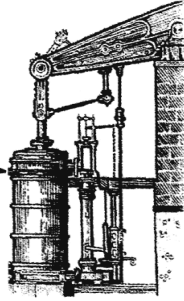

Council Vacancy

Library Service Devolution

Regular in-depth discussions with Cornwall Council regarding the possibility of taking on a library service in Hayle continued and in November 2017 the town council decided to take on the service at its current location from April 2019.

2018/2019 Precept Demand

Hayle Town Council's Precept will increase this year by 4.48%, which equates to a £6.00 increase per Band D property compared to last year. The final Precept for 2018/19 is £439,742. The figures include £5,000 towards the War Memorial project and an increase of £1,000 in support of the

Hayle Neighbourhood Plan

The Regulation 16 Consultation on Hayle's Neighbourhood Plan finished on 11 January 2018 and the plan has been passed to an Independent Inspector who will review it, together with any comments received. This phase is expected to take about two months and when completed the plan will go to referendum, probably around April 2018, assuming it is found to be satisfactory and requiring little change.

will be passed to the Independent Examiner. Cornwall Council has appointed Mrs McCann as the Examiner. She has already examined five Cornish plans, including St. Ives.

She will commence her deliberations at the end of January and we hope to hear back in February.

Once we are all in agreement, the Plan will go to a referendum of all Hayle registered voters. A majority vote in favour will approve the Plan, which will then be adopted by Cornwall Council. Hayle will then have additional protection on certain aspects of planning and will start to receive a higher percentage of the Community Infrastructure Levy that will be spent on Hayle projects.

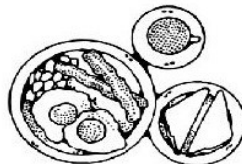

Millpond Update



Once again the festive season has come and gone, but the

rough weather was unfortunately still with us. Storms Eleanor and Dylan brought in the New Year, but at least we escaped the blizzards for the time being.

'Be careful what you wish for' is a phrase that could be applied to the work carried out along the Rope Walk! The Millponds were declared as a 'Heritage Site at Risk' by English Heritage and instead of the proposed clean-up of the Brass Foundry and the two pits, all the trees along the Nature Trail have

been removed. The entire site has lost its unique character. Its history and wildlife have happily co-existed for over thirty years making it a special place to visit and enjoy. It has been sheer overkill and totally unnecessary and has probably left the walls much more vulnerable by the removal of the ground cover along the path. Sad to note we have lost rare plants, our 1979 Dedication Tree, three Memorial Trees, planted in memory of friends of the site who have died, and the willow beside the Jute Pit which grew from a willow-wand put into the ground in 1916 when the Rope Walk was closed down. All these gems are irreplaceable and will be sorely missed.

We have not yet heard about any of the work needed to tackle the overgrowth on the Inner Pond. A

Status Report has been submitted to Heritage and we can only hope that a more sympathetic approach will be taken than was used on the Rope Walk, but they will have to take our wildlife into consideration whatever they eventually do.

The heavy rain which fell over the New Year has raised the levels of the river and leat, but the water is clean and virtually silt-free. We still have over sixty ducks in residence.

Hector, our heron, is now visiting regularly but we do now have a very special visitor. The young buzzard which we first saw in the autumn is now living on site. It has been seen and photographed by our Millponders along with some other winter migrants including our merlin, which is also back with us until the spring.

In the interest of wildlife health and tidiness PLEASE put your plastic bottles and bags in the bins provided. Thank you!

Finally, our Christmas Set Piece has just been taken down and we would like to thank Hayle Decorative Lights for the annual display on the wall of the Swan Pool.

HAYLE HERITAGE CENTRE



We are starting 2018 here at the heritage centre with some exciting news!

Amid torrential downpours, a monumental event took place on Thursday 15th December when the Cunaide Stone, a 5th Century Christian burial stone previously housed in a wall at Plantation (displayed there in the 19th Century by Henry Harvey), was removed and brought inside the Heritage Centre. The Trust had applied for and was granted Scheduled Monument Consent in October, with the aim of preserving and protecting the stone which has long been listed 'at risk'.

