HISTORY OF HAYLE ROTARY CLUB

In 1973 a group of Hayle businessmen became an extension club of St Ives Rotary Club. This small seed corn group grew and was accepted into Rotary International with their Charter Presentation Night celebrated at the Tregenna Castle Hotel on 19th November, by District Governor Chris Warman.

St. Ives President Ray Scott-Brown presented the Bell Jewel to Rotarian Bill Couch who became the proud Founder President of HAYLE Rotary Club. The motto of Rotary of "Service Before Self" was soon embraced by the Club. The first achievement was assisting a sick child to visit Disney Land in the USA followed by the popular "It's a Knockout" competition, which ran for many years, thanks to the kindness of the Rugby Club. Spectators will remember the shows, and stalls for charities and businesses were in abundance. One young man had a tooth knocked out by accident but Rtn. Phil Budden the local dentist was on hand and took him to his surgery – outcome O.K. Unfortunately after several years of

huge success the show was killed off by Health & Safety legislation. After 2 years rest, we were again beholden to the HRFC which allowed Rtn. John Murley to make his dream come true by holding a Vintage & Classic Car Show. Businesses turned up trumps again with adverts in the programme raising money.

Membership had grown to 30+ and our ladies had formed an Inner Wheel Club. The saying "behind a successful man lies a more active woman" was never more true and we are extremely grateful for their dedication over the next 25 years or so with our expansion into the education field.

The senior school (Highlanes) saw us holding Job Interviews practice and Work experience for 2 weeks. Master-Chef was a very popular event. All 8 schools in our area were able to take part in Youth Speaks, Young Photographer and Musician contests.

At this time we began to see a small ebb in membership due to job transfers, retirements and relocations and we had to rein back on our ability to hold large events. However we were able to continue with our standby BBQs which we had been holding for over 30 years. Firstly at Calloose Caravan & Camping Site, Leedstown when Rtn. Phil Gardener joined us and we had to visit every afternoon to fire up ready for evening cooking – even bailing out the site on one occasion when it had been flooded – but we still operated and fed a very grateful clientele.

Our BBQ's have since been our mainstay for fundraising and helping other organisations—schools, hospitals, churches, Hayle Day Care and a host of other local charities including Guy Fawkes Night for the Penzance Rotary Clubs

More recently we have supported Hayle in Bloom, Hayle Christmas Lights, Foundry Day, Hayle Swimming Pool and even on ASDA quay for a variety of other charities.

Active work within our area for other charities has included Penhaligan Friends, The Parkinson Centre, Polio Plus (the eradication of), CLIC, Send a Cow, Shelter Box, Water Aid, Kids out Days at Flambards, and collections for RNLI, Poppy Collections for Remembrance Day (when we have consistently collected 10% of the Hayle total), Blood Pressure/Stroke Awareness.

As friends we have moulded into being known as “the friendly Club” – probably as we are so small we have to be! We have had over 2000 people come to share our meals and talk about Rotary. We have even hosted Rotarians from USA, Ecuador, Australia, Nepal and France with whom we were twinned in PORDIC and exchanged biannual visits.

Hayle Christmas Lights 2020

Now the lights are switched off and hopefully been taken down by the small group of dedicated people who, with your support, help to keep Hayle bright at Christmas.

In the last issue of the Pump, which gives us fantastic support, thanks were offered to all those that assisted in various ways including helping with the putting up/taking down of the lights, local shopkeepers and businesses who allow us to put lights on their premises (and in most cases actually pay for the electricity used) as well as support our fund raising by either donating to us, hosting our collection boxes, or donating services.

Also Hayle Town Council and Hayle Harbour Authority for their ongoing support as well as the many individuals who put money into our funds. Without all this support we couldn't do what we do.

Now is the time to start planning for next Christmas – and here we would ask for your help again. We are especially keen to do more work in Copperhouse. There are already two things we are planning for next Christmas in this area. To this end we shall be approaching businesses in the area to see if we can add more Christmas trees next year. We want to have a “dedicated Hayle” display. This will be approximately a 4m x 1.2m display (made up of two 2m sections to allow ease of installation) made on galvanised steel frames with rope

lights (or similar) in white, red, green, blue, orange and/or yellow lights. We have still to decide what constitutes a “dedicated Hayle” display but feel it should be something to do with Hayle’s heritage – the local iron foundries and their role in Cornish mining, Hayle harbour, the golden sands of Hayle and its tourism or something else.

We are sure that there are individuals in Hayle who can come up with some great ideas. So please put them down on paper and let us be inundated with what you would like to see as a home town display in Copperhouse. 2020/2021 Precept Demand and Staff and Organisational Review

At the time of writing this Hayle Town Council's Precept for 2020/21 has not been finalised. The town council has arranged a time extension with Cornwall Council for the submission of its precept request. The reason for the delay in finalising the budget is largely due to the council commissioning an independent, holistic staff and organizational review. The review, which took part in early January, comprised an in depth look at the current responsibilities and services that the council deliver, the number of existing employees (13, mostly part-time roles, including library staff and excluding seasonal lifeguards), the current workload, devolved and delegated duties, the committee structure and the cycle of meetings. The findings of this report are due imminently and recommendations will be put to the council for consideration. The outcome of the review and consequent decisions will allow members to set the required budgets for the forthcoming financial year. It is anticipated that this process will be completed by 6 February and details of both the review and the precept will be published on the website.

