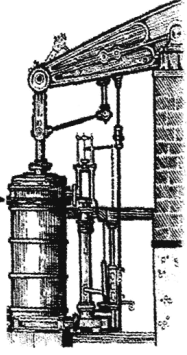

Mayor's Annual Awards

Presentations of the awards took place during the Annual Council meeting on Thursday 10 May 2018 at Hayle Day Care Centre.

Mr John Broadbridge was selected as Male Citizen of the Year 2018/2019, posthumously. John was selected for his work for the Hayle Lions Club, most recently as President, running the fun day almost singlehandedly and acting as Santa. He also helped Hayle in Bloom, Marie Curie nursing and the Hayle

Food Bank. He was also involved with the counting for the Poppy Appeal and had previously been very involved with scouting in the town. Sadly, John had died in February so the shield was presented to his wife, son and daughter.

The Mayor presented the award for Female Citizen of the Year 2018/2019 to Mrs Alison Stuckey for her working extremely hard on a voluntary basis, in a variety of roles, for Hayle Day Care Centre. She is also heavily involved with the local U3A and was previously involved with the Hayle Twinning Association and Save Our Sands.

Macmillan Cancer Support Hayle Committee was chosen to receive this year's award as Organization of the Year for their efforts to raise money

for Macmillan Cancer Support, with raising over £14,000 in 2017 for The Cove at RCHT, Treliske. The small committee had formed over 30 years ago and now comprised a wider group of friends which organized regular coffee mornings and sales as well as an annual ball.

The Mayor chose Hayle RFC Colts as the Youth Organization of the Year 2018/2019. The newly formed team recently played in and won the Cornwall plate competition 24- 7. Everyone was informed that this was the first year of the new Colts team, following amalgamation with Helston and a few players from St Ives and that there had been a shaky start to the season but then they had started to win games. Hayle War Memorial Project

The Council has obtained planning consent, had the site transferred and registered, worked up a scheme and most recently appointed a contractor to upgrade the War Memorial. It is anticipated that work will commence in June and be completed before the summer holidays. The idea was to enhance the area, give the memorial more presence and to prevent cars from parking in the surrounding area. The memorial will be cleaned, the lettering repointed and a name will be corrected. Granite cobbles will be laid and some railings installed. All of the work will be completed prior to the centenary which marks the end of the First World War.

slightly less steep but they can still use it which is the important thing. It would be good if we could find them another one so that more of them could bask and enjoy the summer sun.

We still have about fifteen ducks left on the pond. Ky, our Cayuga, is still with us. He is still a colourful character and I am sure that we will be blessed by a few more, so we keep our fingers crossed. The happiest additions to our family are five ducklings. They are at least a week old and look very healthy. We do not seem to have much of a seagull population this year so they could all survive.

Spring is beginning to turn into summer. The yellow iris are beginning to bloom as are the marsh marigolds and red campions. Some of the ferns are starting to grow back

along the Rope Walk and the yellow dead-nettle has also survived. This is one of our rarer plants so it is a great relief to see it growing again. We have seen some Holly Blue butterflies and a few dragon and damsel flies during the very warm weather which is a good start. We still have a lot of water going through the river and the leat but the pond water is very clean and the pond weed and waterlilies are

Spring took a long time coming, but it was worth the wait. The wayside hedgerows have been glorious, awash with primroses, violets, and many other wild flowers and plants. Sloe blossom (Blackthorn) was particularly exuberant. I enjoy early morning walks around Copperhouse Pool with my dog, taking in the scents, sounds and sights of a new day. One morning, three pure white little egrets flew elegantly over my head, silent and graceful, and catching the first rays of sunlight. A beautiful sight! Many of the wintering birds have flown away to Greenland, Iceland and Scandinavia, but new passage birds like whimbrel arrive every day. A beautiful pair of shelduck (Britain's largest duck) can often be seen at Copperhouse and I suspect they may be sitting on a nest nearby. With luck we will see ducklings soon enough.

Walking at Ryan's Field, near the bird hide, I was intrigued to see that the many dog poops (sadly left by irresponsible owners) had been

The last time I saw Rick, before his untimely death, was when I drove him back to Penzance railway station after a home visit.

It was 5 o'clock in the morning and as the train was about to pull away he stood in the open doorway, raised his huge arm with a clenched fist, his challenging pose, and shouted at the top of his voice.. Kernow Bys VykenCornwall For Ever.

The echoes bounced around the station. The door slammed and he was gone.

Summing up.. What an amazing life.

Joined General Custer's 7th Cavalry. Highly decorated in the Ia Drang battle in the Vietnam War.

institution, Morgan Stanley Dean Witter.

Became a Vice President. It occupied twenty two floors of the South Tower, with a staff of nearly six thousand employees.

He was officially the last person out of the South Tower after an underground bombing in 1993. After that, he was videoed warning of a likely aerial attack on the World Trade Centre.

On 9/11/2001 (11th Sept 2001) the attack happened as he had predicted, on the North Tower, Rick put into operation his much rehearsed escape procedure. In doing so some 2,700 Morgan Stanley employees working that day escaped from the South Tower building and got safely away before the building collapsed, killing some 3,000 people.

After his fellow employees were safe he went back into the building to try and help others escape, but he was killed when the South Tower collapsed.

He is a household name in the USA for his actions on that fateful day. Many TV programmes have been made about him, and another best-selling book, *The Heart of a Soldier*, has been published.

The American Army Training Camp where Rick was an instructor after he returned from Vietnam, has erected a larger than life bronze statue of him. The California Opera Company made a production about him which has played across America.

His widow Susan still gives talks about Rick all over America. He is still pictured in papers and national

magazines some 17 years after that terrible event.

Here in Hayle there is a large granite and bronze memorial to him on Penpol Terrace, opposite to the house where he was born, and his name will be remembered forever, as the Great Western Railway have honoured him by naming one of their new high speed trains after him.

Also the unveiling ceremony of his name is to take place at Hayle station later this year.

An amazing man – amazing life. Hayle and Cornwall are proud of you Cyril Richard Rescorla.

Goodbye my friend, **Kernow Bys Vyken.**

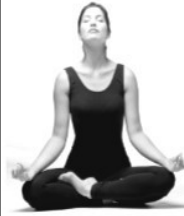
