Council Corner

Councillor Vacancies

We currently have two vacancies on the East Ward.

More information about joining the council is published on social media, on our website and the noticeboards around the town. Feel free to call the office for an informal chat with the Clerk or one of the officers and/or contact one of the existing town councillors who could provide information and discuss what's involved from their perspective.

2023/2024 Precept Demand

Careful budgeting in recent years has allowed the council to use the precept funding to continue to provide services, which could have otherwise been lost, via the devolution process. Additionally, the town council continues to support several groups and organizations in the town annually, including Hayle Day Care Centre, Hayle in Bloom, Hayle Christmas Lights and Hayle Youth Project and it also contributes to the work of the Friends of the Towans.

Last year we softened the increase of the budget by utilising excess general reserves, but unfortunately this is not an option this year.

We've decided, given the current cost of living crisis, to withdraw or delay committing to certain projects and have reduced contributions to

earmarked funds. However, the rise in utility and running costs, coupled with the withdrawal of the Council Tax Support Grant means that we have had to increase the precept.

The net effect is an increase in the precept of 10.74%, which equates to 8.47% or £18.76 per annum for a Band D property.

Unsuccessful Outcome for Hayle Town Council in Growth Plan Judicial Review

Hayle Town Council has been unsuccessful in challenging Cornwall Council's decision to grant planning permission for 85 residential dwellings following a High Court hearing which was held on Friday 20 January 2023.

A High Court Judge ruled in favour of Cornwall Council after considering

the arguments put forward by both parties.

On 7 February 2022, the West Sub-Area Planning Committee (Cornwall Council) resolved to grant planning permission subject to conditions and Section 106 planning obligations on a site off Viaduct Hill after an officer reported that funding had been secured for the upgrade to the Loggans Moor roundabout and was scheduled for delivery in 2022/23. On 8 March 2022, Cornwall Council decided to withdraw from the delivery of the roundabout upgrade scheme, and Hayle Town Council felt that this was a material consideration to which Cornwall Council was obliged to have regard before granting planning permission (which was finally passed for the site in question on 17 May 2022). On 27 September 2022, a

High Court Judge decided that Hayle Town Council's challenge was sufficiently arguable to proceed to a full hearing.

Cllr Anne-Marie Rance, Mayor, said: "We are disappointed that the High Court Judge has found against Hayle Town Council as we wanted to ensure that any new developments are in line with the Hayle Growth Area Concept Plan as agreed by both Hayle Town Council and Cornwall Council. The plan seeks to avoid ad hoc development that is not supported by green infrastructure, including the implementation of highways and junctions prior to the granting of planning permission. Taking the decision to pursue a judicial review was not a decision that the council took lightly. We took

DIGGING THE DUNES!

Well, here we are - spring is springing all around us and that incredible natural flower garden the Towans will be bursting into colour. It hardly seems any time ago that I told you about the ponies coming back to graze and the winter scrub-cutting we'd all be doing. Now that's just a memory - be it ponies escaping due

to the grass being greener on the other side (or a broken fence!), or fond thoughts of a warming bonfire, healthy exercise and good company on a crisp, bright winters' day.

Normally, apart from litter picking and some fairly minimal invasive species removal, we do very little habitat management in the summer. However this year will be different. Benefitting from Heritage Lottery funding from the Dynamic Dunesacpes project (hosted by Cornwall Wildlife Trust, but we are a partner), we plan to bring in a digger to some locations.

The plan is to dig out roots and topsoil from areas where we've cut scrub this winter, so that bare sand is exposed again. This is an increasingly rare part of the overall dune ecosystem, as grassland and scrub builds up a soil so that areas become stabilised - in a nutshell, this is actually on the way to not really being a sand dune anymore. About 70% of the invertebrates - insects etc - in a sand dune system need the

more open, sandy areas, so these become lost as soil and scrub takes over.

