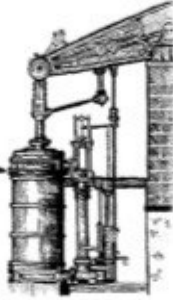

Tree Planting to mark the Coronation

The gardening/maintenance works team with the support of the Mayor and Town Councillors have taken the first steps to creating a community orchard for the future. The first 6 fruit trees were planted on Friday 6 May 2023 to mark the coronation of King Charles III. The trees have been planted to help increase the biodiversity of the town and are part of a long-term plan to establish a wildflower area here.

The orchard can be found adjacent to the tennis courts in Hayle Recreation Ground. There is no vehicular access into the orchard, but there is parking outside the play area.

The orchard is obviously in its infancy and will require careful maintenance and pruning to allow the trees to thrive and, in time, to provide sufficient fruit for the community to pick and utilize. Our gardening and maintenance team will aim to make further improvements to the area in the coming months/years, with the potential for more trees and improved access.

If members of the public and or community groups wish to either plant or donate further trees, please liaise with the Town Council Office and arrangements can be made.

BIRD BONANZA!

The weather this spring has been a little more 'traditional' this year, with lots more April showers than we've had in recent years, following quite a wet March when we sadly had to cancel quite a few school visits.

However, this rain has made our gardens, countryside and Towans alive with fresh and colourful plants, in turn supporting a huge

wealth of insects and birds, reptiles etc - the rich web of life that we are a part of.

I've led a spring bird-watch at

Gwithian Green, through St Gothian and up around Godrevy for several years now, always hoping to see 50 species, which we normally manage. This year we had rich pickings though! On May 3rd, we recorded an incredible 69 species! If we'd then gone across to Hayle Estuary, we'd probably have pushed 80, which again just goes to show how wildlife-rich this bit of Kernow is.

Birds are now actively nesting for the next few months, so I would encourage anyone walking a dog on the Towans to please keep it on a lead, or at least keep to the main busy paths and, most importantly, try to prevent your dog running loose in the long grass. Two declining species - Skylark and Meadow pipit - share the Towans with us and nest on the ground, making them

It has been a treat to see a pair of shelducks on Copperhouse Pool. They

seem to be there most days, and very obvious with their black and white plumage. A Little Grebe has been in residence for some time and can often be seen near the Home Bargains bridge diving for food. Other avian highlights include a Bonaparte's gull from across the pond, a Great White Egret and waders including Whimbrel and Ruff.

herb and vegetable gardens. It has a taste of celery, but it went out of fashion. Curiosity about its unusual name led to the discovery that it might be named after the city of Alexandria, as the plant originated in the Mediterranean area, or it might be named after Alexander the Great! Whatever, it has provided an attractive show this Spring. As it fades, the white-flowered Cow Parsley and the Red Campion takes over, along with other summer plants that help brighten our walks.

Maybe you watched Wild Isles, the wonderful documentary films, with David Attenborough. The RSPB collaborated in the making of the films. They can help you find out more about Nature's wonders.

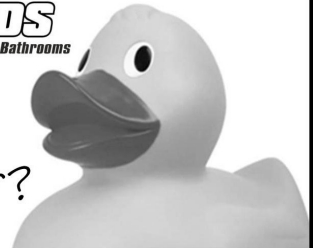

Blue Plaque: Harvey's Clock

There cannot be many local citizens who have not glanced at the Harvey's Clock as they pass by. The four faced clock on the tower above Harvey & Co's offices in Foundry Square, has been a presence in the town since 1830. During its early years, three faces showed London time, and one face showed Cornish time, a twenty-minute difference.

The clock was fully restored in 2003 and is now regularly maintained. The clock is Grade II listed. A Grade 2 listed building is defined as a UK building or structure that is "of special interest, warranting every effort to preserve it". Grade 2 is a

classification that can be applied to a wide variety of buildings and other structures, in a range of ages, styles and locations.

I am unable to find more information about the clock, but I am sure there are many, like me, who find the clock and its tower attractive and useful.

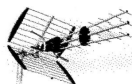
While it does not bear a Blue Plaque, the red telephone box in the grounds of Passmore Institute is a nostalgic sight for many. Replaced by the ugly, and oft vandalised, modern glass and stainless-steel boxes, I am sure there are others who prefer the old model. In fact, there were two models, one larger than the other. If you go around the back of the fully restored phone kiosk at Passmore, there is an

Blue Plaque Correction.

I regret to say that mistakes were made in the article about the Hayle Railway in the Dec/Jan issue No 165. Thank you to the reader who pointed out the errors.

1) The Hayle Railway never went over the swing bridge, which was built in 1880. It went over a drawbridge to the west of the swing bridge, and its foundations can still be seen.

