As Trustees of Passmore Edwards Institute (PEI) Hayle we were extremely upset and disappointed to read the letter in the Oct / Nov 2025 edition of the Hayle Pump regarding the closure of the Hayle branch of the Royal British Legion (RBL). The writer unfortunately was not in receipt of the full facts.

The long standing arrangement between RBL and PEI was for RBL to have exclusive and unrestricted use of a room. Rent was reviewed annually on 1st October and adjusted in line with the Consumer Price Index. On 1st October 2021 rent for the coming year was set at £690 per quarter (£230 per month). As at 31st March 2022 rent payments were up to date.

Unfortunately shortly afterwards the treasurer of PEI passed away. This left two trustees with access and signatory rights to the Institute's bank account. One of the trustees did not have access to the internet and was not in receipt of bank statements. The other was also an officer of RBL.

Records indicate that ad hoc payments of varying amounts were then received up until 1st November 2024 when regular monthly payments of £80 were made by standing order. At no point was the amount of rent being paid by RBL since 31st March 2022 brought to the attention of the trustees of PEI at their monthly meetings.

The apparent loss of rental income became apparent in the spring of 2025. In order to mediate a future position agreeable to both parties the trustees met with the Regional RBL

Engagements Officer. A proposal by the trustees for the RBL to pay a room rental of 45% of the average monthly income being generated by two comparable rooms within PEI was declined.

A further offer for the RBL to pay for 3 sessions a week and to open up access

to the room for others to play snooker or use the room for social functions at other times was also rejected.

There had also been a long running issue regarding the RBL's denial of access to the room which was required for regulatory purposes. The vacated room has now been left in a terrible state of repair.

The Poppy Appeal has not operated from PEI for a number of years but is organised from a nearby property.

The trustees are a small group of local volunteers who want to keep the building open for Hayle people but in a climate where new community buildings appear to be the preferred option e.g. the proposed new Town Council Civic building we are concerned for the future of this great Grade 2 listed building.

Hayle Terrace Community Garden Project

Hayle Terrace Community Garden project is well underway and is due for completion at the end of November by our appointed, Hayle based, contractors Sharp Country Landscapes. The site was granted by way of a S106 agreement, and we were successful in securing £100K CIL funding. Obtaining the necessary approvals to deal with the contamination was a hurdle, as was securing the site in the first instance, but it will all be worth it when the garden is established! At the most recent meeting of the Full Council, it was resolved to name the garden as the John Pollard Garden, in recognition of the late John Pollard's contribution and service to the town.

Civic and Community Hub

As previously report we received the great news that our funding bid was successful (Town Regeneration and Investment Programme – £51,750). This additional money will be utilised to progress the Civic and Community Hub project (based on the existing library site) to RIBA Stage 4 (ready for construction) and has allowed us to undertake some further consultation and engagement work with young people and those with disabilities - helping to ensure that we get the interior designs just right for all users. We have been running a series of workshops and events to consult with you; the community, and we can't wait to progress the project at speed.



HAYLE PUMP SUPPORTS NEW CRIME PREVENTION INITIATIVE

St Erth Hayle has launched a Neighbourhood Watch (NHW) Scheme to prevent crime and fear of the crime in the village with financial support from the Hayle Pump magazine for street signs and bin stickers to promote the initiative.

The inaugural meeting on October 24 was attended by six scheme co-ordinators from the village as well as Steph Good, NHW Community Project Manager for Cornwall, PC Joe Magurean of Hayle Neighbourhood Policing Scheme, and Cornwall Councillor John Martin.

The scheme, which covers most of the village centre, aims to foster a greater sense of neighbourliness to reduce crime and bad behaviour through

community co-operation. It will also share crime prevention advice with residents, get involved in community projects working closely with the parish council, St Erth Residents' Association and other local groups.

It was formed following the annual parish meeting earlier in the year where concerns were raised about an increase in anti-social behaviour and a desire to integrate newcomers to the village more effectively.

Francesca Peterson, co-ordinator for St Erth's Lanuthnoe NHW Scheme, who organised the setup meeting said: "We were delighted and grateful that the Hayle Pump was able to help us get off the ground as a new organisation by funding these promotional materials. We hope to get the street signs up as soon as possible and will support this with a leaflet campaign about the new scheme. We also have plans for a community event to enable residents to come and chat with us about what we want to do and

how we can help them."

FRANKIE IN FRANCE

When Frankie left our site on the morning of Sunday 2nd November, we were devastated. We now know that by 9.49am on Monday 3rd November Frankie was already at the Île





Aganton, on the north coast of France! This sighting was reported on the French national citizen science portal for nature. This all became apparent on 9th November when a further set of photographs of Frankie looking fit and well, and who was now along the coast at Plage de Keremma, were forwarded to us.

Between 2nd and 9th November Park staff were out at all times of the day and night, in all weathers, following up on potential leads in order to try and retrieve Frankie. When the confirmed sighting of her in France came to our attention on 9th we immediately knew it would be unlikely that we would be able to return her to the park for the reasons shown below.

It was never our intention for Frankie to end up in the wild. There are a number of reports of similar situations where flamingos have lived for many years and thrived, including over European winters, so while we will continue to worry about her it is a position we have to accept.

We are confident that her movements will be observed and logged in France by the citizen science members and feel relieved to know that she has shown the resilience and skills that will serve her well as a "wild" flamingo. Frankie's parents and the rest of the flock at Paradise Park continue to do well.





It had developed from H.T.P., Hosken, Trevithick, Polkinhorn & Co Ltd. a 1890 conglomerate based at Loggans Mill in Hayle involved in milling, shipping and wool processing. In 1936, the milling division in Plymouth, together with the H.T.P. name, were purchased by Spillers Limited leaving the largest agricultural merchant throughout Cornwall and West Devon to be known as Farm Industries Ltd. developing HTP Motors Ltd in Truro, and Devon Woolcombers Ltd in Tavistock, from its grand offices in Princes House.