Annual Citizens and Organisations of the Year

Nomination packs will soon be available from the town clerk's office for the Citizens and Organisation of the Year Awards. The council is also seeking nominations for Hayle Young Person of the Year and Hayle Youth Organisation of the Year. The

The town council has recently engaged Topan Fencing to install more of the bow-top metal fencing at Hayle Recreation Ground, around the children's play area. Car Park at Hayle Swimming Pool, King George V Memorial Walk

Improvements to the car park surface will soon be undertaken at the car park. This year Hayle Harbour Company has donated the gravel and will assist with the work. Thank you. When the work has been completed a car parking meter will be installed and users will be required to pay to park between the hours of 10.00am and 6.00pm. People using the Swimming Pool facilities will be able to claim their payment back and the car park will be free to everyone after 6.00pm daily. The fee for the first hour will be 50p. The 'No Overnight Parking' rule will still apply.

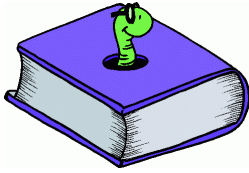

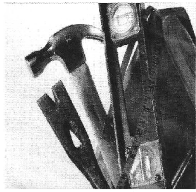

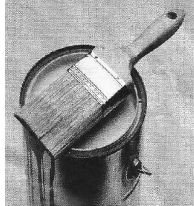

Bodriggy Health Centre Patient Participation Group

Patient Participation Groups (PPG) have been going since November 1972. At least 41 per cent of General Practices in England and Wales have a PPG and Bodriggy Health Centre has had one for several years. Patient Participation Groups are not very well-known and most people do not know what they do. So, here is an explanation of how PPGs work and what their role and function may be. If you are interested, we encourage you to discuss joining the Bodriggy PPG.

Patient Participation Groups:

Once set up, Patient Participation Groups are usually run by patients with the help of the Practice Team. We have a committee that meets every three months to give the PPG some leadership and a sense of direction. The PPG works closely with the Practice and we have members of the Practice Team, including GPs join most meetings.

Patient Participation Groups are not set up to be a 'forum for moaners' but nor are they 'doctor fan clubs'. They are a route for patients to advise and inform the Practice on what matters most to patients and to help identify solutions to problems. Members of PPGs should think about the

Improving communication by assisting in the production newsletters or leaflets that provide patients with information about their health and how to access services

Together with members of the Practice Team and other significant NHS and/or Local Authority partners participate as appropriate in the organisation of health promotion events so that patients can have a really good understanding of their health and how best to look after it.

Acting as a 'critical friend' to the Practice, by helping it appreciate and understand what patients are thinking and are saying about issues, such as, opening hours, telephone systems, requests for home visits, delays in being taken for appointment, seeing their favourite GP, seeing their favourite Practice Nurse, repeat prescriptions and the range and type of services provided within the Practice.

Helping to fill some of the gaps in services by signposting patients to available support or providing services such as patient libraries, volunteer transport, befriending and support groups.

Fundraising to support the work of the PPG and to improve the care that is available to patients of the Practice.

Influencing the services that are provided, and where they are provided, by taking part in what are called commissioning decisions: this means that services can be developed in the way that is best for patients.

Undertaking appropriate survey or research to find out what matters to patients and discussing the findings with the Practice.

Getting Involved.

This will seem rather daunting. But Patient Participation Groups across the country, run by patients, are doing these things and are making a real difference. If you feel you would like to get involved, either as a member of the PPG or just helping out once in a while, please contact us. It is all voluntary and each and every contribution is appreciated and valued.

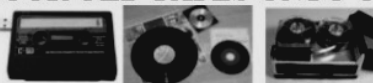

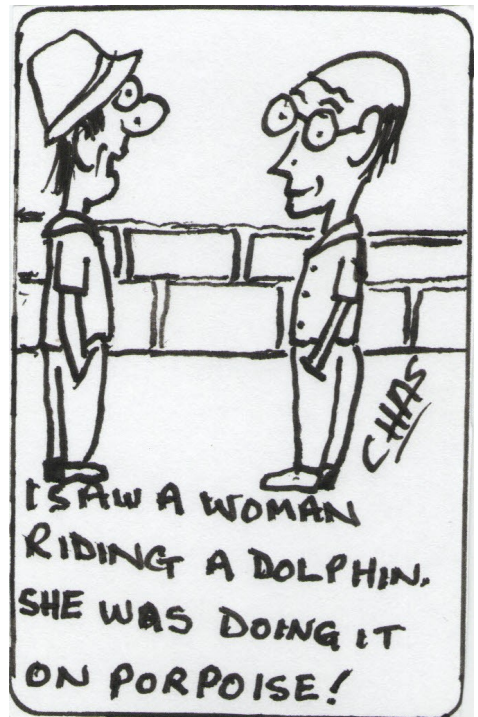

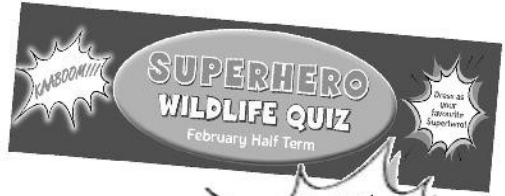
