Citizens Advice Bureau

Our Citizens Advice Bureau (CAB) service offers free, confidential advice and is available **by appointment only** for the foreseeable future. Sessions take place on the **first and third Wednesday of each month**.

Home Group Support

We also host a representative from Home Group, who offers free support with:

- Housing applications
- Form filling
- Budgeting
- Personal Independence Payment (PIP) paperwork
- Debt management
- Accessing GP and health referrals
- And much more

This free service is available to support people with physical health needs and/or disabilities.

Sessions are held every Wednesday from 1.00pm to 3.00pm. Although you are welcome to drop in, appointments are recommended as the sessions can be busy. Please call 07423 494338 to arrange a suitable time.

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Children's Activities

Our Rhyme Time sessions for children aged 0–3 years take place every Wednesday at 11.15am. Weather permitting, we hope to hold these sessions outdoors, so please come prepared.

Story Time is held every Friday at 11.00am and includes a story, with a craft activity on some occasions. Our Lego Club meets every Saturday at 10.30am. All children's activities are free of charge.

Health & Wellbeing

Blood pressure monitors are available for library members to borrow for up to three weeks.

Computer Support

Our Computer Buddy is available on selected Friday mornings to help anyone who is confident using a computer but needs assistance with a particular issue. Please pop in or contact the library if you would like some help.

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1st St Erth Guides



What a year we've had! Firstly, we've grown from just eight Guides to 18, and by September our numbers will have increased to 24. We must be doing something right! This year, we've welcomed many visitors to speak to the Guides, including a representative from Children's Hospice South West. Inspired by the visit, the Guides baked and sold cakes at the St Erth Farmers' Market, raising an incredible £100 for the charity. We are grateful for the supportive parents within our Guiding family. At the end of last year, one of our

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mums showed the girls how to make beautiful Christmas decorations from recycled materials. In January, one of our dads, who works with deafblind clients, led sessions to raise awareness of the lives and challenges faced by the deafblind community. It was fascinating, and the girls earned their Communications badges.

The Guides were a real credit at the Hayle Remembrance Service in November. In February, they joined more than 100 Rainbows, Brownies, Guides, Young Leaders, Leaders and members of the Trefoil Guild to celebrate the Division's 100th World Thinking Day – a major event in the Guiding and Scouting calendar worldwide.

In March, the girls tried their hand at DIY. Working together in patrols, they used tools to build dolls' houses before decorating each room beautifully, earning their Interior Design badges.



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Our camp at Condurro in May was a fantastic success. We were incredibly fortunate to have a wonderful team of adults and Young Leaders supporting the girls through their first camp experience. They enjoyed cooking on open fires, tie-dyeing, water games, making rockets and singing campfire songs in the sunshine.

We rounded off the year with a successful celebration evening, complete with lots of cake, where many badges were presented. A special congratulations goes to one Guide who, despite overcoming many challenges, achieved her Gold Award.

We currently have three fully trained leaders, but with our growing numbers we need more adult

volunteers to support the unit. Whether you can help once a month, once a fortnight or every week, we'd love to hear from you. There's no need to have been a Brownie or Guide, and there's no pressure to become a leader—we simply ask for commitment.

For nearly 40 years, the Angarrack Christmas Lights have been bringing festive magic to our village and delighting generations of visitors throughout the Christmas season.

However, we are now facing a very real risk that the lights may not go ahead this year.

Following Storm Goretti, we commissioned an electrical inspection of our equipment, which identified the need for urgent repairs and essential electrical improvements.

We must now raise a significant sum of money to carry out this work,

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and time is running short. Unless the repairs are commissioned soon, we may be unable to continue this much-loved tradition.

Hayle Foodbank

Inequality is one of the biggest issues facing this country at the moment, and one that politicians of all parties are struggling to address. Fortunately, here in Hayle we have a community that is willing and able to tackle some of these issues at a local level.

Hayle Foodbank was formed in 2012 to help local people in the Hayle area with short-term support during difficult times, such as



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waiting for benefits, job loss, relationship breakdown, unexpected bills, or homelessness.

Our aim has always been to help people get back on their feet as quickly as possible, and we are very fortunate that the people of Hayle give so generously either through donations of food and toiletries at collection points in ASDA, Copperhouse Chemist, and WJ Winn Funeral Directors, or through financial donations.

Many individuals and organisations donate food and money, too many to list individually. We would like to mention the Hayle Runners and Thurstan Hoskin Solicitors who make regular donations, as well as Riviere Farms, who donate fresh

veg, and Pengelly's Farm, who donate potatoes.

