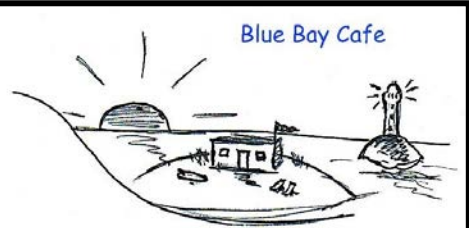

life to create I always move between disciplines: painting, drawing, metalsmithing, photography, portraiture, ceramics, figure drawing, mural painting, lamp-working, glass sculpture, collage, video, jewellery — because there isn't time *not* to.

The thought of being stuck in one stratum absolutely abhors me.

And why does art have to be so serious? Can't artists admit they love the ability to conjure up something never before seen on the planet? My favourite method at present is to use party poppers to explode paint onto a surface. Fantastic results!

The late actor Jeremy Brett supported me for a year by buying my Sherlock Holmes postcards to send out to his fans. I produced 130 portraits of celebrities, then they became less fashionable so I switched to collage. Changing direction gives a boost to my creativity.

I know I am a jack of all trades. Every few years I have a massive burn up of all the accumulated work I am dissatisfied with, or feel I have moved beyond, but I always keep back the best. The ash doesn't go to waste because I mix it into acrylic paint for the creation of new pieces. A new idea is the '4-Way Hanging'. No details will be revealed here, but it increases a painting's potential. None of my paintings is sold framed. The first exhibit is the catalogue itself. Hand-made, with several pages like a retro-style scrapbook. The first 100 copies (numbered and signed) have a piece of an original painting pocketed inside. This might be a unique idea.

After the “Beast from the East” we have now been blessed with a month’s worth of tropical

sunshine which our turtles have spent their time avoiding. They have only been coming out of the shade early in the morning or in the cool of the evening because it was too warm for them to bask normally.

With the passing of midsummer our drakes have started to return to the Millponds as the breeding season ended. Our fifteen residents have now become over sixty as the boys come home to moult and prepare for next spring. Our ducklings have all survived and have now been joined by four more which were hatched on the river and three moorhen chicks. Our reduced seagull population has certainly helped. We only have less than a dozen visiting us regularly and only one breeding pair.

The Upper Swan Pool is still very clean. The water lilies are now in bloom and look quite spectacular. The dragonflies are still with us and our larger Carp and Black Tench are

There is always something to see at the RSPB Copperhouse Pool.

It might be the swans doing early morning flights in huge circles overhead, their wings whistling as they go. Or pure white egrets paddling in the shallows. Or a noisy mob of dozens of gulls taking exception to a stately heron passing through their territory. And one morning, a roe deer, running and leaping through the tidal pools, from Jubilee Bridge to Black Bridge and beyond. That was a truly exciting Nature Watch!

Last time I mentioned the shelducks, and several weeks later I heard that they had indeed been nesting, not in the Pool, but on the Towans. Mama Shelduck brought her family of ten to the pool by the shortest route, i.e. through a Glebe Row resident's garden, from which they could not get out. Eventually, the kindly home

owner allowed them to exit via his house. I hope they thrived. The nine mallard duckling on the Hayle River were cute as buttons, too.

A Pacific golden plover was seen on the estuary in June and July, only the 5th recorded sighting of this species in Cornwall. **Many birds are now returning to the estuary. Recent sightings include** black-tailed godwits, common sandpipers, dunlins, shelducks, little egret, whimbrels, greenshanks, barnacle goose, grey plover, wood sandpiper, Mediterranean gulls and curlews. Harret from RSPB in Penzance will be visiting Hayle in August/September, meeting the locals and giving them the opportunity to help shape community work RSPB are planning. She will be on the lookout for volunteers to help, particularly a Volunteer Co-ordinator, and people to help with her surveys.

RSPB will have a presence at upcoming events – Hayle Harbour Fest, Hayle Carnival, and family Fun Days at Lands End and Marazion. They will be promoting Wild Challenge, a great way to learn more about nature.
