### Bleed Control Kits in Hayle

There are over 27 defibrillators in the Hayle area now thanks to the efforts of many in the local community, not least Nick Reynolds of Paradise Park who has been championing the introduction of them for several years now. Whilst public knowledge of defibrillators has grown tremendously in recent times, alongside their rollout, what is not known about so much are Bleed Control Kits.



These kits contain an assortment of materials to stop or control blood loss and are all designed in mind that the person accessing them might not be medically trained. Typical contents include a large trauma dressing, Celox Gauze, Fox Chest Seal dressing, tourniquet, disposable gloves, scissors, foil blanket to keep patient warm and a CPR Face Mask. The

Daniel Baird Foundation Charity (of which the photos of the kits are credited to) was set up by the family and friends of Daniel Baird who was fatally stabbed in Birmingham in 2017 and died from catastrophic bleeding at the young age of 26.

NOW IN Bedding plants, New Cornish potatoes, Local strawberries The Foundation supply Bleed Control Kits at a cost nearing £100 per kit, of which these kits not only support the Foundation but aim to save lives from blood loss within minutes.

In Hayle there are now, at time of print, three Bleed Control Kits: Probably the 1st three in Cornwall! Championed as ever by Nick Reynolds, and supported by Hayle Town Councillors Jeremy Martin and David Raymer, the very first Blood Kit in Hayle was installed at Paradise Park. The 2nd kit was installed at Terrill Bros. who funded it themselves for everyone on the industrial estate where they reside to benefit from its

availability. The 3rd Blood Kit is at the Hayle Youth Project at Humphry Davy Lane.

The importance of Blood Control Kits cannot be underestimated as Nick himself had cause to use one within days of the kit being installed at Paradise Park when a friend cut through an artery in their leg after accidently dropping a knife whilst cooking. Using a tourniquet, Nick managed to stop the bleeding before the ambulance arrived. Nick is determined to continue raising the profile of Defibrillators and Bleed Control Kits as two lifesaving bits of equipment that should be present in all areas of the county. Both these are

It first turned up at Marazion marsh on 28th September before flying up to Potteric Carr, South Yorkshire where it was spotted between 10 – 15th October. Deciding that Cornwall was a better idea for winter, it returned to Marazion marsh just four days later. The bird has commuted between Hayle and Marazion ever since with sightings at Copperhouse pool into March.

These beauties have impressively large bills, shaped like long spoons, which they sweep from side to side to feed. If you thought calling baby Puffins pufflings was cute, Spoony chicks are known as teaspoons!

Our winter guest will likely be on the move soon so keep your eyes peeled. The bird is easy to spot with a green metal ring on its left leg with white code 'V463' (especially helpful when its bill is tucked in for 40 winks!). Wishing our guest safe onward travels.'







Despite March's wet and blustery weather, the plants and wildlife that Spring is on the way. If you tune into your senses, you'll notice buds swelling and bursting into leaf and flower, birdsong becoming more vibrant and spirited and the gentle buzz of foraging insects taking advantage of a burst of warm sunshine.

This can be one of the best times of vear for wildlife watching as animals become more active. of the Towans suggest getting out and about to gather food and materials in preparation for breeding. There is something very special about a chance wildlife encounter, one where you're so quiet and unobtrusive the animals don't even know vou're there and you get to watch them going about their daily life in their natural environment.

> Wheatears are one of the earliest migrating birds to pass through the Towans in the Spring. This little

bird spends the winter in Africa and then heads back to Britain to breed, using the Towans as an important refuelling stop before continuing its journey north. Its name Wheatear (old English for white arse!) becomes apparent when you see its white rump as it flies away. We'll see them again in September when they make their return journey. It can also be a surprise to see a Shelduck (Britain's largest duck) disappearing into a sand dune less so once you find out that they use old rabbit holes as nest sites. Meadow Pipits and Skylarks also nest on the ground and all these birds are easily disturbed by energetic dogs eager to explore.

As the days become warmer, native wildlife such as adders and lizards start to wake from their winter hibernation. Being cold blooded animals they're not able to fully regulate their body temperature and rely on heat from the sun, ground and air to keep them warm. On warm spring days they often bask in the sun on areas of bare ground or short grass. They're naturally shy animals and prefer to move away to the safety of undergrowth at

the slightest sign of danger. However on cooler days they're not able to move away quickly and that's when they're more likely to try to defend themselves and could give your dog a nip.

So, next time you're out on the Towans, keep your eyes and ears open and pause if you spot any wildlife. You can give them a helping hand by allowing them time and space to move away on their terms. If you're out with your dog, you can also help keep them and wildlife safe by having your dog on a lead or under close


