

I'd like to say a really big 'Thank You to our wonderful team of pony checkers or 'lookerers' as they're officially known! Together they've given over 400 hours of their time, going out virtually every day to check on

the health and welfare of the

groups of conservation ponies that have been grazing on areas of the Towans over the winter and spring. The ponies have done a great job in munching on the vegetation - slowing scrub growth and creating patches of short vegetation, letting more light in to the smaller plant species. Trampling by the ponies creates patches of bare soil good for insects and other animals to bask on and great for seed germination, burrowing insects. The ponies' dung provides food for insects, which in turn become food for birds and



other animals. The ponies have moved on to pastures new, away form the Towans, but we hope to see them back again in the autumn.

Another thank you to our practical conservation session volunteers who, since October last year, have given over 470 hours of their time, carrying out practical work to help look after the wonderful habitats of the Towans and Gwithian Green.

Looking forwards to the next few months, we're excited to be celebrating World Sand Dune Day with a joint event with the Friends



of the Towans Art Club at St Gothian Sands on **Saturday 29th June 2-4pm.** We'd love you to come and join us on a short trail of activities exploring the dunes with your senses, finishing off with the opportunity to get creative, making art or writing a poem.

On Tuesday **4th June** you can join us on a guided bird walk. Setting off at 8am, we'll be taking a gentle stroll, guided by Peter, our resident bird specialist and chair of trustees, to find out what birds we can see and hear around St Gothian Sands and Godrevy. We plan to finish in time for some mid morning refreshments!

We have a guided butterfly walk around Upton Towans on **Tuesday 2nd July 11am - 2.30pm**. Local butterfly specialist and Friends of the Towans trustee, Dick Goodere, will lead us on another gentle stroll, this time looking and finding out about all the wonderful butterflies of the Towans.

Save our Sand, part of Friends of the Towans, are continuing with monthly beach cleans focusing on different parts of the bay each month. On April's clean 16 volunteers collected 28 kg of rubbish from the beach in front of Riviere Towans. Each piece of litter collected from the beach saves marine and shore wildlife from the dangers of eating or getting caught in marine litter. The next beach cleans are on Tuesdays 18th June and 23rd July.

We're also looking forward to welcoming some school groups to find out more about the wildlife, habitats and conservation of the Towans. We have a couple of groups booked in, but if you'd like your school to be involved, do get in touch! Championship Event to be held in Hayle

It's not often you can say that Hayle will be the hosts for a national championship event. That is certainly going to be true on June the 23rd when the best Junior rowers from around the country come to battle it out for the title of National Under 14s Champions. Run by Hayle Pilot Gig Club CIO and supported by the Cornish Pilot Gig Association, the U14s Gig Rowing Championships are one of the blue ribbon events in the CPGA calendar.

In the words of Dylan Jane, the CPGA's Event Lead: "The Under 14's Championship is a crucial event in the season for junior gig rowers, providing an opportunity to develop confidence, bond with their peers and test their sporting abilities. Hayle is the perfect all weather venue for this event and Hayle Rowing Club do a fantastic job to ensure that spectators and participants have a great day."

The Under 14 Championship promises to be a great event this

year and is open to the public from mid- morning to late afternoon. Its free and, as the racing is up and down Copperhouse Pool, it is ideal for watching the races unfold. There will be a BBQ, raffle, refreshments, and things for the kids to do, so it's a great family day out.





Georgina came to Hayle in the seventies with her mother and a much-loved African grey parrot. She was a qualified geologist and found the history of Hayle fascinating. She worked for the Town Council, and in the nineties created Hayle Archive, rescuing a load of documents due to be discarded, and originally setting up the Archive in an old ICI building on North Quay, later to be moved to the Brewery Office, Sea Lane.

Her knowledge of Hayle, its history and its wildlife was probably unparalleled. Visitors to the Archive could be sure that any questions about the town would be answered in great detail.

Georgina had an enormous love of the Millpond and was

instrumental in getting the
Ropewalk restored to its former
glory. Every Wednesday without
fail she would pay the ducks and
swans a visit, armed with a big
bag of grain. And when the Pump
was published, there would always
be an article written by her,
keeping us up to date about the
happenings.

Georgina was somewhat eccentric, not always easy to get along with, but she had a good heart and a great sense of humour. Her love of Hayle and nature showed itself in the many and varied articles she wrote, and sometimes also illustrated.

Her loss to Hayle and its people is great. We will miss her.