So, while this might look drastic, it's being done with both care and good intentions, so don't be alarmed! Parts of Mexico and Gwithian Towans will be the main locations. I'm always happy to discuss any of our work, so get in touch if you'd like to know more or have concerns. Contact me at martinrule@talktalk.net or 07854 123 877. Over Winter, up to 18,000 migrant and wintering waterfowl flock to the Hayle

estuary – especially during severe weather, when conditions here may be milder than elsewhere in the UK. There are still many birds finding food and refuge on Copperhouse Pool and Hayle Estuary. Wigeon and teal are easily seen but will return to their breeding grounds during March. But watch out for oyster catchers, curlew, little egrets, gulls, and waders, who use the Pool and Estuary all year round.

There is a useful list of birds that may be seen each day in the greenhouse on King George Walk.

Mention was made of Lapwings in the last Hayle Pump story. On several occasions, I was fortunate to see large flocks of these attractive

birds flying over the estuary. It made a grand sight.

With Spring just around the corner, we will soon be seeing butterflies and other insects. There are bumble bees buzzing in my garden despite the cool and damp weather. Wild flowers are evident, celandine, dead nettle, and sloe blossom, and daffodils popping up everywhere. What a lovely time of the year! Make the most of it!

Hayle Christmas Lights needs you

Hayle Christmas Lights is in need of more volunteers to take on some of the tasks needed for the lights to continue to shine bright at Christmas. This call has gone out many times over the last few months with, unfortunately, a very poor uptake. The present officers of the lights (Chairman, Treasurer and Secretary) have been in post for a number of years and are looking to stand down. Without your support the lights may not be able to continue.

Many of the present team are getting too long in the tooth to continue with the tasks needed and without new

volunteers the lights cannot be put up, taken down, maintained and improved.

Much of the work on the lights, that is seen by the public, takes place in November when the lights go up (ready for the switch on taking place on the last Friday of the month) and in January, when the lights are taken down. However, the group also meets once a month throughout the year when much of the work is planned and then undertaken to ensure the lights can go up and down speedily and safely.

Tasks undertaken include: sorting out grant applications, liaising with other groups, businesses and others to improve displays, sorting out costs for "new" lights or for replacement lights, ensuring that electrical items

Millpond Update

Winter seems to have passed quite swiftly and the weather has been less extreme this year. The drakes are settled and have quite a few friends keeping them well fed and happy. When we make our Wednesday visits, they troop off the pond to be fed and our Moorhens join them on the bank. We have had a flock of over seventy birds since the autumn. The number will start to go down as the breeding season approaches and the birds move to their breeding ground. We still have egrets and a young heron visiting and the Kingfishers are still on the river. Redwings and Marsh Tits are winter visitors, but I have not seen

our Water Voles. So, our Local Pussy Cat might have found them. The spring bulbs are in bloom the site. Daffodils and crocus are creating splashes of colour and bluebells and Snowdrops will soon appear along the Rope Walk. There is a great variety of wood land plants and flowers around the mill ponds, and it is certainly a site to be recommended in any environmental scheme around the Hayle area. The Millponds site has been used for educational purposes since it was opened to the public in the 1980s by the Hayle Town Trust. We sincerely hope that such projects will continue to make full use of our facilities and you are more than welcome.

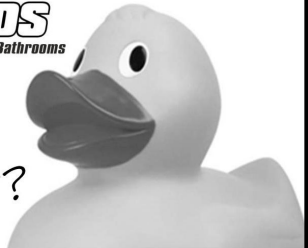

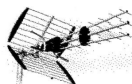

new ropes on our bells. They stretch over time, and the damp weather makes them stiff. It is reassuring to know that they are in good shape, so it is up to the ringers to make a nice sound!

We occasionally have a visiting band of ringers, usually on a Monday evening. They ring for nearly an hour to attempt a Quarter Peal, a big achievement, and usually succeed – well done, them! We have a grand set of bells here at Phillack, and it is always good to hear them ring out across the town.

The Coronation of King Charles III is coming closer, and some enthusiasm expressed about ringing for this momentous moment in history. I repeat, any ex-ringers are welcome to join us!

