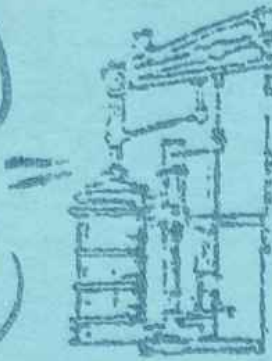

Multi-Marathon Walk for Meningitis

Steve Dayman, the Founder of the national charity Meningitis Research Foundation, started a walk from John O'Groats to Land's End on 30th September, 1988, planning to finish at Land's End on Tuesday, 10th November.

His target was to collect £100,000 for the Charity to fund essential equipment for a vaccine development programme to fight against group 'B' meningococcal meningitis and septicaemia through immunisation.

Currently, there is no vaccine available for group 'B' meningococcal disease. It was this disease that caused the death of his own son, 14 month old Spencer. Also walking this great distance was Steve Fear, from Highbridge in Somerset, who lost his 16 year old niece, Sophie Deacon to meningitis and septicaemia in 1993. Steve was joined along the route by many celebrities, including Sir Jimmy Saville, Denis Law, and Fiona Armstrong, as well as over 200 members and supporters of the Foundation.

The two Steves and their companions stopped overnight

at Hayle, and reported that they had collected over £600 from Probus to Hayle.

Hayle Town Mayor, Mrs. Shirley Oliver, the Town Clerk, John Burrow, and the Deputy Mayor, Brian Capper, greeted the group when they set off towards Land's End on a windy, sunny morning, and they walked with them through the main streets of Hayle.

N.B. The bacteria that cause meningitis also cause septicaemia, which is the blood poisoning form of the disease and more life-threatening. The symptoms which may exist

with septicaemia are fever, vomiting, aches and pains in muscles and joints, cold hands and feet and a red pin prick rash which will not fade under the pressure of a glass tumbler. This rash may go on to develop into purple bruise-like marks. Initial signs mirror flu-like symptoms, but a person's condition will deteriorate very rapidly. The common signs of meningitis are severe headache, stiff neck and dislike of bright lights.

The Foundation operates a 24 hour Helpline on 01454.413344 manned by trained staff and nurses,

Illuminated Street Decorations in Hayle, Christmas 1998.

In October, the Hayle Chamber of Commerce, met to consider the implications of the legislation governing Decorative Street Lighting, issued by the Lighting Engineers at the County Council, which is now fully effective. This legislation originally emanates from the Institute of Electrical Engineers and Europe.

Last year we contacted the County Engineer to explore and clarify how the illuminated

decorative shapes which we traditionally have installed at Christmas might be affected. Many changes were required to bring them up to date.

The main difficulty arises due to our shapes being formed on metal frames. These must now be earth bonded to a source supply and protected by RCD cut-offs. This year all the existing cabling must be changed to use external "Polar" yellow cable with moulded on fittings. The Chamber's lighting shapes need a complete re-make.

Faced with this fact, and other requirements, and the

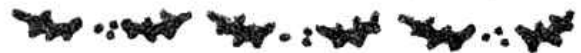
The Chamber will organise its annual "Best Decorated", Shop Window, Business Premises, Household, and Pub Frontage, on a Festive Theme throughout

Year 2000

A new start for the people of Hayle.

At the third meeting of the co-ordinating committee held on the 20th November at the Community Centre there was plenty of enthusiasm shown regarding the projects being mooted as Hayle's contribution to the Millennium celebrations.

The meeting was also attended by Mr. Foy, who is in charge of Parks and Gardens for Penwith, John Lindfield, the Economic Development Officer, and Helen Rodda who is to be the Liaison Officer between Hayle and Penwith District Council. Mr. Bob Williams of Clnnex S.W. was also there to advise those present of the feasibility of installing lighting along the Memorial Walk. The most favoured design for lamp standards was for a cast iron one, and Mr. Williams' considered opinion was that there should be one every 30 metres, i.e. a total of 30 along the whole length of the Walk. The present concrete columns are splitting and beyond repair, so a whole new scheme is needed. This would really enhance the area and the road would be upgraded as well.

Brian Capper, Deputy Mayor, was also at the meeting to talk about the planned incorporation of the National Cycle Network, whereby the grass verge alongside would be widened in places to enable cyclists to ride in safety, the work for this being undertaken by Sustrans.

Mr. Foy could see that there was a potential for environmental enhancement at the old Phillack Cemetery, and would like to see it planted with yew trees and pines, which his department would undertake. There are plans to improve the fountain, and it

would be nice to have some more seating; maybe individuals would like to have a seat placed along there in memory of a loved one, or clubs and organisations could possibly raise the necessary funds. The seats would be like the ones at Copperhouse, and the cost would decrease if a bulk order were placed.

The other ideas are still going forward - repair of the clock in Foundry Square, restoration of the cinema, a pageant, an exhibition by Churches Together, and an Ecumenical service on the first day of the new century, and the improvement of the access at Phillack Cemetery.

The Pump Newsletter team has decided to adopt the idea of all the historic places in Hayle being identified by a plaque of some sort, and Thyatira Co-operative will print a leaflet of booklet, if necessary, so that we can show visitors what a great place Hayle was (and still is).

