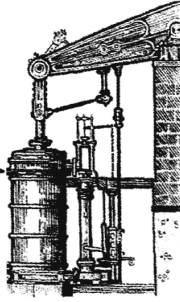
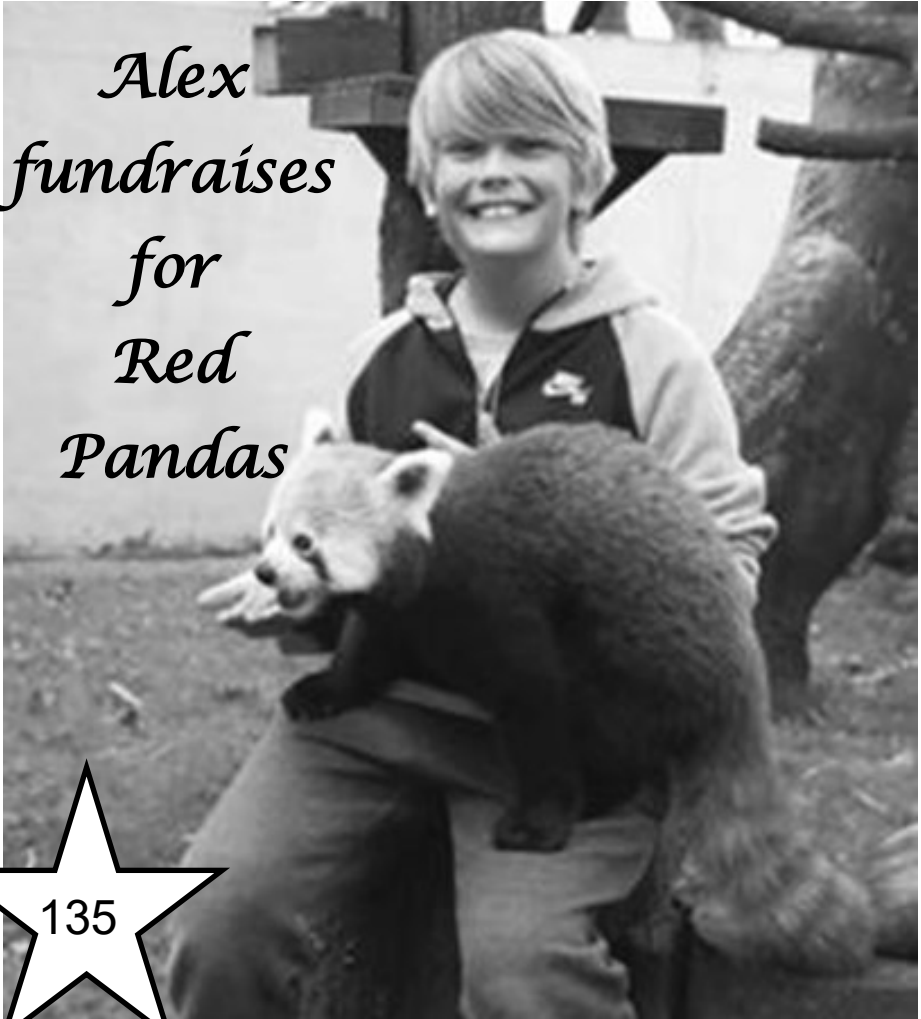

He raised the money at school to help Red Pandas, and then planned a visit to Paradise Park with his mum Loretta to actually meet his favourite animal.

Director Alison Hales comments "It was a pleasure to meet such a well-informed Red Panda enthusiast. We will pass the money on to the Red Panda Network, a charity that we fundraise for through our Red Panda Experience and other activities at the Park.

The money is helping to establish the world's first protected area dedicated to Red Pandas in Nepal. So far this summer we have raised \$1,347 dollars, which can be seen on the charity's fundraising page <https://give.redpandanetwork.org/fundraise/team?ftid=122409> - and there will be more funds to add soon!"

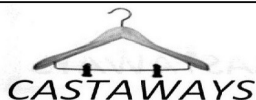

Church cemetery is the resting place of eight servicemen who died in the World Wars, by placing signs at the entrance to the cemetery on Lethlean Road.

Hayle resident and historian Chris Berry spent hours searching online archives to discover more about these local servicemen - where they lived, and how and when they died. Some of the surnames are still familiar in the Hayle area today. The names of those interred at Phillack are as follows:

BUNKER Benjamin, Private, Died 02/02/1915 aged 38, of influenza.

BURROWS John William, Sergeant, Died 07/04/1943 aged 21, killed in action.

CALLAWAY Samuel, Engine Room Artificer 1st Class, Died 01/10/1918 aged 42, of pneumonia.

JOSE Richard Arthur, Sergeant, Died 16/02/1919, aged 22, of pneumonia.

LOVE George, Private, Died 28/05/1918, aged 21, of wounds received in action.