Specialist Stone Conservators Kelland Conservation, under the supervision of Historic England, spent the day delicately removing cement from around the stone, which revealed itself to be in four substantial pieces. Each section, with a depth far greater than anticipated, was gently removed and hoisted into a trailer. The bottom of the base section was buried almost two feet underground.

Back at the Heritage Centre the heavy sections were lifted into a designated room with a stable environment in which the stone will rest until the spring. Paper pulp was applied to absorb any moisture. In March, Kelland Conservation will

return to begin remedial conservation work; it's hoped that the text on the stone will become clearer. Once this work is complete, a bespoke frame will be made to display the stone as part of an exciting new exhibition opening this summer.

The new exhibition will display artefacts that have never been seen before by the public exploring a time frame from the Neolithic period to early Christianity, the exhibition will be supported by family friendly workshops tours and talks.

food inaccessible. You may see wigeon, various geese, curlew, golden plovers, redshanks, greenshanks, lapwings, and even a spoonbill, among others. Recently, a kestrel has been seen at Copperhouse Pool and a red-throated diver at Carnsew. New birds are always turning up so keep an eye out and let us know what you see.

Litterpicks are held at all the local RSPB sites, recently clearing a large amount of rubbish, including bottles and cans, which are recycled. It is a satisfying way to spend a few hours. Watch the RSPB website and local press for news of further events. The Biffa waste disposal company has helped out, which is greatly appreciated. The RSPB are always looking for more volunteers to help protect nature and there are many ways to help, get in touch if you want to do your bit.

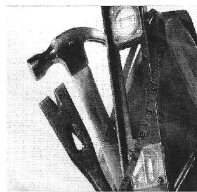

Ventonleague Chapel

(Minister Rev. J.B. Seddings)

In 1872 the United Methodists in
Hayle formed a Sunday School.
From this Sunday School grew
Ventonleague Chapel, (Methodist
Free Church) which opened circa
1875/76. The very active fellowship

at the Chapel produced many good Preachers such as Tommy Clemens, Cyril Williams and Harry Rutter, to name but a few within living memory. Just after the 2nd World War,



Ventonleague Chapel became famous for its Ventonleague Male Voice Choir. One of the Choir members, Mr Archie Trevillion, (nicknamed “the Singing Milkman”), delivered fresh milk each day by horse and cart.

Once we heard his singing, we knew he was on his way. My mother would take out her milk jug, Archie would dip a pint measuring jug into one of the milk churns on the back of the cart and fill the milk jug with fresh, warm, frothy, unpasteurised, full cream milk; however did we survive (healthwise), in those days? During renovations in 1989 Mr Andy Badcock found large Scoria Blocks in the walls of Ventonleague Chapel; these Scoria blocks probably originated from the famous “Cornish Copper Company” Smelting Works established in Ventonleague circa 1756. (It was the C.C.C. that built the Wesley Round Chapel in Copperhouse in 1785) By the year 2009 Ventonleague Chapel had survived the demolition of

Rick Rescorla

The personal
story by Mervyn
Sullivan

RETURN VISITS TO HAYLE

On leaving school Rick joined the Post Office Telephone Company and stayed with them until being called up for National Service. After something like twelve years of friendship and seeing him on virtually a daily basis when he left Hayle to join the army, I didn't see him again for many years. With his many educational qualifications Rick was made an officer in the Army Intelligence Corps based in Cyprus. Also doing National Service at the same time in Cyprus was another Hayle boy, Terry Mungles. Terry recalls that one day he was told to report to headquarters to be questioned by an Intelligence Officer. Terry could think of nothing that he had done wrong but his knees were knocking as he tapped on the office door. On being told to enter, Terry's fears melted away as he saw Tammy sitting behind the desk. They had been playing rugby for Hayle only a few months before.

"Hi Terry, I saw you were here in Cyprus and just called you in to say hello. Cup of tea?"

"No! I need a very large whisky!"....

Rick joined the Metropolitan Police, based in London, but he said that there was not enough action for him so he transferred to Africa's

Rhodesian Police, but his lifelong ambition to join the American Army had got the better of him. He made the move to the States. He took American nationality and joined the famous 7th Cavalry. Being a cowboy film lover in his younger days, it had to be General Custer's outfit that he would join.

