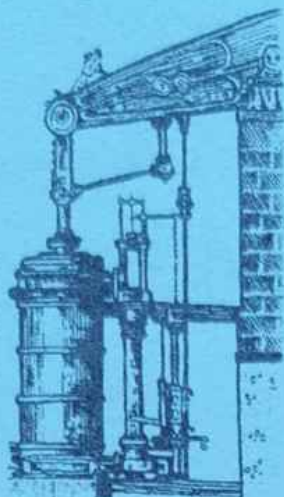


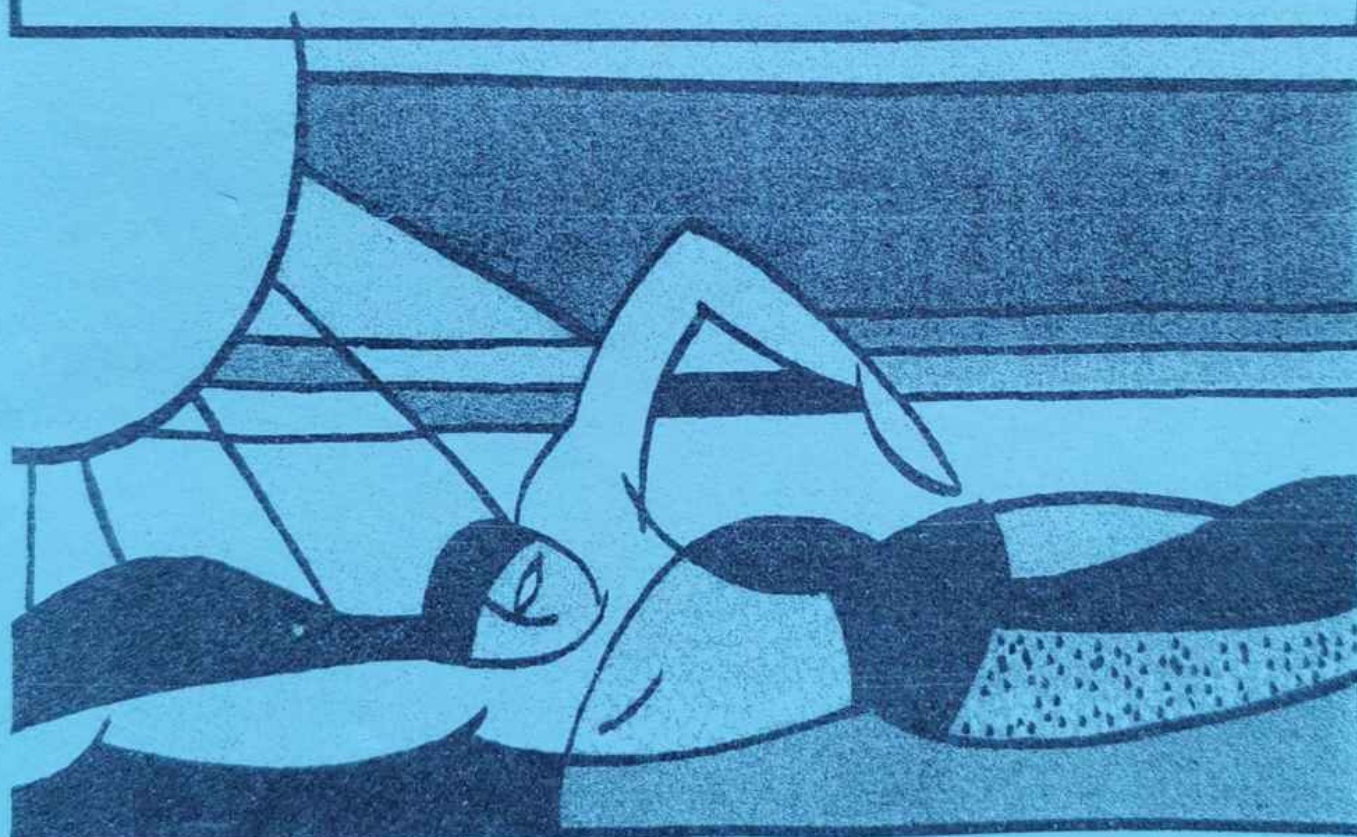

# HAYLE YOUTH PROJECT LAPTOP LENDING

The Hayle Youth Project is proud to announce its new laptop computer lending library. Young people from the area will be able to register with us and take away laptops in order to help them with their studies. The scheme is open to all young people aged 14 to 19 who are engaged with any form of education service. 5 laptops will be made available with standard office type software, so that young people can write their essays or do their coursework at home in their own time. A further 5 laptops will be loaded with creative software in order to enhance learning opportunities. These will have photo editing, music creation, web design and music editing software. The young people will have to register with us and let us know the nature of their specific computing requirement. We are hoping that we will be able to lend these computers in 2 week blocks, in order to allow those involved unlimited access to this valuable resource without feeling pressured to get them back to us. The launch date for this scheme is Friday 1<sup>st</sup> June and will take place at the project office, 57 Penpol Terrace, on the Harbour opposite Philp's Pasties between 4.30 and 5pm. ## ***Millpond Update***

