## Year 9 pupils from St. Piran's



School in Hayle were offered a summer term challenge, to create a display for Hayle in Bloom on a disused site in the town. Nigel Powell, Chairman of Hayle in Bloom, told the school that visitors to the town were surprisingly unaware of the beautiful beaches that were such an asset to the town and he suggested that an area backed by a wall, close to Philp's East Quay Bakery would be available for a floral display. Armed with saws, secateurs, and sacks to bag up the rubbish, the Year 9 gardeners cleared the overgrown site of weeds and debris, a task completed in twelve man hours one sunny afternoon in June.

The next stage of the project involved painting a background mural of Godrevy Lighthouse with breaking waves in the foreground. Wooden panels were painted in St. Piran's playground and then attached to the wall at East Quay which had been smartened up with masonry paint. The floral display was then planted in a series of containers reflecting the colour of the coastal rock outcrops. The planting was designed to represent a breaking wave, spilling over the recess that housed the seascape, two varieties of blue salvias, silver cineraria foliage and blue and white bacopa were used to simulate sea foam cascading onto the beach

below.

Hayle in Bloom completed the picture by adding a sandy beach in the foreground, as a small taste of what Hayle can offer .

Year 9 pupils thoroughly enjoyed the great range of activities involved in the project, ranging from encounters with wildlife during the site clearance - "I think it's a tarantula Miss!"- to capturing "the perfect wave" in paint and

## *Hayle Library Under Threat*

Cornwall Council has a statutory duty under the Public Libraries and Museums Act 1964 'to provide a comprehensive and efficient library service for all persons in the area that want to make use of it'.

It must deliver a modern and efficient library service that meets the requirements of the community within available resources. Cornwall Council also has a statutory duty to deliver a balanced budget at the same time as government support grants are being cut.

Every service provided by Cornwall Council has been reviewed to find savings and the result is that funding for the library service is being cut and the number of libraries in Cornwall will be reduced. Hayle Library will likely be one of these unless Hayle Town Council takes responsibility for the funding to keep it going.

**Hayle Town Council is conducting a short survey to learn your views on the library service and how much you are prepared to pay to keep it going.**

## **Book clever for cheaper rail tickets**

**Railway journalist Andrew Roden offers some advice on getting the best value rail fares.**

It's increasingly tempting to let the train take the strain - you can relax in comfort, read a book, work, or simply watch the scenery go by. But rail fares can be infuriatingly complex if you want to get the best deal, as I've just found searching for tickets to and from Gatwick Airport for family members. So, how do you get the very best deals on rail travel?

### **Use your railcards**

There's a host of railcards available which offer a third off most (but not all) rail fares. If you're 16-25, a Senior Citizen, travel regularly with a friend, or have a family with children there's a railcard for you. You can get them online or at booking offices and the savings ramp up, especially on long journeys. There's even a Devon and Cornwall Railcard which offers 1/3 off most off-peak fares in the region: at £10 a year it's an absolute steal. Be aware though that there may be restrictions on travel times and some ticket types – so there isn't always a saving to be had.

### **Ask the experts**

The booking office staff in Penzance are particularly brilliant, so if you're travelling a long way, see what they can do. You may be surprised at how much they can save you: I've checked with fares experts who know the system as well as the train companies – and the ladies and

This well-known website charges a booking fee for credit and debit cards. If you're booking tickets online go to [www.gwr.com](http://www.gwr.com) or [www.crosscountry.co.uk](http://www.crosscountry.co.uk) to find the same fares at the same prices – without booking fees. Bear in mind though that it isn't always cheaper to book two single fares: check out the prices for return tickets before you buy.

### RideCornwall

If you're travelling within Cornwall after 0900 the RideCornwall ticket is great value. For £10 adult you get unlimited rail and bus travel in Cornwall and to Plymouth.