Local schools and churches are also extremely generous at Harvest and Christmas time, supporting our Christmas Parcel operation, through which up to 80 local families receive a special festive parcel.

Rick Rescorla – Hayle's Hero

Hayle has produced many remarkable people over the years, but few have earned worldwide admiration quite like Rick Rescorla. His courage and selfless leadership on 11 September 2001 saved the lives of more than 2,600 people and ensured that the name of our town became associated with one of the greatest acts of heroism in modern history.

Born Cyril Richard Rescorla in Hayle on 27 May 1939, Rick spent his childhood in the town during the Second World War. Like many young boys of the time, he was fascinated by the American servicemen who arrived in Cornwall to prepare for the D-Day landings. Those experiences inspired a



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lifelong commitment to military service and leadership. After serving with the British Army's Parachute Regiment, Rick emigrated to the United States, where he joined the U.S. Army. He became a highly decorated officer during the Vietnam War, earning a reputation for exceptional bravery and calmness under pressure. Those qualities would later prove invaluable in the greatest test of his life.

Following his military career, Rick became Head of Security for Morgan Stanley, whose offices occupied many floors of the South Tower of New York's World Trade Center. Convinced that the towers could one day be targeted again after the 1993 bombing, he

introduced regular evacuation drills. Although some questioned the need, Rick insisted that everyone should know exactly what to do in an emergency.

His foresight proved lifesaving. On the morning of 11 September 2001, when the terrorist attacks struck the World Trade Center, Rick immediately ordered the evacuation of Morgan Stanley's offices.

Ignoring advice to stay put, he calmly directed thousands of employees down the stairwells. Witnesses recall him encouraging frightened people, even singing Cornish songs to keep spirits up and prevent panic.

Thanks largely to his planning and determination, more than 2,600 employees and visitors escaped



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safely before the South Tower collapsed.

Having helped almost everyone reach safety, Rick returned to the building to search for anyone still trapped. He never came back. He gave his own life so that others might live.

Today, Rick Rescorla is remembered around the world as a symbol of courage, leadership and selfless service. Here in Hayle, we are especially proud that such an extraordinary man began his journey in our town. His memorial on the harbour serves as a lasting reminder of the values he embodied: duty, compassion and an unwavering commitment to others.

As we pass his memorial or tell his

story to future generations, we remember not only a soldier and a hero, but a Hayle lad whose actions on one tragic day changed thousands of lives forever. His legacy reminds us that true greatness is measured not by fame or fortune, but by the difference we make to the lives of others.

On Friday, 11 September, from approximately 12.30 pm, pupils from Penpol School, together with students from Bodriggy Academy and Hayle Academy, will gather in the Penpol playground before marching to the Rick Rescorla Memorial for a special service to mark the 25th anniversary of the 9/11 terrorist attacks.

Joining the procession will be standard bearers, military



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personnel, local MPs, town mayors and, we hope, a marching band. A choir will also take part in the service, together with the Vicar and members of Hayle Town Council.

We are delighted to have received permission for a temporary road closure to allow the procession to take place safely. Every child attending will receive a free Rick Rescorla commemorative badge and a special-edition booklet telling the story of Rick's remarkable life and the significance of the event.

I will, of course, keep everyone updated as further details of the ceremony become available.

To help fund the commemorative badges, I am selling specially produced postcards. I would also like to express my sincere thanks to everyone who has already made a donation. Your generosity has helped us get this project underway.

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Elizabeth Carne



Elizabeth Carne was born in 1817 at Riviere House, Phillack, now a Grade II listed building. This Georgian house belonged to the Cornish Copper Company and commanded an impressive view over what was then the bustling industrial shipping port of Hayle. The cellars housed her father's experimental laboratories and a small foundry, which were visited by eminent men of the time, including Humphry Davy. It was an exciting home for a curious child.

Elizabeth (a distant relative of the Brontës) was the seventh of eight children born to Joseph and Mary Carne, and the second daughter to be named Elizabeth. The first Elizabeth died shortly after birth.

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The family were wealthy, and Elizabeth led a privileged life, allowing her to pursue academic and philanthropic interests. Her father, Joseph, was a managing partner of the Cornish Copper Company, a mining engineer and, later, a banker.

When Elizabeth was a child, the family moved to Chapel Street, Penzance, to what is now a hotel adjacent to St Mary's Church. Here, her father joined the bank established by her grandfather. Following his death, Elizabeth was destined to take up his leading position at the bank, an unprecedented step for a woman at the time.