Now that the work has been done and the new willow fence, having survived the fierce winter gales, has sprouted into a mass of green shoots, the ponds are taking on a new dimension. We had a problem with silt coming downriver after heavy rain, but this year the river has run almost clear, allowing the suspended silt in the ponds to drop to the bottom, visibly clearing the water in both pools. With yellow flag irises and dusky pink rhododendrons in bloom the effect is stunning.

Spring has brought us both gains and losses. Firstly, our latest pair of swans, Anthony and Cleopatra, have successfully hatched 3 cygnets. Since 1987 a total of 73 cygnets have been hatched on the ponds. The ducks and moorhens have not been so lucky.

Only 9 ducklings have survived out of 21 hatched and four moorhen chicks, but the real tragedy befell our ducks who nest each year on the Angarrack stream in Copperhouse. Late maintenance work on the river bank took the grass cover away and of the 26 ducklings that were there only 7 survived because they were too exposed to local predators. The Environment Agency have since assured us that such carnage will not be allowed to happen again and that areas of grass cover will be left to protect the young birds. Hopefully we will still get a second hatch before the drakes start to return to the Millponds at the end of July, although one pair have taken out 'squatter's rights' on the Co-op car park.

After a couple of technical hitches the completed project was celebrated with a Gala Concert on Sunday 27<sup>th</sup>