### Cheaper by sleeper?

Consider the Night Riviera sleeper train: the most it will cost is £60 per single berth (£35 per person if you're sharing a twin cabin with family or friends) on top of an off-peak ticket and there are sleeper only tickets which are cheaper still. If you're travelling to or from London it can save a fortune in hotel fees – and get you to where you need to be while you're travelling, saving hours of time as well as being a magical experience. It's particularly useful for those travelling from London's airports whose flights arrive in the early evening, removing the pressure of rushing to get the last day train home.

**On Monday 4 August the Man Engine is coming to Hayle;** this is the largest puppet ever built in the UK and will be touring Cornwall over the summer as part of the celebrations for the tenth anniversary for Cornwall gaining its World Heritage Site status. **The engine will be arriving at 18.00 at Foundry Square.**

Our volunteers have been working hard over the winter undertaking new research for an exhibition that

will look in detail at four topics of the town's history: J F Pool, Shops in the town, the Foundry process and shipping. # Hayle Neighbourhood Plan

Have your say



**The initial consultation** on Policies for the Neighbourhood Plan closed on June 10<sup>th</sup> after a 2-month period and with two open days. There were almost 250 responses – a good result considering that it took about an hour to complete the survey. We are now going over the comments and making changes to the policies where necessary – although these are minor since there was very strong support across the board.

We also asked statutory bodies, land owners and a wide range of organisations to respond and we had some good suggestions and a lot of support from most of these.

Cornwall Council has a legal duty to review the Plan and we are now working with them to make sure all of the Policies are well written and consistent with planning law. Once this process is complete, we will make a formal submission to Cornwall Council and, once approved by them, it is referred to an external inspector. Assuming she approves it, there will be a referendum for all Hayle registered voters.

If we get over 50% support, the Neighbourhood Plan will strongly control the planning process in Hayle until 2030.

## Millpond Update

**psychology is** a subject that I am finding difficult to master! As expected Oberon left the Ponds three weeks after Titania, but, surprise, surprise, he also headed for Copperhouse Pool and a grand reunion with his estranged partner. Now they are the loving couple again and you would think that they had never been apart. We must wait for next spring and hope that all their problems have been truly solved. In the meantime the Millponds are swanless once again.

As summer progresses our unmated drakes have started to drift back home. Now they have started their annual moult and will spend the next couple of months in various states of scruffiness until the females return and they resume their courting plumage again.

The turtles are appearing regularly now but as yet we have not noticed any additions. They do love being photographed and they will pose quite happily either singly or in a group for anyone with a camera pointed in their direction.

The Millponds have joined with the 'Bee Aware Project' and they will be planting raspberry canes in the wood. We already have patches of wild strawberries which are also part of the scheme which is run countrywide by Exeter University to

ensure that wild and domestic bees are protected and enhanced under controlled conditions. Visitors are encouraged to pick the fruit produced.

The weather has stayed quite changeable. Typical English summer I hear you say but we also had an overdose of continental thunderstorms with very heavy rain and localised flooding in places. Our river level has been slightly higher than it usually is at this time of year, but fortunately not as it was earlier in the year when the pond overflowed because the syphon is still not working properly. Water levels may become a source of future anxiety due to the number of houses being built in the surrounding area which will increase the ground water flowing into the Ponds from the river. This makes the control of the overgrowth on the Inner Pond essential to control the levels by improving the water flow through both ponds.

Work has not yet started on the Millpond site, but we hope that it will do so soon, but the programme of works is still to be finalised by the Council and contractors.

(1) grow nectar/pollen rich flowers and shrubs, (2) leave patches of land to grow wild, (3) cut grass far less often, (4) avoid disturbing or destroying nesting or hibernating insects and (5) think again about using pesticides. In the last 10 years, beekeepers have lost about a third of their managed bee colonies. At home, in your street, at work or school, you can help the 250 or more types of bee by following the above advice.

The Town Council is the new owner of the Walk and could save a significant sum by observing this DEFRA advice throughout Hayle. It would appear that the "Phillack Living Churchyard" (see Issue126) is under threat of being tidying up more often due to a complaint. Perhaps Hayle Town Council will take this on board when making these decisions.

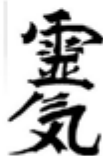