Joseph shared his passion for collecting fossils, ore specimens and minerals with Elizabeth. In turn, she became an accomplished geologist, delivering several scientific papers to the Geological Society of Cornwall, becoming the first woman to do so and later its first female member. Quite an achievement. Elizabeth inherited, catalogued and expanded her

father's impressive mineral collection, now owned by the Sedgwick Museum of Earth Sciences.

With her contemporaries, Miss Hockin and Miss Tyacke, Elizabeth furthered her interest in conchology, developing a specimen case that could be transported to present their finds, including several rare Cornish specimens. Her illustrated records of shells found on nearby beaches are both impressive and detailed. These are complemented by her sketches of molluscs, studied alongside her sister, Caroline. Their collection of molluscs was donated to the Penzance Natural History Museum in 1899.

The family's strong Wesleyan Methodist beliefs and values played a significant part in Elizabeth's life. Through these, she developed a lifelong commitment to philanthropy, promoting education and addressing social problems, as well as declining religious and spiritual values. Elizabeth's grandparents were active members

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of Cornwall's growing Methodist movement, and her grandfather was regarded as the county's father of Methodism. During his visits to the area, John Wesley stayed at the Carne family home.

Elizabeth's father ensured that his daughters received an excellent education at home, where there was a strong Methodist emphasis on hard work, study and community service. This is reflected in the books and articles Elizabeth wrote, some under the pseudonym of John Altrayd Wittitterly. She articulated a strong belief in equality and the integration of communities, regardless of social status.

Elizabeth possessed an intellect recognised by many eminent

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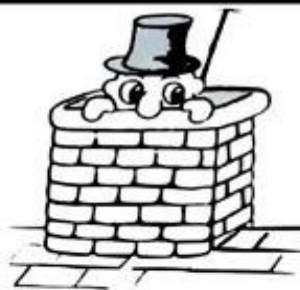
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visitors. One such visitor was John Stuart Mill, the British philosopher, who described her intellect as "remarkable". When he visited, Elizabeth was only 15 years old, and he was particularly surprised by her intelligence because of both her gender and the remote location in which she had been raised. The presence of such distinguished intellectuals in the Carne household, together with the atmosphere of debate and discussion they fostered, undoubtedly encouraged Elizabeth's own development and thinking.

Elizabeth's second book, *Country Towns, and the Place They Fill in Modern Civilization* (1868),

contributed to contemporary debates on social, educational and moral philosophy. In it, she expressed a passionate belief in the dangers posed by continued inequality, ignorance and poverty. She also voiced concerns about overcrowded slums, poor drainage, inadequate housing and polluted air—issues that remain strikingly relevant today.

After inheriting her father's estates, Elizabeth devoted both her wealth and her time to improving the education and wellbeing of poor and disadvantaged local people. She distributed food, clothing and books to those most in need, established and funded three, possibly four, local schools, and

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donated money towards the purchase of land for community projects.

Elizabeth's passion for the natural environment extended to Boscawen-Ûn. She purchased the site after learning that a local farmer intended to demolish it. At the time, the stone circle had a wall running through its centre, which Elizabeth had removed. She also commissioned the construction of the surrounding wall that still stands today, helping to protect this important historic monument.

Elizabeth died of typhoid fever in 1873 and is buried in the churchyard at Phillack, where her tomb can still be seen.

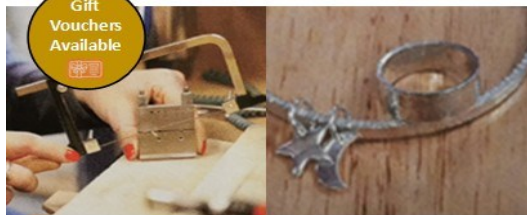

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Seeing and Tasting Like an Insect

This summer, families have been working with Friends of the Towans Art Club and partners Budding Nature CIC and Jolly Goodh CIC to explore how insects see and feed on the dunes at Gwithian. Through a mix of art and science, the project invites young people to look closely, move imaginatively and understand the Towans' fragile ecosystems in new ways. Working alongside artists and ecologists, families have been testing ideas for an

educational pack to be developed in a future phase of funding. Creative works so far include a ceramic and metal tongue sculpture inspired by insect mouthparts, and a compound -lens viewing structure crafted at the blacksmith's, which echoes the way dragonflies perceive movement and colour. A drone performance, with families moving like insects across the dune paths, has brought sensory ecology and multi-species learning vividly to life. We warmly invite the public to join us at the Friends of the Towans Fete on Saturday 22 August at Gwithian Church Hall, where we will show a short film of the project. Visitors are also welcome to explore the temporary sculptures installed on