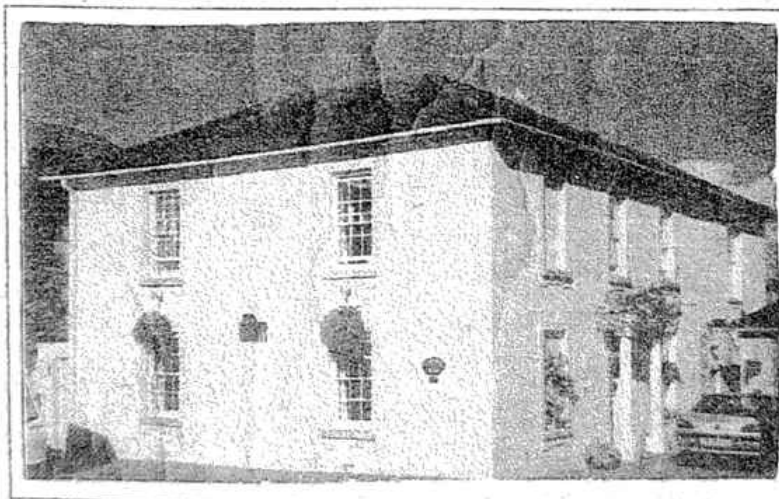

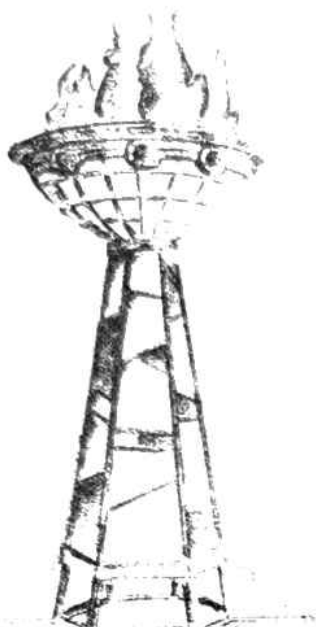

## FLAME OF HOPE SWITCHED OFF.



Back in Issue 43 (December 2001) we published an article about Hayle's Flame of Hope.

This was built by Terry English, (the man who made the armour for the film "Excalibur" among many other achievements) and was installed on the parapet of St. Elwyn's Church by the Hayle Harbour Support Group, with the intention that it would burn until the first machine cuts the first piece of ground at the start of the Hayle Harbour Development.

Now, almost six years later the Flame of Hope has broken down, the man who used to look after it has now gone abroad to live, and it has been taken down and returned to Terry English.

We can only hope that this is not a bad omen, although the Harbour Support Group says that ING are still on target to put in their Planning Application this summer.

I am often asked, after the first consultation with my patients, 'How many treatments do I need?'

I wish it was as easy as that. In fact, it is a rather difficult question to answer. Why?

How many treatments are dependent initially on two key variables; your body and the practitioner's skills. Let's think about our bodies. Remember, with chiropractic we are trying to normalise a joint or joints that are stressing and in many cases giving rise to pain. How well your body responds to an adjustment, that is designed to facilitate that change, depends on four things:

1. How long you have had the symp-

toms.

2. Your age.
3. Your general health.
4. Any underlying health issues.

Most conditions that can be treated through chiropractic fare better if the patient seeks treatment within the first 6-8 weeks. A long standing problem, often referred to as chronic, will inevitably give rise to further complications, as the body adjusts to the area under stress and attempts to compensate. Also, the patient will become mentally accustomed to the pain and discomfort and probably forget what life was like before the injury. To look for a speedy recovery, seek help early, therefore avoiding the need for a lengthier course of treatment.

Unfortunately age is a factor. As we age, our bodies are not as responsive or able to heal as quickly. We should

never generalise and whilst chiropractic helps patients of all ages, our age can be a factor in the time it takes to treat successfully.

Our general health affects our lives in probably everything we do. There is real evidence that patients who are not obese, eat a balanced diet, sleep well, exercise often and are not stressed, will benefit more quickly from treatment. It is a sad fact, that many of us still do not give enough thought to our general health, a reason why chiropractors will gladly give advice on these issues.

Certain underlying health conditions will be contra-indicated as far as chiropractic treatment is concerned. One reason the initial consultation is so important is that these issues are highlighted before treatment is considered. However, saying that, most bone re-

lated and soft tissue conditions, such as ankylosing spondylitis, rheumatoid arthritis, osteoarthritis and fibromyalgia, do not necessarily preclude a patient from seeking help. The individual circumstances of each case will be assessed before treatment is considered. What is important is that the patient understands what can be achieved through chiropractic and what is outside this particular area of healthcare. All patients who are suffering some form of underlying health condition, if treated, will always be treated using conservative and non-invasive forms of adjustment.

**So have I answered the question?**

What I can say is that most patients, whatever their circumstances, if treatable will see some change in 4-6 treatments. No reaction to treatment will inevitably mean referral for further examination, usually to the patient's GP. It is, however, rare.

Happily most patients do respond within a couple of weeks.

