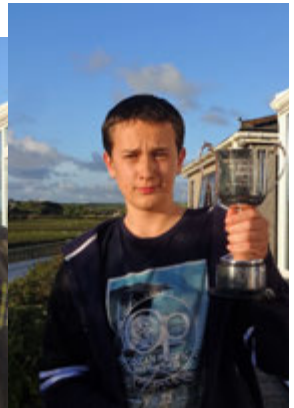

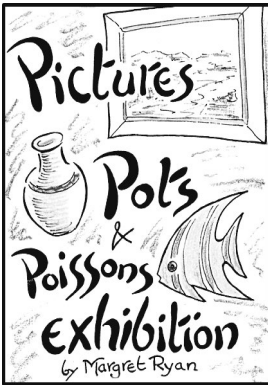

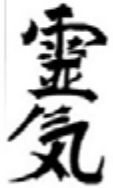

## A pint of original at the Ellis Brewery tap

Revellers enjoying the recent feast of entertainment at the Cornish Arms Fools Festival in Hayle might have been forgiven for thinking that the bottles of old Ellis Original on the bar were all part of the fun – it being April and all.

Everyone knows that the last drop of Ellis was brewed back in 1934 when the family-owned brewery became part of a larger Cornish family outfit, St Austell Brewery. While MD Christopher Ellis went on to join the board at St Austell, the distinctive yellow and red labels of the Ellis ales were consigned to history.

However, those lucky enough to try a sample of the beer down at the Cornish Arms would have realised they were in fact the real deal, brewed to mark a special occasion in the modern history of the Ellis family, the marriage of Christopher Ellis' great great grandson and namesake, Chris Stephens. Crafted by St Austell's Brewing Director Roger Ryman on the Small Batch Brewery after an original recipe gleaned from the pages of the historic Ellis journals, the ale went down a storm at the reception to celebrate the marriage of Chris and Rachel at St Peter's Church at Ugborough.

However, having enjoyed the special brew on his wedding day, Chris decided it was only fair that he and his father Paul should take some bottles back to the Cornish Arms - the original Ellis Brewery Tap - to celebrate its historic link to the family during the pub's weekend festival. The moment was a particularly

poignant one for Devoran-based Paul, who has spent many years working to preserve and keep the heritage of the Ellis family alive, whose business interests started in Hayle as far back as 1815. Sampling the ale in its historic home, Chris said, "We were absolutely thrilled when Roger agreed to brew the Ellis Original for our special day. I think everyone was amazed at how good it tasted and it just felt right to bring it back down here with my father to celebrate a little bit of our family history."

Landlady Claire Williams, who took a break from getting the pub ready for the weekend's successful festivities, was joined by Cornish beer writer and journalist Darren Norbury in giving a massive thumbs up to the brew, while samples were also left for locals to try as part of the pub's



wider beer festival.

Commenting on the brew, St Austell's Roger Ryman said, "It's always a treat to be able to use historic recipes and to try to make them work in the modern day. Having the Small Batch allows us to be creative and work on special brews like this one and, while we have brewed one or two Ellis ales in

## Council Corner June & July 2017

### Town and Parish Council Elections

The local Town Council Elections took place on 4 May 2017. There has been a bit of change and we welcome three new members; Peter Nidds, Steve Benney and Ken Townend BEM. Their contact details, along with those of the other successfully re-elected members are on the back cover (p.44) of this edition of The Pump.

Sadly, the Council says goodbye to Jayne Ninnes, John Bennett, Owen Philp, Robb Lello and John Coombe who stood down due to their many other commitments. Ian Lawrence was not successful on this occasion in his bid to regain his seat on the North Ward. The Council wants to place on record its appreciation to all of those who gladly served and freely gave their time during the last term of the Council.

During the Annual Council meeting on Thursday 18 May 2017 Councillor Nick Farrar was successfully confirmed as Hayle Town Mayor and Councillor Clive Polkinghorne as Hayle Deputy Mayor for the forthcoming year.

Congratulations to both!  
Insufficient candidates stood in the South Ward and therefore no election occurred and we were left with three vacancies. By the time this has gone to press we hopefully will have co-opted 3 additional members. We will keep you posted.

### Hayle Open Air Swimming Pool

The Swimming Pool is due to open again on Saturday 24 June 2017 and will be open daily from 11am to 6pm, weather permitting, until Sunday 10 September 2017. We can confirm that entrance prices have not been increased for the fifth year in a row and once again season tickets will be available to purchase. These may all be purchased at the pool. Please note that a small passport photo is required for season tickets.

We are also pleased to be able to confirm that the Town Council is continuing free entry to the pool on Tuesdays for all residents of Hayle and/or the TR27 postal code area. However, the process will now be more tightly regulated. Free Tuesday Swim Passes may be obtained from the Clerk's office (not the pool) upon proof of residence or ID (birth certificate, passport etc) for children and a small passport size photograph will be required for each pass. These will be available from the office from Monday 19<sup>th</sup> June. In the meantime, there is much hard work being undertaken, mostly by a team of volunteers. A group of three met over the boat in March, weeded, refreshed and nourished the soil and began to plant. It is a work in progress as our plants become available and as we discover which thrive on the South Quay.

The yellow iris are in bloom around the Inner Pool and when the rhododendrons start to flower on Duck House Island the visual effect is magical.

We also have English bluebells, as opposed to Spanish hybrids, white valerian, broom rape, Lady's Smock, Italian arum, lilies and germander speedwell.

Our former gardener, Tommy Oatey's Canna lilies, planted in his memory, are also looking spectacular around the site.

With all this botanical beauty on show around the Millponds it is

sad to see how much of the rest of the area is being neglected and in particular the Inner Pond which still needs the reed overgrowth dealt with and the rubbish removed from the pond itself.

The Millponds are important historically and ecologically. The Gardens and Ropewalk date from 1776 and were the site of Harvey's original foundry. The Ponds are regarded by English Heritage as of special interest because they are the only remaining example of the

The former West Penwith Council radically altered the Inner Pond in the 1970s but it was partially restored in 1989-90 when the Foundry Flood Scheme was carried out. The Ponds are now owned by Hayle Town Council

## **NEW WELL WOMAN AND PREGNANCY YOGA CLASSES**

I have always loved yoga and in honesty there has never been any other form of embodiment that has ever compared to its benefits for me.

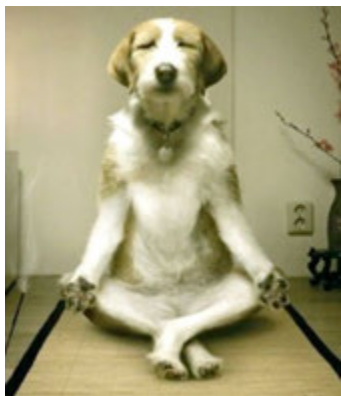
