On Saturday 8th June please join us for the low-stakes drama and buddy comedy **CAN YOU EVER FORGIVE ME?**, starring Melissa McCarthy and Richard E. Grant, both nominated for acting Oscars and Baftas. This is the bizarre true story of misanthropic cat-loving New York writer Lee Israel who started trading in literary forgeries when demand for her trademark biographies dries up. Lounge lizard Grant is her partner in crime.

Later in the month, on Thursday 20th June, we'll present our only foreign-language film of the summer, the extraordinary social-realist drama **CAPERNAUM**, in which a streetwise 12-year-old boy in Beirut takes his negligent parents to court (*in Arabic, with English subtitles*).

Then on Saturday 13th July it's back to comedy-drama with the very quirky **SOMETIMES ALWAYS NEVER** starring the always dependable Bill Nighy as a dapper tailor searching for his missing son Michael who fled 10 years earlier -- over a game of Scrabble. If you enjoy the gentle, stylised films of Wes Anderson (*The Grand Budapest Hotel, Moonrise Kingdom* et al), then this one's for you: offbeat yet very English.

Finally, on Thursday 25th July we end the season with the heart-stopping

1970s Harlem love story **IF BEALE STREET COULD TALK**, based on James Baldwin's novel that interweaves prejudice and oppression with love, loss and transcendence -- a beautiful and heartfelt film.

As usual, we'll take a break in August and look forward to seeing you in September with a fresh programme of some of the most interesting films released in UK cinemas over the past year.

All screenings take place upstairs at the Passmore Edwards Institute and begin promptly at 7.30pm. Tickets are £5 per person (£4 for members; membership is just £7.50 per year). Millpond Update

As you walk around the Millponds you will realise that it is “Iris



Time” again, with the banks of both ponds adorned with bright yellow irises and the purple blossoms on the Ponticums on Duck House Island. This is always regarded as the true sign of the arrival of Spring, together

with bluebells and primroses flowering along the banks. We still have the true English bluebells growing on site, rather than the Spanish imports which have replaced them in our gardens.

We have also had our first ducklings. Six were hatched but regrettably five have been taken by the seagulls. We hope that we might get another brood and that they will do better. I will make the point, in answer to a question which was asked, that the turtles would not hurt ducklings. Our turtles are vegetarians and since they arrived in 1897 they have shared the pond with a goodly number of ducks and ducklings over the past century without any problems.

As regards to our other resident wildlife, all the species of birds, animals, trees and plants have been listed since 1986 and in total 720 species have been catalogued, either as seasonal visitors or resident on site. Any work or regular maintenance must take the wildlife into account and take care not to do them any harm. The Millponds are their home and they have a right to be there.

Odin has now been "King of the Ponds" for four months now and it was good to see our heron paying a visit to the Inner Pond. There is a lot of work going on along the Rope Walk and we still are not sure when they will have completed the renovations, so the Nature Walk will not always be open to visitors for a while yet. We will eventually get

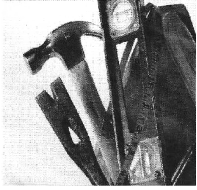

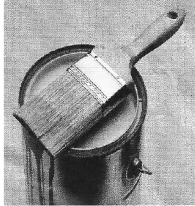

overhead although this has not been welcomed by the local gull population. The spoonbills that spent the winter around the estuary have returned to their summer breeding grounds, most likely in the Netherlands. In June keep an eye out for shelduck with their ducklings around Copperhouse Pool.

Heyl Seizure!

by Roy Phillips

In the olden days before I was hatched in 1930 and in even older, olden days before industrialisation encroached from every direction, Hayle (Heyl) estuary must have been a paradise for birds. It would have been the same for birders too, although most would have seen them over the sights of a gun. With no causeway road, no Carnsew, no quays, no main or St. Ives branch railway lines, and the whole extensive area tidal up past St. Erth and Copperhouse, it would have been a vast expanse of salt water at high tide and an equally vast expanse of glorious mudflats at low tide. There

was so much water flowing in and out that the river mouth and flats were naturally dredged and the main channel deep enough for ships to reach where Griggs Quay was later built. Most of the encroachment was long before my time and one would have hoped that that was the end of it.

After the demise of mining and smelting with the pollution they brought, the estuary became comparatively clean, yet still with much arsenic and heavy metals lying there deep in the mud, accruing value. There it may have rested. Wishful thinking, for it was not to last.

In my time, the coal-fired power station was bad enough, dropping black smuts on white washing hung out to dry, but the ICI chemical works for extracting bromide from the sea polluted the river and the Copperhouse arm of the estuary with unseen chlorine. All denied by them, of course. It was for some other reason that the mud was sterile with no invertebrates for the birds to feed on. I had a job working on the chemical works when it was shut down for a complete overhaul of the system. Within weeks that part of the estuary which had been utterly barren of life became bright green with the resurgent growth of first colonising algae (seaweed). Life was returning until the plant started up again, when the weed and all the invertebrate life it supported were again eliminated until both power station and chemical works were closed and demolished.

