This conversion has all been made possible by the contribution of ground workers from Corinthian Homes who removed the gravel, prepared the areas to be turfed and built/installed numerous raised beds, for flowers. At the same time, Haven Holidays at Riviera Sands generously supplied the turf as well as some manpower to help lay it. Nick and Ali Reynolds at Paradise Park are also donating two lovely benches to complete the transformation.

Without the generous help from these three companies and our wonderful volunteers, this project would not have been completed and its success represents a great example of positive community spirit. We will be entering the area in this summer's South West in Bloom judging; planting and painting it in red, white and blue and naming it the Queen's Jubilee Garden. Incidentally, the adjoining Bouledrome has also benefited from some long overdue care and is 'ready for use'! We would ask dog-owners to please encourage your hound to do its 'business' elsewhere so as to maintain the condition and thus, prolong the life, of the new turf — thanks!

In the February edition of the Pump we mentioned that some new developments would likely be happening along Penpol Terrace in the coming months. Well, I, for one have noticed far more care and attention than normal being applied to many of the beds this Spring, leading to a much-improved appearance overall.

Paul Clark, the organiser, reports that over the last few months the 'Penpol

Terrace Community Plots' have, again been blooming and that H.I.B. have ensured availability of tools, if needed, as well as a supply of garden waste bags, including their removal. There are now 5 beds, managed by diverse sections of our community and their name plaques appear in the beds they tend. The groups are: Hayle Runners; Women's Institute; Friends of the Towans; Hayle Light and Life Church; and Hayle Old Cornwall Society, with Trevor Smitheram, who looks after Rick Rescorla's memorial on behalf of Susan. The remaining beds are managed by Hayle in Bloom and dedicated individuals such as Shirley Thompson and her sister, Silvia. 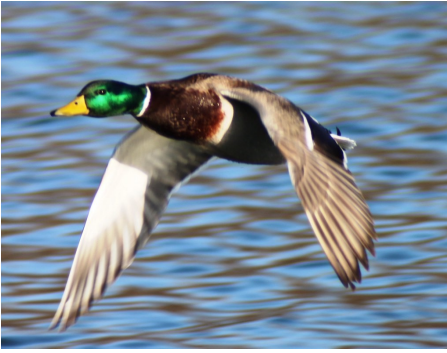

They have settled well and are watched over and fed by Nigel Powell. There are also two adult swans, Titania and Oberon, which also seem to keep an eye on our cygnets, so they are well guarded.

Their parents are nesting again so now we wait and see how many new cygnets arrive this year.

Most of our ducks have moved to their nesting sites but we still have two pairs left which normally hatch on the pond and the moorhens are also still with us.

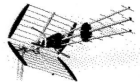

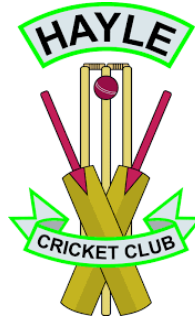

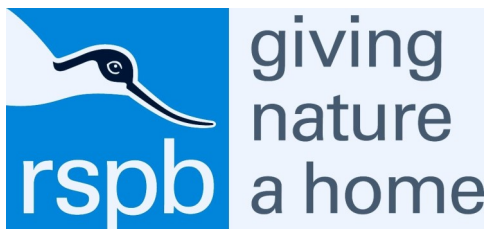

Herring Gulls nesting and they certainly keep me wondering!

The tatty nest they built had been neglected for weeks, except for adding occasional oddities such as a broken dog's toy, and a bird feeder from my garden. Then, just this week, Mama Bird took to her nest. She was attended by not just her mate, but by another gull as well. The two fussed and preened and clucked for hours, while she sat, regally lapping it all up. I was surprised that an extra bird was tolerated, but I suspect may be their youngster from last year.