In the mid sixties Rick was sent to serve in Vietnam and was involved in one of the bloodiest battles in American history. The battle of the Ia Drang Valley in which he was a platoon leader. He made it his business to know every soldier in his unit personally, along with their family connections back home in the States and treated every one of them as his brother. It is reported that he sang Cornish songs as signals and to keep up the morale of his men. The strains of Trelawney, Lamorna, 'The White Rose' and 'Going up Camborne Hill' were never put to better use. He was known as Hardcore, a name given to him by General Hal Moore as he said that Rick was the hardest soldier that he had ever fought with. A best selling book of this battle showed a photograph of Rick in the heat of the battle on the front cover.

This was to become the iconic photograph of the Vietnam war. The best selling book entitled 'We were Soldiers Once and Young' has since been made in to a film starring Mel Gibson. Mel Gibson's picture has now replaced Rick's on the front cover of the book!

On returning to the USA Rick put

himself through university, qualifying as a lawyer before joining the Morgan Stanley Bank as a Vice President based in twenty two floors of the South Tower of the World Trade Centre in New York. The rest of his career is history.

In the ten years or so before he was killed, Rick made many return visits to Hayle to see his mother, Sissy, and to catch up with relations and friends old and new: Cousin John Daniels who was running the Cornish Arms along with his wife Sally and daughter Charley, Margaret and husband Chris Stumbles, Anthony "Titchy" Bawden, Helen and Geraldine up Connor Downs. Rick tried to get around to see family friends and as many old acquaintances as possible. He spent a lot of time in the Cornish

talking about the old rugby days. Rick had such a compelling awe about him that wherever he was he seemed to attract a crowd. Whether it because of his physical size and his willingness to discuss any subject with anyone, I don't know. He would visit friends such as Shirley Hubbard and her sisters Nora and Joan of Penpol Terrace fish and chip shop (run in my young days by their mother and father, and known lovingly as Papa Hoskings); Surely one of the oldest family businesses in Hayle. I have many fascinating stories about Rick's visits home. His mother Sissy, a well-known character in the Penpol area, was never interested in Rick's amazing life away. Lighting up a cigarette she would say "Aw, guss on, I don't believe a word of it...it's only

ee showing off." But, inside, she was happy that her boy was home again with her. A true mother's love for her child.

On another night we were having a drink in the White Hart when Rick asked me about a dear old Hayle rugby friend of his, Stanley Sullivan (no relation to me). I told him that Stanley was now very frail, blind and was in the Bonaer Nursing Home, just up the road.

"Right, let's get some Guinness and go up and see him."

"Rick, it's ten o'clock...it's a bit late". "Look, I'm back to America tomorrow and this may be the last time I see him, we're going".

Rick explained the position to the night staff and they let us in for a "few minutes as long as we were quiet". Stanley was still awake and laying back on his bed.

"Stanley." "Is that you Tammy?" The drinks were opened and Rick sat Stanley up on the bed, supporting him with a large arm around his shoulder. I sat at the foot of the bed. "Right Stanley" said Rick, "strike up!" - the very signal that Stanley needed to start singing. As 'The White Rose' was only part way through, I had to stop singing when tears of happiness began rolling down from the blind eyes of a very old man singing with his close friend, Tammy. Outside Stanley's open door, other elderly people, along with members of the staff, joined the Cornish singing. Stanley died some time later ...

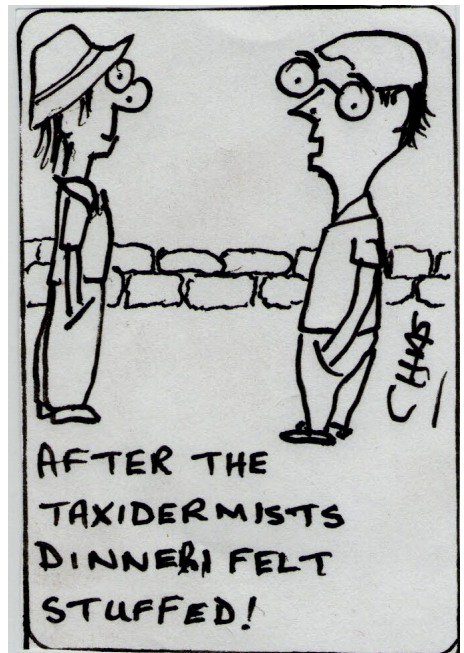
