has a strong competitive history. On the other hand we are high on the paddle for fun and fitness side.

The club has concentrated a lot for the last few years on running training courses, but this year while we are continuing the training we are trying to paddle more and worry about qualifications less, to make sure we spend as much time on the water as possible. The idea is to reinforce skills and knowledge in a not very proscribed way – paddling for pleasure not paper in other words.

We'll probably be spending club nights (Wednesdays 6pm to 8pm or later from 26 April to 13 September) around the harbour for those less experienced or who just want a gentler paddle in flatter water, off the edges of the estuary in the waves for those who like the bump and ride, and maybe even a St Ives ice cream run or two for the more distance oriented paddler in suitable conditions.

We also paddle more informally on a Friday night and run trips in other areas (Marazion/Helford/Lizard etc) and river trips in the season (roughly October to March, Exe, Dart, Tavy) for those hardy enough and who want the oh so different river experience.

We have our own bit of white water inside Carnsew Pool, which is gentler than it was once but also in its own way trickier. It's a good learning experience and can be great fun if not for the faint-hearted and really only for the experienced

or when attended by coaches. There's even a few of us who are mad enough to paddle year round in all weathers. In the harbour you get a different perspective on the town and can often shake beaks with the local kingfishers, flap a wing at a cormorant or shake a flipper with Sammy the seal. The fact that this all happens in a privately owned working commercial harbour still surprises and delights, and it is all on our doorstep: fitness, fresh air and fun a few minutes from home. Come and meet us, try it, you might not like it but love it !

The new outfall should help to carry away the extra flow going into the ponds but it should be monitored to avoid any future flooding.

Our black-headed gulls have now departed again to return to their breeding grounds in Wales. "Bye Folks, we'll see you again in the autumn!"

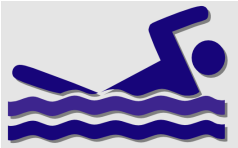

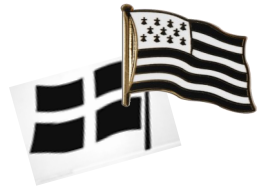

## **THE MINES OF HAYLE REVISTED**

Several years ago I wrote a series of articles published in the Hayle Pump that looked at the Mines once to be found in the immediate neighbourhood of Hayle. I have recently been asked about these articles and I thought it informative to write an overview highlighting these mostly forgotten enterprises that often now only exist as a name.

Many of the sites have been redeveloped over the years and show little sign of their previous history.

were employed in the 1800's making it possibly Hayle's largest ever employer. The mine reached a depth of approximately 257 fathoms or 1550ft from surface (or 'grass' as the Cornish Miners termed it). This was a very old mine and sales of tin are recorded from Angarrack Smelting House in 1718. From a historical point of view, the eastern part of this mine called **Alfred Consols** had a Copperhouse built steam engine installed in 1855. After this mine closed and after moves to several other mines, this engine was eventually installed at South Crofty mine where it remains to this day in Robinsons Engine House next to Heartlands at Pool.

Growing up at Guildford Road in the 1960/70's, this mine was our playground and I remember the huge heaps of clinker from the steam engines that operated there. Wheal Alfred was so important and rich at one time – in 1807 for instance it was making £2500 profit each month, that its name was incorporated into several other mines (mainly to entice investors). At one stage there was a North, West, South and East Wheal Alfred at work in addition to Consols mentioned above.

**Mellanear Mine** was situated under the Hayle Bypass between Joppa and Water Lane just north of Tolroy. It incorporated a much older mine called **Wheal Ann** on its eastern side. Mellanear Mine was active mostly in the later part of the 19<sup>th</sup> century and was notable as

The largest concern by far was **Wheal Alfred** situated about a mile south of the mini roundabout at Loggans. This had a long and chequered history as a copper producer and has a recorded output of over 105,000 tons of copper ore mostly produced in the first half of the 19<sup>th</sup> century. It is reported that over 1000 persons

being one of the last big copper producers in Cornwall. It reached a depth of 150 fathoms (900ft) and produced over 65,000 tons of copper ore as well as some tin, zinc and lead. It was one of the wettest mines in Cornwall and required considerable pumping out. There is barely any sign of the mine today having been built over in recent years. At the western end it adjoined a small mine called **West Alfred** that amongst others had a shaft called 'Mexico Shaft' in the marshy ground by the Hayle River flyover.

**Wheal Lucy** was a tin mine occupying the area around Cove Café on the Towans. This was a small mine that only produced around 25 tons of tin and reached a depth of 30 fathoms (180ft).

Several adits (or drainage tunnels) were driven in from the Black Cliffs but most of these have been lost in rock falls over the years. It is rumoured that one of these went as far as 'Riviere House' and the mine was originally called Riviere Mine

in its earliest days. The mine was last worked in the 1880's.

**West Wheal Lucy** was a small mine found under the golf links at Lelant. It was worked mainly from adits driven in the low cliffs at the mouth of the estuary which can still be seen. It produced small amounts of tin during the 1870's.

Beneath the sand dunes at Upton Towans and on the site later occupied by the National Explosives Works lay the interestingly named **Boiling Well Mine**. One theory is that it got this name as the water in the main shaft literally bubbled up out of the rock. The mine produced mainly copper and lead and over 5000 ounces of silver! It eventually reached 70 fathoms (420ft) in depth and closed in the 1860's. The Engine Shaft was later used as a water source by the explosives works. Most of the shafts were recently made safe.

**Wheal Emily** was a small mine centred around Strap Rocks at Gwithian. Another small mine, it produced zinc, lead and 169 tons of copper ore from a maximum depth of 42 fathoms (252ft) and closed in 1860. There is a semi buried waggon in the cliff top from this period.

At Copperhouse, two exploratory tunnels were driven south to try to find new mineral lodes. These were possibly intended to join up with Wheal Alfred eventually although neither did. One did get

as far as **North Wheal Alfred** which was a small mine just south of Trevassack crossroads and was driven from Market Square.

Prospect Place is likely to have been named after this trial which seems to have gone by the name **Wheal Arthur**. The other tunnel (or adit) is the source of the spring that empties into Copperhouse Creek by the new fire station. It ran alongside Bodriggy House south under Trevithick Crescent and terminated in a field next to Burnthouse Lane. This trial appears to have been called **Wheal Shoat**.

Perhaps the most surprising (and unusual) mine in Hayle was at Foundry under the **Plantation**. It

was only recently discovered when a foundation was being put in and appears to have been worked from a tunnel driven in from Foundry Lane. It is not a true mine as such but appears to have extracted a deposit of iron and possibly manganese deposited when sea levels were much higher than today. It is almost certain that this

was operated by Harvey and Co as part of their foundry works. The workings themselves are a series of interlinked chambers forming a grid system and pick marks are clearly visible showing how the deposit was extracted. The workings are no longer accessible and more research needs to be carried out in order to throw light on the history of this unique endeavour.

This then is a very brief overview of mining enterprises found in the immediate Hayle area. If the area is expanded to a 2 mile radius then literally dozens of other mine can be included. Taking into account the amount of machinery and supplies needed to service the mines it is no mystery as to why

Hayle ended up with two foundries and helped lead the industrial revolution in the 19<sup>th</sup> century.

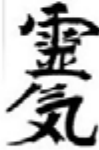

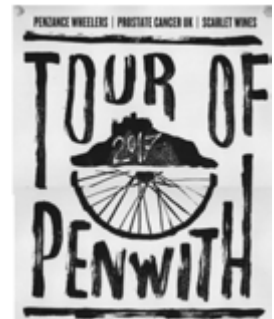