2) ASDA is on East or Foundry Quay, not South Quay. I apologise again for these errors.

In addition, my informant told me that, in the First World War, a branch line was built from the Hayle Railway to the National Explosive Works at Upton Towans. It crossed the river by a bridge to the rear of Brookway and then via Loggans Road to the works site.

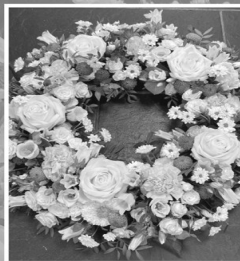

This cost them around 40 places. They positioned well in their subsequent group races but remained in the same group, ultimately finishing 75th.

By the second half of the Sunday, the sun had begun to shine and the traditional rafting up and trophy ceremonies were held in summer-like conditions. A fitting end to an exciting few days which saw the club perform well and demonstrate some real potential in what were often trying circumstances."

Big changes have happened with my humble little Potting Shed - my spare room is now a pop-up Gallery. I am open three days a week rather than one day a month (see my new advert for details), so now have a much better showcase for my ceramics and other artworks.

The name 'Sunflower' was chosen as it was my late mother's favourite flower; the big, bold, glorious plant which always makes a positive statement in any garden. For her 95th birthday I made one of my big collages of a sunflower head, and this, along with the five other collages I made during lockdown are on display in the house.

Pottery-wise, it has been less of an emphasis on figurative work lately and more on pots and vessels. Having found a few small areas locally with clay or clayey soil, I've been making pots with a 50/50 blend of it mixed with commercial clay, to give it some extra plasticity. These are drying on the windowsill as I write and should be in the kiln very soon. By the time this edition of the Pump comes out I should have some interesting pieces. They have been made using the coiling method, as I severely inflamed my right thumb tendons several weeks ago using clay on the wheel which was much too firm. Had I dampened it first I

wouldn't have been in pain for weeks. Still, I have had an injection now and my 'industrial injury' is starting to settle down. Fortunately, coiling wasn't painful if I was careful, and as I can coil just as easily clockwise as anticlockwise the work could continue.

The little masks I make seem to be a popular item, so I will be experimenting with making a larger, probably life-size version for gardens. They could look very cool on a garden wall. The ash glaze experiments are on the back burner for now, as they haven't turned out to be as exciting as I planned, but you win some, you lose some. The pots using wax resist look great, so these can be pursued further.

In early April I was able to spend a couple of days with friends in Polzeath, where we drooled over the artwork (not literally) in the Whitewater Gallery. Some beautiful ceramics in porcelain, then later saw some Roman vessels and shards in a Wadebridge antique shop. 2,000 years old and still beautiful. Ceramics don't last forever, but two millennia isn't bad. *Kind regards to all from Linda.*

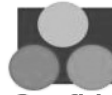

Hayle, renowned in the past for its engineering greats such as the Cornish Copper Company and J&F Pool over the Copperhouse end of town, and Harvey & Co over Foundry, have a new younger challenger. Just a short distance away from Hayle Pump HQ is Penpol School where a team of young engineers have been selected as finalists in a Lego competition in the USA. The Penpol Pumpkins, from Penpol School in Hayle, are hoping to raise £25,000 to pay for their flights, accommodation and transport in Massachusetts.

As the following Press Release written by Cornwall Council shows, this local team is aiming big ...

Jacob Woolcock, the Pumpkins' teacher, recorded a heart-warming video of the team finding out that they had been selected for the international First Lego League finals, which you can view on their website.

He said: "It's a huge honour to be asked to represent Great Britain at this international final and is a real testament to the hard work and determination which our students in the Penpol Pumpkins have showed this year.

tasks, as well as complete a project and presentation. This year's competition was all about exploring how energy is sourced, transported and consumed around the world.

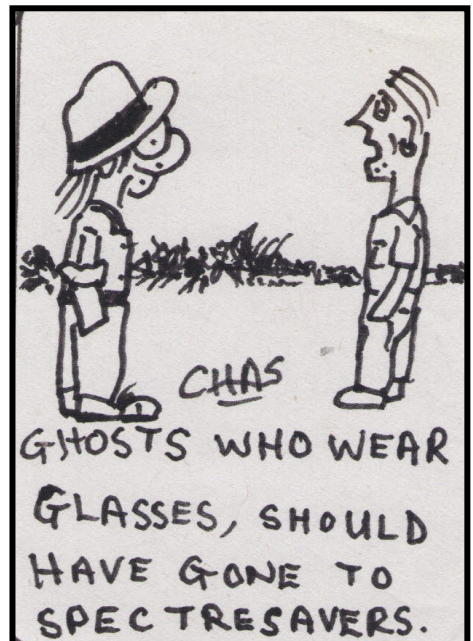