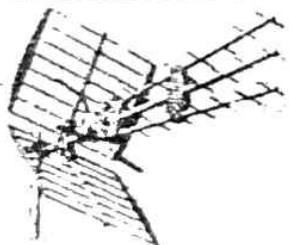
**Labour which changed the face of public licensing.** As practising musicians my wife and I were particularly concerned about the abolition of the so-called '2 in a bar' rule, under which venues such as pubs, bars and restaurants did not previously require a music licence if they employed 1 or 2 musicians. In Cornwall, a large proportion of all gigs fall into this category, and given the difficulty of promoting live music in Cornwall we were naturally opposed to this part of the new act.

Apart from our own selfish concerns, we were also worried about press reports that local events, such as church choirs and other non-profitable charity events, for example the occasional Millpond Gardens concerts, would in future have to obtain a music licence. On February 11<sup>th</sup> 2003,

whilst the bill was still being discussed, I contacted Andrew George MP, who immediately took the matter up with Dr Kim Howells, the minister in charge of the bill. Such was the government's great concern at the issues I had raised, Dr Howells did not reply until 16<sup>th</sup> April 2003. (We pay these government ministers, and their staff, a handsome wage to look after our interests – would you put up with your dry cleaner taking this long?) I quote from one part of the reply; "A Government amendment to the Bill now exempts the provision of entertainment of (*sic*) entertainment faculties (*sic*) at a garden fete, or at a function or event of a similar character from the licensing scheme which the Bill will introduce". It goes on to say that the exemption does not apply if the concert is promoted for the purpose of private

gain, which is reasonable enough.

Is there a cunning government plan whereby mangling the English language exempts ministers from telling the truth? (I believe John Prescott always worked on this basis.) In any event, I assumed substituting the presumably intended 'or' for 'of' and 'facilities' for 'faculties' meant that local open air events for good causes, with no private gain, would be licence-free. The Act was passed in November 2003, and there has been a small, but perceptible, decline in our own paid musical work since then. Turning to the local non-profit making musical scene, in April we were delighted to learn that the completion of the excellently renovated Millpond Gardens was to be marked with a concert by Praze Hayle Male Voice Choir and Hayle Samba Band, exactly I would have

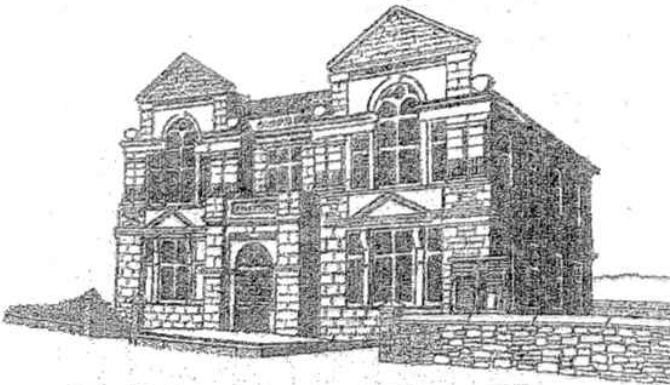

used the fortune he had amassed for philanthropic purposes. He was born in Cornwall and his name appears on many buildings in the county including Camborne and Redruth Free Libraries, Newlyn Art Gallery and the Falmouth Hospital. It was to celebrate the life of his father, who had lived in Hayle, that the Institute in Hayle was built. The foundation stone was laid in 1893 and the official opening was in 1896. The building sits proudly in the centre of Hayle linking Foundry and Copperhouse together.

The original conveyance of land from Harvey and Co. and others states that the land must be used "as a site for a Literary, Scientific and Educational Institution." Today the charity which manages the property has as its objects: "The provision and maintenance of a village hall for the

use of the inhabitants of the Parish of Hayle and neighbourhood without distinction of political, religious or other opinion including use for meetings, lectures and classes and for other forms of recreation and leisure time occupation, with the object of improving the conditions of life for the said inhabitants."

