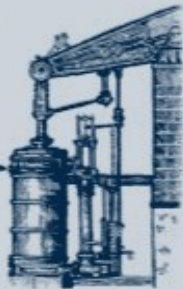

Opening times are: 9am to 5pm Monday to Friday.

The Hub consists of a counter service where customers can speak in private to someone from their own bank. At the time of writing there are three banks taking part which are:

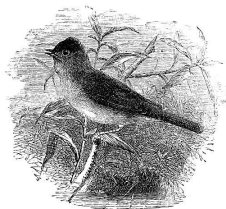

station is outside my kitchen window and may be a bit close for comfort for the birds, who all seem a bit nervous about using it. If I'm not around, though, it is invariably empty on my return. I've got my fingers crossed that in time they will learn that. I wish them no ill and become more acceptant of my proximity.

I can also report that the mother herring gull who has nested on my roof for several years has returned with a new mate. Her previous mate was killed in the nest on my roof last year, as he brooded their three chicks. I

helped the mother bird and her one chick (the other two died) survive by feeding them until the youngster flew away six weeks later. The mother became quite tame, and very well-behaved. No sign of nest building for the newlyweds yet, perhaps a bit early, but the bird calls if she is hungry, as she did last year, and once given a treat, is satisfied. I'm happy to have my avian friends back.

As I write this article, I learn that there is a partial eclipse of the moon on Friday (March 15). The shadow of the Earth obscures the moon, and the BBC says it will be a 'dramatic spectacle'. On this occasion, as the moon moves into Earth's shadow, it gradually darkens, before turning a dusky red, resulting in a stunning 'blood moon'. Maybe you got up in the middle of the night to see this dramatic event?! While it may be odd to write of something come and gone, it serves as a reminder that 'Nature' is not just the plants, animals and scenery that we see all the time. It is EVERYWHERE! There have been several heavenly events in recent times, but, alas, most were lost to view due to cloudy skies.



We have blood pressure monitors available for a 3 week loan to our library customers.

As always, we would welcome any new members to help in all aspects of the group. We are not

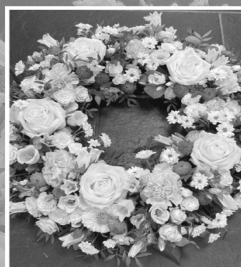

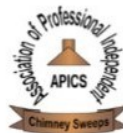


Hayle lions are still on the hunt for new members

Springtime on the Towans

It looks like Spring is on the way - the days are lengthening, we're getting more frequent spells of warm sunshine and we're starting to see signs of spring! Tender new shoots are appearing and we're seeing and hearing more bird and animal activity on the Towans.

Looking out for our wonderful wildlife

When you're walking on the Towans

do keep an eye out for ground nesting birds, particularly skylarks and meadow pipits, as well as adders and lizards. They're all easily disturbed by humans and energetic dogs eager to explore. Disturbance uses up these animals' vital energy supplies and can make breeding less successful. We can all help look after our wonderful wildlife by keeping our eyes and ears open - pausing when we spot wildlife and giving them time and space to move away on their terms.

People are often concerned about coming across adders on the Towans. Adders are naturally shy animals and prefer to move away to the safety of undergrowth at the slightest sign of danger. Being cold-

blooded, on cooler days, they're not able to move away quickly and that's when they're more likely to try to defend themselves and could give a dog a nip. If you're out with your dog, you can help keep them and wildlife safe by having your dog on a lead or under close control - you could be rewarded with a great view of the wonderful wildlife of the Towans!

Practical Conservation Sessions

With the onset of Spring there will be a change in focus for our practical conservation sessions. We've stopped our autumn and winter scrub management work (cutting back shrubs and small trees like gorse, blackthorn, privet, cotoneaster and buddleia) to avoid disturbing any nesting birds. We'll be moving on to removing some of the low-growing brambles, opportunistic seedlings and some invasive flowering plants that have moved into some of the bare sand areas. Removing these plants gives some of the often less vigorous dune grassland plants a chance to spread into and re-colonise the bare sand.

From May onwards more of our sessions will focus on finding out more about the plants and wildlife of the Towans. We'll be developing plant and animal identification skills and starting to carry out some simple plant and wildlife surveys along with occasional practical habitat manage-

ment work. Gathering information on what plants and animals live where on the Towans can give an indication of the health of the Towans and its habitats and can help to guide how these important habitats are managed.

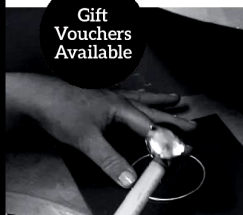