Blue Plaque: The Crimean Siege Mortar

Take a walk along The Plantation opposite Jewsons, and almost straight away you will be confronted by a formidable weapon, a Crimean Siege Mortar.

The mortar was built in Hayle, in 1856, by local engineers Harvey & Co, for use in the Crimean War, and sent directly to Crimea from Hayle on local ships. It weighs 5 tons and has a 13" bore with a choked barrel. The mortar was placed on display many years ago. It is set on a timber carriage, replaced (circa 1995) by then Hayle Councillor, Mr Lello; A replica of the original, made of oak, it would have been an expensive job.

The principle of this mortar is to fire high over the defence walls and not be seen doing so by the enemy. This, apparently, was not an easy task.

Harveys, and their neighbour and competitor, Cornish Copper Company, were among the leading engineering firms of their day. Richard Trevithick, most associated with Harveys, improved on the industrial steam engine, including one that helped drain low lying land in Holland. Harveys built many ships, and helped the Crimean war effort by making the mortars, and contributed to steam engine development.

There was strong competition between the two companies, including boundary arguments. Eventually, a battle broke out between the two parties, which had to be settled by the Military from Marazion. This led to a division in Hayle, with each company building their own facilities, at Foundry and Copperhouse. Reminders of this still exist, with several granite boundary posts marked H on one side, and CCC on the other.

The mortar is yet another reminder of the history all around us.

Going Potty: Tales From the Potting Shed.

So far this year has been productive for me, with a sale on January 2nd and a particularly successful one on February 6th. Between these dates I had an astounding bit of good luck. The Leach Pottery in St. Ives holds 3 day and 5 day throwing courses, where 4 or 5 students work with a tutor to learn the Leach techniques used for their standard-ware. These courses are booked up a year in advance, but by chance I looked at the website, and lo! there was a space the following week! Did I have enough to pay for it? Yes!

And so, on Monday 16th Jan. I cycled over to the Pottery and with Barbara, Ghaz and Andrew began a steep learning curve. Our tutor was Lucy Rutter who couldn't have been more encouraging. We attempted simple cylinders on the first day which were all supposed to be the same size... On Tuesday we pulled handles to make mugs - another technique I'd never done - and threw bowls in small, medium and large sizes. One of mine slumped badly but was rescued the following day with some

turning to tidy it up.

By the end of the week I had a nice collection to take home. 34 pieces in all, assisted by Barbara, who had a car. Damp unfired pots don't travel well in a bicycle pannier. We were each allowed to put one pot forward for glazing and firing at the Pottery, though we won't see these for a couple of months. All my others were fired at home with only one disaster; my largest pot came out with a shattered bottom, which is a sad demise for a pot, as I'm sure you'll agree. The February sale coincided with getting these new pieces on show, one dish selling only hours after coming out of the kiln. All the masks I made last year sold out too, so I'll make more, and some small models of Cornish milestones (the ones with the little pointing hands)

using local clay.

On searching for clay deposits in the fields around St Erth recently I found a very sticky pathway, so took a small sample of the gunge home with me. It has been washed, sieved and is now settling out. Eventually it will be squidged and kneaded on a plaster slab until it is firm enough to wedge properly. It will be interesting to see if it is plastic enough to use on its own, or if it will need some commercial clay mixed with it.

The Japanese Knotweed experiment which used ash from burned stems mixed with transparent glaze didn't give as exciting a result as I'd hoped. The ash left tiny specks in the glaze but did not seem to colour it at all. I have some pine ash to try next.

The March 6th sale was another

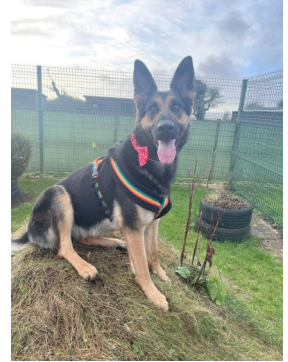


I am a bit of an anxious young lady. I haven't known whether I'm coming or going in my life so far and this has made me a bit wary of things. I would love someone who can help me with