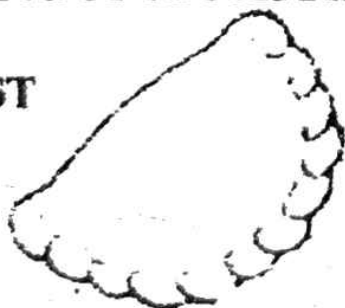

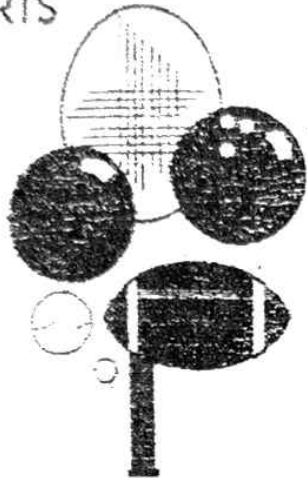

There have been recent reports of dog walkers disturbing the birds on the RSPB nature reserve at Copperhouse Creek. Although this appears to involve only one or two individuals, any activity like this will scare the birds away – for example the swans have all been frightened off. Please do not allow your dogs to run across the estuary, as this spoils it for

everybody.

The warden and a small team of volunteers have been tackling the RSPB site at Ryan's Field. Refurbishing benches, painting fences, installing a cycle rack near to the hide and clearing back overgrowing vegetation around the car park and footpaths. All this work has given the area a new lease of life for the summer. In April the beach patrol hit Copperhouse Creek, removing 17 sacks of rubbish. Our next two meetings are in June and July at Carnsew and Lelant. To volunteer please contact the RSPB office on 01736 711682.

### Birds

Hopefully you all saw the White-billed Diver, our first ever for Hayle, and only the fourth for Cornwall. This stayed around until 27<sup>th</sup> March and the Spotted Sandpiper hung on all the way to May. A Franklin's Gull proved popular one weekend during its stay here 2<sup>nd</sup> - 6<sup>th</sup> March although it could be difficult to pin down. This was followed by an adult Kumlien's Gull on 17<sup>th</sup> March for one day only. Migrant raptors included an Osprey on 7<sup>th</sup> March. Not many of you may have seen the three Glossy Ibis fly over the estuary on 20<sup>th</sup> April. I hear some even reached Newfoundland!

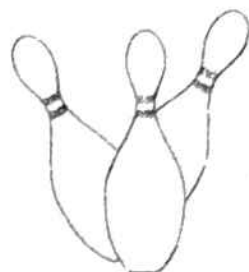

## 1876 MAP OF HAILE

We have been very pleased to receive an 'Alan Godfrey Maps' publication "Hayle & Lelant 1876". The

map is a facsimile reprint of the original Ordnance Survey map, and the rear of the document has comprehensive historical notes by Tony Clifford, who kindly sent us our review copy, and extracts from a 1910 directory listing some of the prominent inhabitants of Hayle at that time. The town's population was then a mere 1,684, about one fifth of the present total.

The map itself is a fascinating document. The general outline and main roads of Hayle and Lelant are immediately recognisable, but are of course considerably less built up than at present.

The historical notes printed on the back of the map are most informative on the town's industrial past. The directory of residents is extremely interesting, and there are some familiar Hayle names. For instance, apart of

course from Harvey and Trevithick, there are entries for Ellis, Crowle, Philp, Polkinghorne and many others whose names are still locally well known to us, including 'Misses Elizh. and Jessie Biggleston', who were Penpol Terrace booksellers.

Incidentally, although many facts about Copperhouse are included, the map itself is concentrated on the town's Foundry end, so Copperhouse folk should be warned that it ends at Hayle Terrace. (I hope this won't cause too much upset, because as the historical account recalls, a previous dispute between the town's two ends in 1818 erupted into violence, resulting in the calling out of the Marazion Militia!) Hopefully a similar map featuring Copperhouse will be issued at a later date.

We will be giving our own copy pride of place on the Hayle Pump office wall. If you are one of the many who are fascinated by old maps, I thoroughly

recommend this publication. It costs £2.20 plus 60p p/p and can be obtained from the publisher:-
