS interest if it could be a single, larger shop instead of three small ones, so a planning application to change to a single shop has been progressed and narrowly accepted (with conditions) by Hayle Town Council. We can't know the name of the prospective tenants because that's confidential and dependent on GETTING the final planning permission from Cornwall Council.

Sadly as time has gone on it's become clear that the Goonvean Beam Engine, though made in Hayle has a replacement beam, the biggest and most visible part, made by “Holmans of Camborne” and with that logo cast into it. The engine is of a type that needs an extremely

strong building or structure custom built to support it, and extremely deep holes and sumps beneath it. The costs of assembling it in Hayle would be prohibitive, even IF a suitable site could be found.

Heritage experts have pointed out that beam engines were never assembled in Hayle but made as "kits" for assembly in custom built houses on site where they were needed, and therefore it would not be "historically accurate" to show it assembled in Hayle.

It IS planned to bring it to Hayle where some parts can be displayed publicly and the rest safely stored until such time as funds and a suitable place might be found to assemble it in the future.

Work continues on a £250,000 scheme around Hayle on the Recreation Ground, Memorial Walk, Plantation, Millpond, and Railway Gardens to bring them up to standard by Cornwall Council so that they can be returned to the control of Hayle Town Council which actually owns these sites on behalf of the town. Most work should be completed this year with the formal "hand back" next April.

New councillor Hayle Town Council welcomes Ian Lawrence who has been selected from candidates to be co-opted onto the council, he is already settling in and getting involved.

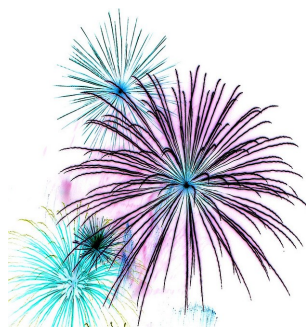

Copperhouse Pool

As a Hayle Town Councillor and mayor, I often get asked why Copperhouse Pool can't be permanently flooded and used as a boating lake or similar resource, like at Helston or Newquay.

It would be a pleasant addition to the King George V Memorial Walk



and an attractive visual centre for the town.

The problems are largely based in its history and are many and complex!

It's owned by the Royal Society for the Protection of Birds and, as part of the Hayle Estuary, is of European importance as a tidal estuary for migrating and over-wintering birds, so, they are keen for it to remain as a tidal estuary, and – as outright owners, what they want is what is most likely to happen.

Copperhouse Pool is also part of a Site of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI) with very strong legal protection and large fines and prison terms under the Wildlife and Countryside Acts, and this part of its status is administered by the Government body "Natural England".

More recently, it has become part

Valley at Gwinear) so, can't be dredged or deepened due to the phenomenal costs of removing any material which would have to go to specialist treatment works "up country" at a massive cost.



It is an integral part of the Hayle Flood prevention scheme, too, managed by the Environment Agency and sometimes needs to be kept empty to cater for any river flooding and prevent the highest tides coming in. With all these agencies and bodies having legal and ownership rights over Copperhouse Pool the chances of its being permanently flooded are so remote as to say it can NEVER happen.

Perhaps, instead, it would be better for people to realise that we are possibly unique in having a tidal estuary in the middle of our town, which is also an RSPB nature reserve and start to be proud of that and market it as such. Although it's featured in the town guide (available from the Town Council Offices), not many other sources of marketing for Hayle make much of it.

Maybe, this natural asset, as it is, is the real Jewel in the Crown?

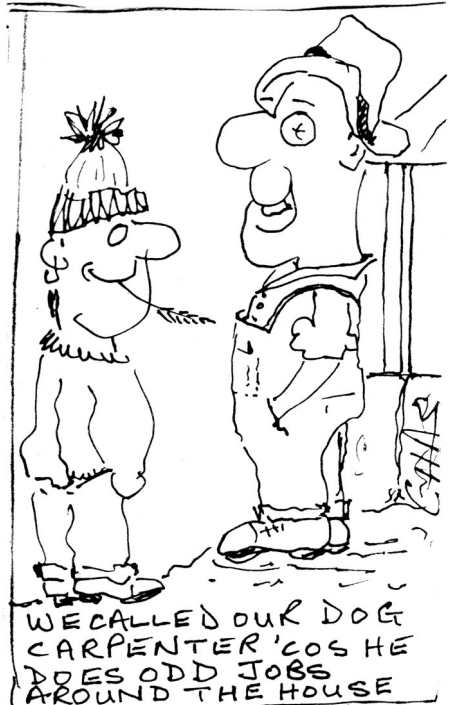

Concerns Over Hayle Library's Future

Cornwall Council announced in Feb 2015 that **44 % will be cut to the Library and one-stop shop service** budget in Cornwall over the next two years:- £1.8 million. The Council ran a public consultation in early 2015. It asked for opinions and for any groups, town councils or organisations to come forward with proposals to run the services in the light of these cuts by 29th May 2015. Approximately 6% of current library members replied to the consultation survey. At this time, the Council stated that there were no proposals to close sites.

In August 2015, Cornwall Council asked again for any groups, town councils or organisations to come forward to run the services, and gave a deadline of 30th September 2015, as not enough groups had come forward to enable the Council to enact their planned savings. But, this time, there was a change of rhetoric:

Council's current message is:-

Whilst we are aiming to protect the whole library/one-stop shop service: organisations and groups taking on the running of their local service, whilst being supported by the Council's central library and one-stop shop team – we only have 14 'Expressions of Interest' and, without more, we cannot rule out ultimately having to close sites to deliver the service within budget.

Hayle Library/OSS is indeed a valued community asset. 261

children registered to read there this summer. There are 4,708 visitors a month. It loans 402 books every day it is open. 9% of members are on means-tested benefit: the highest in Cornwall. Hayle is an area with some acute social deprivation and a growing population.

The town council is already overstretched. It is likely to be the vulnerable who suffer most if Hayle library and OSS close.

Think of the situation in Hayle if the library does close. How will residents access vital information, particularly if they are unemployed or on very low wages? The library has always acted as a very important social hub in the town. But, above all, the library is there for the benefit of EVERYBODY. IF WE ALLOW IT TO BE LOST IT WILL NEVER RETURN!

So, what can you do for Hayle Library:

Contact your local councillor/county councillor/MP;

Consider whether a 6% consultation response rate is enough to base key decisions;

Ask if the council is reviewing the impact of decisions on the vulnerable.