MILLETT William Phillip Ivor, Air Apprentice, died 26/01/1946, aged 21. (No reason given.)

POPHAM William Henry, Private, Died 07/11/1919, aged 24, having been discharged from service as no longer fit for duty in August 1917.

PURCHASE Joseph Henry, Private, Died 28/03/1917, aged 18, of pneumonia.

Also buried in Phillack Cemetery are two of the four victims of a 1916 explosion at the Dynamite Works,

Gwithian. This disaster occurred just before Christmas, and two of the victims were buried on Christmas Eve. Christmas would surely never be the same for the families involved. While not servicemen, they were part of the war effort, and died doing their duty.

ROGERS Harriet Isabel aged 19

STONEMAN May Belle aged 21

Two others are buried elsewhere:

COCK James aged 62, buried at Gwithian Churchyard.

PERRY George James, aged 50 years, buried at Gwinear Church graveyard.

At the going down of the sun, and in the morning, we will remember them.

Chris Berry mentions that he could find no report of the tragedy at the Dynamite Works, despite trawling many newspaper sites. He wonders if this was deliberate, so as not to lower the morale of the people. Little is known of the details of the accident.

Chris has put together two interesting booklets with more detail than is possible in this article, including how to locate the graves. The booklets are kept in Phillack Church. My thanks to Chris for his research and allowing me to use it. The Commonwealth Graves Commission website,

www.cwgc.org, has more information on their work, including help on how to find a war grave.

Hayle in Bloom

The town as it is today looks pretty good, as it did on South West in Bloom judging day; some areas are good, and some not so good. Having said that, we have suffered from adverse weather conditions this summer and this is reflected in bee colonies falling by as much as 50%. Allotments and vegetable produce have done well, but not flowers.

It is very pleasing, and encouraging, that many more gardens and areas on main routes through Hayle are now looking well-tended and cared for. Hopefully, this progress will be continued as other local towns are 'raising the bar' so that in West Cornwall there is the biggest concentration by area of Bloom

members and competition entries than anywhere in the country!

To assist with, and encourage this progress, Hayle Town Council has invited Hayle in Bloom to join a study tour of the town in order to identify areas which can be targeted for improvement.

There are, of course, a number of 'small' areas that spring to mind, e.g. the areas adjacent to the bridge on North Quay, but there are major improvement projects also. One that springs to mind is the Millpond area in Foundry, which, if ecologically developed and properly managed could become a community and tourist attraction to be proud of. Our local history is something to be envied.

Mayor's Sponsored Walk

Despite the rain over 70 people participated in the sponsored walk on Sunday 3 September to raise funds for Cornwall Hospice Care, incorporating St Julia's Hospice. Money is still coming in and it seems likely that over £5,000 will be raised. Thank you to everyone who took part in or supported the Mayor's Sponsored Walk. It is not too late to donate to this important fundraising event so please keep the money coming in!

Hayle Open Air Swimming Pool

The pool finally closed on 24 September following an extension for two extra weekends, which rounded off a very successful 2017 season. The extensive refurbishments, including the new entrance, new windows and doors, and the repainting of fences and benches, were worth all the hard work put in by staff and volunteers. The new solar covers successfully often raised the water temperature to a balmy 25 to 26 degrees Celsius, with the lowest recorded being 21 degrees. Final usage figures for the pool are expected to be over 5,000 users, many of whom had season

tickets. The Tuesday evenings adult only lane swimming proved to be a great success and that and the hiring of the pool on Saturday evenings by the local surf lifesaving club for club training increased the usage and profile of the pool. Tuesdays by and large were the busier days due to the continuation of the free Tuesday passes for TR27 residents.

Recreation Ground

The installation of the new inclusive play roundabout at the Recreation Ground has unfortunately been delayed, but we hope that it will be available in November.

CCTV

The two additional CCTV cameras have now been installed by SSE. They cover the Recreation Ground and the far end of Copperhouse and the Penpol Terrace, harbour and Jubilee Bridge areas.

This year's event will take place on Sunday 8 October and as usual the Parade will meet and form in the Commercial Road Car Park from 2.30pm. PAINT THE TOWN JEWSON

Since the Bronze Age, circa 1500-2000 BC when the Irish and the Bretons sent their ships up the Heyl River trading for tin, and well into the Iron Age, there has been someone sitting on the banks of the river willing to do a deal.

ducklings and we now have over sixty birds in our resident flock. It is with a sense of great sadness that we realise that we have lost one of our two Cayuga drakes. He has disappeared from the Swan Pool where they have lived since they arrived on the Millponds in 2012. We have no idea what has happened to him, but according to Facebook his mate was washed into the Penpol Outfall and rescued by the RSPCA. He was returned to the pond and is none the worse for his experience. We will miss his friend because Cayugas are rare ducks even in America where they were originally bred.