At this time of year, the RSPB get lots of phone calls from distressed members of the public asking what to do about other people destroying bird nests and even destroying their

eggs. We explain that all bird nests are protected, that it is illegal to destroy them without a licence and that all wildlife crimes should be reported to the police as soon as possible. If bird nests need to be removed for health reasons, contact Cornwall Council for advice in the first instance.

For my part, I will look forward to watching the gull's eggs hatch into fussy little fluff balls and hoping that they all survive until they fly away. If they fall off the roof, I will do my best to put them back where the adults can look after them. Of course, I might need an umbrella over my head to keep the adults from hitting me (they don't understand that I mean the chicks no harm).

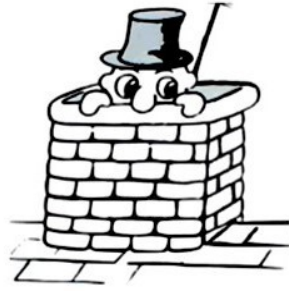

## Blue Plaques of Hayle Bodriggy House

This is the first in a series of articles that will elaborate on some of the Blue Plaques on display

around Hayle Town, and we begin with the one closest to the writer's home in Bodriggy Street, Bodriggy House.

Bodriggy House is an elegant two storey home that stands at the junction of Bodriggy Street and Sea Lane. Many readers will have passed it as they go about their daily life – school, doctor, and so on -but they may not realize that the Bodriggy Estate was one of six great estates in Hayle, surrounding the River Hayle before the town proper came into being. The estate is known to have been in the hands of the family of Bodriggy as early as 1181, and remained in their ownership for 339 years, before being sold to the Coswin family in

1552. That family held it for 248 years, until 1770, when the Curnows took it on until 1923. There have been numerous owners since, including the Ellis Family of Hayle Brewery.

The present house was built circa 1718, by Richard Pendarves, and is surrounded with other buildings that were part of their farm - barns, stables, and a fine wall, capped with slate, which once marked some of the boundaries. Sadly, much of this beautiful wall has been lost or compromised over the years. The house has a granite ashlar front, otherwise is 'painted rubble'. The steep roof is of Delabole slate, with tall brick chimneys over the gable ends. It has a seven-window symmetrical front with a central doorway, pleasing to the eye. An addition has been made to a rear wing, in Victorian times. The interior retains many 18th century features. The writer is fortunate to have visited the house, and overall impression is of space and light. The main staircase is a fine sight.

The house was granted protection as a Building of Special Architectural or Historic Interest in 1988. This

guards the building from any works or demolition, interior or exterior, that would change its character.

Bodriggy House has been divided into two homes for many years. A story heard by the writer claimed that on inheriting the house, two sisters did not wish to live together, and had the house divided, but no proof of this has been found.

There are many fine trees growing on the land surrounding Bodriggy House, and they are all covered by Tree Preservation Orders, issued in 2000. Included are Cherry trees, Fir trees, Palm Trees, a Magnolia, Maple and Rowan, Chestnut, Sycamore, Ash, and Hawthorn, Elm, Olive, Yew, Beech and Austrian

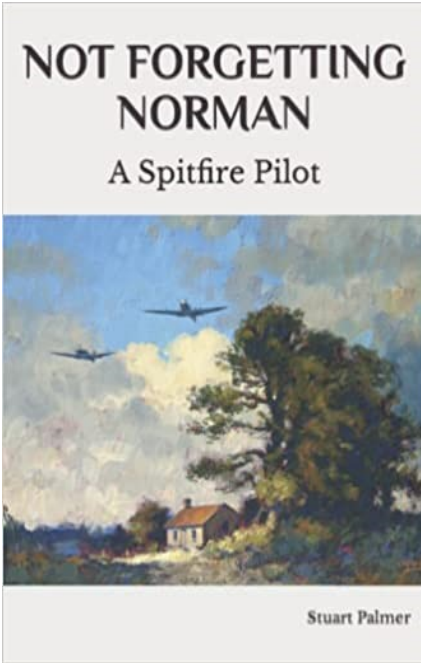
