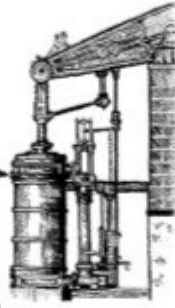

Hayle Unearthed!

Relaunch and New Exhibition at Hayle Heritage Centre

Hayle Heritage Centre will be celebrating its reopening with an Open Weekend on Saturday and Sunday the 13th and 14th April.

Everyone is welcome and entry is free.

New for 2019 is an exhibition covering the early history of Hayle from the Stone Age to the 5th Century CE. For the first time visitors will be able to see the mysterious 5th century engraved burial stone, the 'Cunaide' stone - the oldest burial stone discovered in Cornwall to date. The stone was first unearthed on the Plantation in the nineteenth-century by Henry Harvey's workmen and was eventually placed on Historic England's 'Heritage at Risk' register until conservators, staff and volunteers at the Heritage Centre came to the rescue. The huge stone is part of a wider exhibition telling the history of Hayle from Neolithic times, through the Bronze and Iron Ages to Roman Britain and the Anglo Saxons.

With archaeological finds, children's activities and the conservation story – as well as the stone itself - the new exhibition has something for everyone.

Based on Foundry Square, Hayle Heritage Centre is housed within the Grade II* listed former offices of Harvey & Co, the nineteenth-century engineering powerhouse famous for production of the Cornish Beam Engine.

Council Vacancy

The council is confident that a new councillor will have been co-opted into post, by the time of going to press. We will keep you posted and introduce the new councillor in the next edition of Council Corner.

Former Town Councillors

The council was sorry to learn of the recent deaths of two former councillors, Peter Hampson and Chris Head. Our thoughts are with their families.

During his time on the town council, Peter was always passionate and a great supporter of the swimming pool and played a major part in finding a new home for Hayle Bowling Club.

Chris was instrumental in securing the town's skate bowl and kindly updated the council's logo, using his IT and design skills.

Civil Enforcement Role

We are pleased to confirm that the town council has entered into a service level agreement with Cornwall Council to provide an enhanced civil enforcement service in the town. A new role has been created which will provide a bespoke multi-skilled civil enforcement service for Hayle to address the concerns that residents have raised. The officer will patrol,

by foot and by vehicle, the town and will gather evidence with respect to all environmental crime offences and issue Penalty Notices, if appropriate. The officer will work the equivalent of 2.5 days per week on a flexible rota and will be able to manage and address issues such as parking offences, litter dropping, dog fouling and enforce the dog bans on the relevant beaches. The town council has listened to the community and is hoping that this will improve the local environment but we will need your help and intelligence to capitalise on this new venture. If you are aware of someone that repeatedly parks on double yellow lines please report it direct to Cornwall Council so that the officer is aware and equally, please let us know, about dog fouling and litter hotspots and patterns so that we can share that information with the officer.

I witnessed a beautiful sight recently. I was walking my dog near the bird hide at Ryan's Field, and a bird-watcher there had a fine telescope. She spied a spoonbill across the marsh, and allowed me a look. At that very moment, a second spoonbill alighted alongside the first, and they instantly started courting, caressing each other's necks and stretching high before each other. It was lovely to see, and I felt a little guilty that the kind lady missed seeing it.

Birds of prey have been a common sight recently. If you hear a great noise from a large gathering of airborne gulls, you can bet that a hapless buzzard is somewhere in the crowd, being dive-bombed and screamed at by the mob. And they persist, until the buzzard has moved out of their perceived territory.

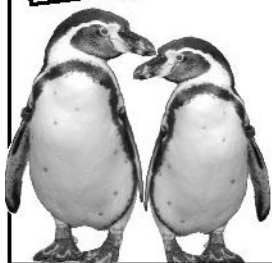
A kestrel is often seen hovering over Copperhouse, then moving on in a short swift flight before hovering again. Occasionally he will 'fall' to the ground to grab his prey, if he's lucky.

And heard but not seen, owls have been frequent callers at dawn.

A more unusual bird visitor was a Glossy Ibis, seen briefly at Ryan's Field. These large exotic birds have been seen in several sites across

In 2008 a 10-year plan for renovating the Institute was prepared – starting with repairing the leaking roof. All of the projects identified in the plan are now complete except for restoring the cast iron railings that were removed in the Second World War. There are detailed drawings of the original design and a quote for the project from a local historical cast iron specialist. Currently, the railing fund has over £1,700. Unfortunately, around £16,000 is still needed to install railings that will last for many decades. Consequently, the Institute is doing as many fund raising activities as possible and looking for generous donors to help.

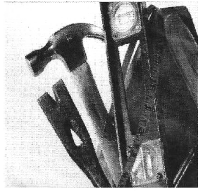

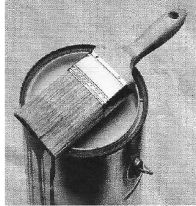

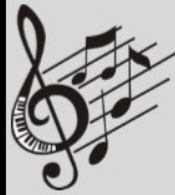


Richard Barber is the new chairman of Hayle in Bloom. He is 42 years