Our winter flock of black-headed gulls will start to arrive very shortly from their reserve in Wales together

The Arum lilies have produced spikes of red berries and the hedgerow by the river has a good crop of hops. Unfortunately we still haven't got our play equipment back. How about an early Christmas present for our toddlers? Please!

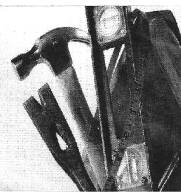

Monday we all went to Saint Quay Portreix, while some went around the market others went sailing on the boat Saint Quay, this was for two hours.

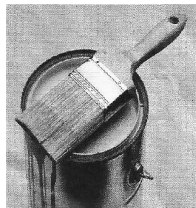

Brian would have loved to have been here today, knowing that the continuation of his endless work of promoting Hayle will be carried forward in the capable hands of the current President of the Old Cornwall Society, Trevor Smitheram, who organised this ceremony dedicating the bench. It was attended by Mayor Nick Farrar, Brian's family and many friends who afterwards celebrated with a pasty at the |White Hart.

A Little Cornish Story from Barry:

Denzil Pentelow, an elderly Cornish farmer, received a letter from the Department for Work & Pensions stating that they suspected he was

not paying his employees the statutory minimum wage and they would send an inspector to interview them. On the appointed day, the inspector turned up. "Tell me about your staff," he asked Denzil. "Well," said Denzil, "there's the farm hand, I pay him £420 a week, and he has a free cottage. Then there's the housekeeper. She gets £290 a week, along with free board and lodging. There's also the half-wit. He works a 16 hour day, does 90% of the work, earns about £25 a week along with a bottle of whisky and, as a special treat, occasionally gets to sleep with my wife." "That's disgraceful" said the inspector, "I need to interview the half-wit." "That'll be me then," said Denzil.



Rick Rescorla...his young days in Hayle. The personal story.

On the green in Penpol Terrace in Hayle, opposite the house where he was born, stands Hayle's memorial to local boy Rick Rescorla. Rick was killed in the terrorist attack on the World Trade Centre, in New York in 2001. At least 3,000 people were killed on that day, the biggest loss of life in a single event in American history. Rick is officially reported to have saved 2,700 of his fellow employees.

The white granite stone stands in a beautiful setting, overlooking Penpol Creek, where Rick spent many happy hours as a youngster, listening to his grandfather's tales of his young days. Thanks must go to the Hayle Harbour Company of that time for giving permission to erect the memorial there, and to the dedicated gardening team for maintaining the site.

BUT...this was not the scene in Rick's and my early days....when growing up during World War Two, Hayle was a very different place. There were no flowers, no well-attended gardens and very little, if any, greenery to be seen throughout the town. Hayle was totally committed to the Second

World War effort, Harvey & Co., South Quay, East Quay, North Quay, the Electricity Generating Station (better known locally as the electric works), the ICI and the ESSO Petroleum Co were working continuously 24 hours a day, as was the huge J and F Pool works in Copperhouse. Hundreds of men and women, even entire families, were committed to the “must win” effort. The town was very noisy, smoky, dusty, buzzing to this massive cause. And during this time Hayle’s population was swollen by two units of the American Army. One of these was comprised of engineers building very large Rhino ferries on some 20 odd slipways on the Weir. These flat top ferries were to carry tanks, guns and lorries to the Normandy landing beaches of

northern France. The officers were billeted in Riviere House and in Penmere House, and the junior ranks were in tents on the Copperhouse playing field. So Rick, then known by his Christian name Cyril, and myself grew up in a town full of soldiers. The American soldiers were very friendly and would happily hand out chewing gum and sweets to the local children. Older Hayle residents of my age will never forget the parties that they put on in the Drill Hall for the children. Food that we had never seen before and would not see again until long after the war had finished. Bananas, oranges, hot dogs, doughnuts and large chocolates filled with strawberry and orange cream etc.

Jeeps and army lorries filled the streets. Then one day without notice, every American soldier departed to the Normandy landings and the next day the town fell eerily empty. The next day very many of those young friendly soldiers, whose last home was Hayle, would lie dead on blood-stained beaches of France. Boys too young to die, but old enough to give their lives for us...R.I.P.

Rick was so impressed by the American army, that years later as a teenager he said that, one day he

would become a US soldier and join the 5th Cavalry, once led by General Custer. This of course in later life he did, and went on to fight and get highly decorated in the Vietnam War in the 1960s.

Cyril's grandfather Steve Rescorla and my mother both worked in the power station during the war and that is where I first met him. At about the age of six or seven we would stand outside highly defended gates waiting for his grandfather and my

mother finish long hours of work, and we would all walk home past the ICI works whose long high surrounding wall, about half the length of North Quay, was covered with thousands of pieces of broken coloured glass. This was intended to stop anyone getting into this very important factory producing special chemicals being used in wartime bomber and fighter aircraft.

This was the start of a lifelong friendship that would last for more than sixty years, until that world-changing day when Rick was killed on September 11th 2001...forever to be known as 9/11.