I first became familiar with the estuary in the years of WW2. The family boats were laid up for winter by Lelant Railway station, where the flats opposite were covered in welded-iron flat-bottomed barges, made on site, ready for towing across for France on D Day, We went to

school in Hayle by train from St. Ives and I always sat by the window to see what birds were there. Going to school I might scan the mud flats, and coming home the salt marsh at Lelant, which is now under toxic household rubbish and a cosmetic football pitch. The latter was a good site for Kingfishers, Green and Wood Sandpipers and spawning mullet. Rarest bird seen was a Little Egret in 1946, rejected as a vagrant and considered to be an escape from a bird garden somewhere.

The egret was lucky not to have been shot for the estuary was a favourite place for wildfowlers all winter. When the CBWPS (Cornwall Bird Watching & Preservation Society) bought the shooting rights, there was an outcry from the local gunners. One in particular, a vet, threatened to take the society to the highest courts to determine the obscure laws regarding who or what had jurisdiction above or below sea levels. I did point out to him that, as he was a man who took animals to bits as a living and blew them to bits as a hobby, he did not have my sympathy. The court case would have been a very expensive and risky business but, fortunately, he backed down and the wild duck and waders that took to the air on sight of a distant human can now be seen at close quarters, relaxed and unafraid.

The next threat of pollution was from the Torrey Canyon. Not the oil, the detergent. St. Ives beaches were economically crucial so huge effort went into cleaning them with many gallons of detergent. Lelant beach

was not considered worth spraying as hardly anyone went there, so the detergent was not concentrated. I saw the oil come floating up the estuary on a high tide, it stuck to the causeway wall and among the flotsam at the strand lines. None of the oil and very little detergent went into the mud. That summer, children digging on St. Ives beaches struck

oil, still there where the detergent had taken it deep into the sand. Lelant was clean and the estuary, comparatively healthy.

Further appropriation came with the infilling of part of Ryan's Field for the foundation of a petrol station and improvement of the St. Ives junction, when the causeway was widened to twice its former width. The wall you look over is fifty metres into the estuary from where it was formerly. Behind you is Ryan's Field. I should say that behind you is that which is now known as Ryan's Field. The proper and original Ryan's Field, on the other side of the railway, is now under a go-cart track after being utterly destroyed in the making of the Hayle by-pass. It was a fresh-water meadow favoured by waders that do

not like too much salt in their diet. I represented CBWPS at the enquiry before the lucky escape from the disaster proposed by the notorious Tekoa company who managed to wreck the Carnsew sluicing system and planned to build a 'wildlife friendly' hotel out into the Lelant arm. Their architect's impression of this development depicted puffins flying past the hotel windows.

All these memories remind us that each generation is often unaware of that which has been lost. We might be tempted not to object to future plans to chop a little more off here, a little bit off there, as not worth fighting for, as it won't make much difference. It will! I could cite more instances of incremental depletion of the wild world. We must always be aware that every wild square metre, whether of meadows or mud, is precious and once destroyed can never be replaced.

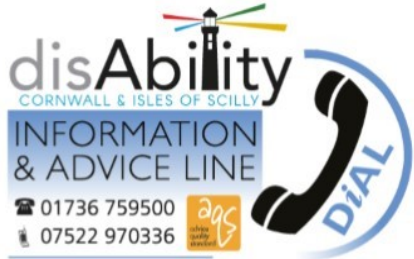

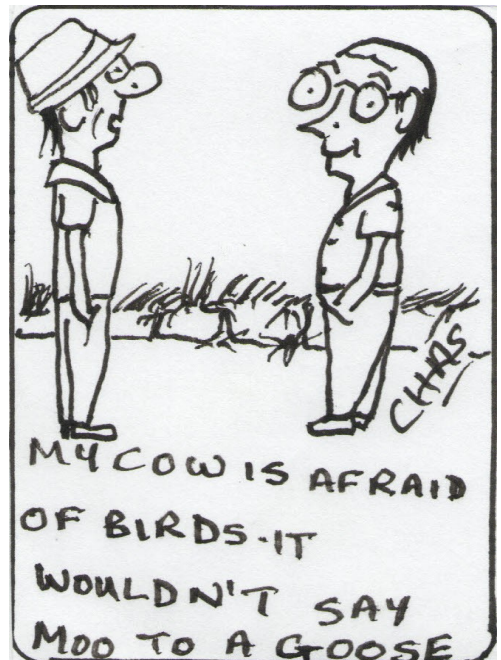