The Town Council is negotiating to have commemorative medals struck, possibly from genuine tin that was smelted in Hayle, for sale, or to be awarded.

At the end of the meeting John Lindfield having patiently

listened to everyone's ideas, gave his opinion on the best way of obtaining funding, and everyone present, I am sure, is grateful for his help.

The Town Council would love to hear what you, the people of Hayle, want. Please make your views known. Do you agree or disagree with any of these projects? Please don't think it doesn't matter what you think - your views as a citizen of this town ARE important.

The Carnival Committee would really like to know what you all think of the idea of moving the next year's carnival from the first week of December 1999 to the first week of January 2000 (for the

Millennium Year only)

Do you agree with moving it?

Do you think it should stay as it is?

PLEASE write with your views on this or any other matter to the Town Council at the Passmore Edwards Institute, or your Councillor, or leave a letter at any of the Pump drop-off points listed on Page 2, and we will make sure it reaches the right person.

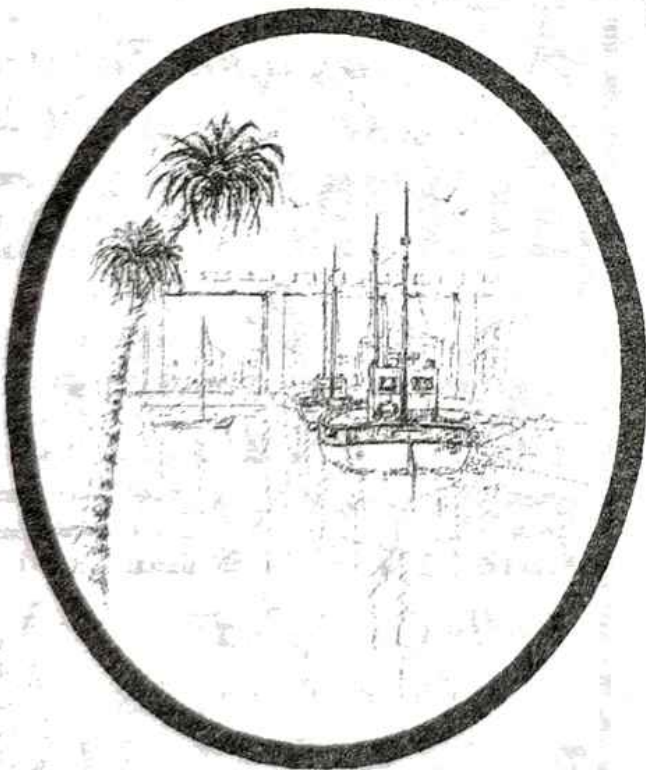

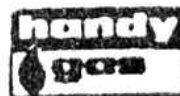

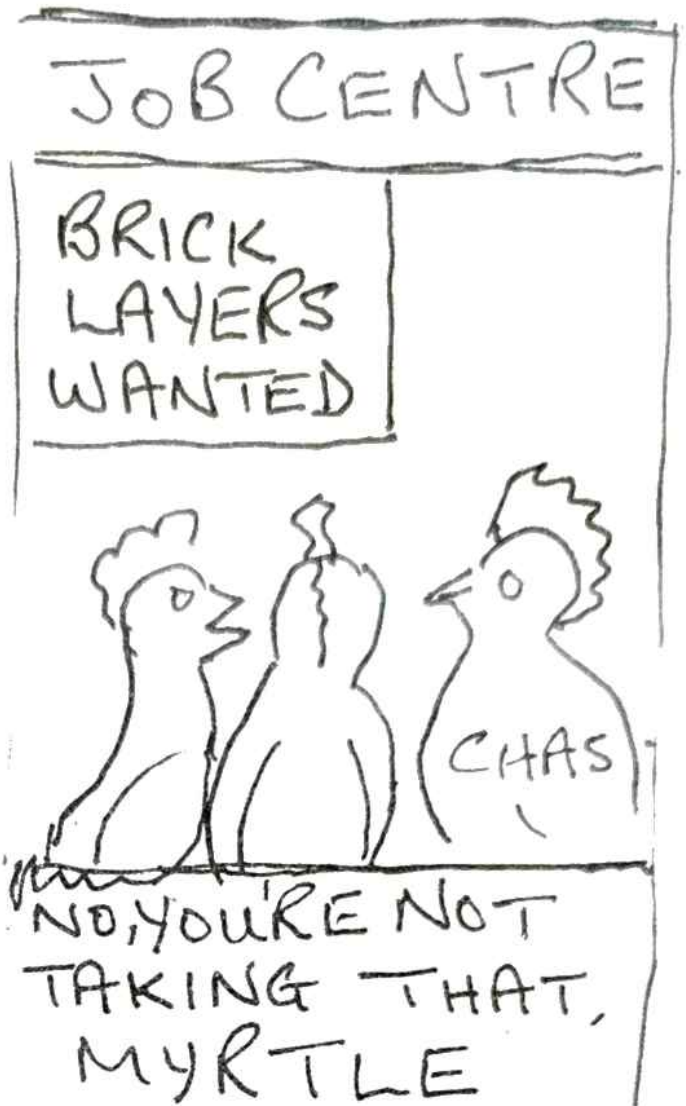
Letter