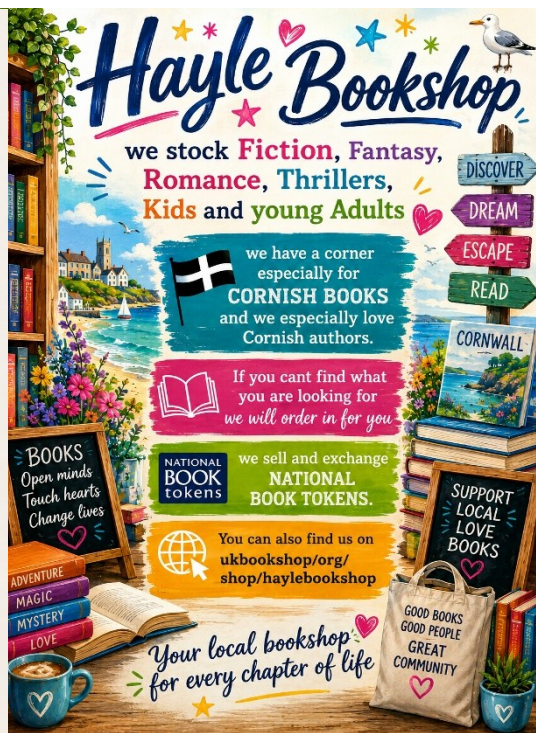

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Art Club have become an established art community who are passionate about Hayle Towans. 2026 will include an exciting combination of sketchbook walks and outdoor drawing and painting sessions on the dunes (with a picnic) most months with workshops planned at Gwithian.

We meet on the Towans from Mexico to Godrevy and our themes include drawing and exploring plants on Gwithian Green, sea holly, identifying butterflies and seaweeds and painting sunsets.

Later in October Art Club will take part in the Big 'Dune' Draw once again.

We formed Friends of the Towans Art Club in 2021 and our first en plein air session on the Towans was

on 23rd April 2022 as part of the Friends of the Towans. The events are free but optional donations however small are gratefully received to support our charity. And it is fabulous that Paradise Park have a permanent display of FOTT Art Club original artwork for fundraising by their shop, so pop in and have a look.

Our Events are publicised on Friends of the Towans Art Club Facebook page and Instagram pages so please follow us to keep up to date and please spread the word. It all helps.

For all of our sessions Art Club have a limited supply of art materials for you to borrow but do bring your own if you have them. Just bring a sketchbook to draw and have fun on the beautiful dunes. We very much look forward to seeing you.

Nature Notes

Maybe it's the sunshine attracting them, but I've noticed a lot of moths and butterflies lately—definitely more than usual. I have a large and rather weedy plant in my front garden called Monarda. While it is not the most beautiful of plants, it attracts many insects, including bees, moths, butterflies, beetles and other small creatures. There was even a small, brilliant blue damselfly there the other day. I am loath to get rid of the plant for that reason. Plants that attract insects — pollinators — are always worthwhile.



A pollinator is an insect or other agent that conveys pollen to a plant, allowing fertilisation. Without pollination, plants cannot reproduce. This is why we hear so much about 'attracting pollinators' and 'planting for pollinators'. They are essential for growing our food crops, as well as the flowers in our gardens.

There are about sixty species of butterflies in Britain, and even more species of moths and they fly away or flutter around, so it is usually difficult to admire their colours and markings up close. Some butterflies are familiar — the Cabbage White can often be seen in our gardens, while the Red Admiral is also quite common. I've spotted Small

Tortoiseshells and Small Blues, and occasionally a butterfly I do not recognise and cannot name. There are many books on British wildlife that will tell you more about these beautiful creatures and online resources can also help. Keep your eyes open when you are out and about. I saw a magnificent Elephant Hawkmoth resting on a shop window just the other day!

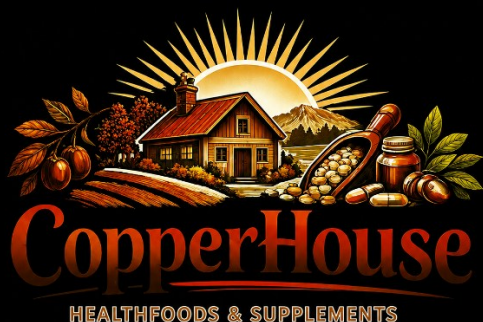
